## #5 Volleyball Hosts #8 Azusa Pacific, Travels to #2 California Baptist

Biola's volleyball team—ranked No. 5 in the NAIA—wraps up its most difficult stretch of the year this week with a pair of tough matches this week.

The Eagles, who had little trouble knocking off No. 4 National American University last week, wrap up a stretch of six matches against NAIA Top-10 teams in eight matches taking on #8 Azusa Pacific and #2 Cal Baptist this week.

Biola starts things off on Tuesday (Oct. 2), welcoming arch-rival Azusa Pacific to Chase Gymnasium in what promises to be another in the epic battles between the two schools.

The Eagles wrap up its long stretch on Saturday (Oct. 6) as they hit the road for a match against #2 Cal Baptist at 7:00 p.m.

### Men's and Women's Soccer Hosts Fresno Pacific, Travels to Concordia

With six women's and five men's GSAC teams ranked in the NAIA National poll, it seems like each week is the conference schedule is a difficult stretch for soccer.

The teams open the week against Fresno Pacific University. The women start things off on Tuesday (Oct. 2), hosting the Sun Birds at 4:00 p.m. The men's teams then takes on #13 FPU on Wednesday (Oct. 3) at 7:00 p.m.

On Saturday (Oct. 6) the teams travel down to Concordia for matches against another set of nationally-ranked teams. The women kick things off at Noon against #18 Concordia. The men's team follows at around 2:00 p.m. in a tough match, facing the #1-ranked Eagles.

### Women's Golfers wrap up Fall Season at Cal State Monterey Bay

After an impressive showing in their first-ever golf tournament, the women's golfers head north to Seaside, Calif. on Monday and Tuesday (Oct. 1-2) to participate in the Cal State Monterey Bay Lady Otter Invitational.

# BIOLA VOLLEYBALL

## #5 Eagles Prepare to Host Arch-Rival Azusa Pacific on Tuesday

While it may only be the mid-point of the season, it would be safe to say that this week could be the biggest week of the season for the Biola volleyball team.

The #5 Eagles will play the most important match of the season this week as they host arch-rival and #8 Azusa Pacific University on Tuesday (Oct. 2) in a match that could be the key to one of the teams reaching the NAIA National Tournament, but more on that below. The match begins at 7:00 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium and is expected to be a sellout, so arrive early!

On Saturday, the Eagles close out a tough eight-match stretch as they travel to Riverside to face #2 California Baptist at 7:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

**#8 AZUSA PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (12-4 overall, 5-3 GSAC):** The rivalry between the Cougars and Eagles has been one of the best in GSAC volleyball over the last 10+ years. The two teams have been neck-and-neck in the GSAC standings every year and this year will be no different.

Azusa Pacific has been one of the toughest teams to beat in the conference this year as they have gone five games against the top three teams in the conference though they have fallen short in each. On Saturday, they were able to come from behind against #7 Point Loma Nazarene, beating them in five down in San Diego.

The Cougars have a number of talented players led by junior setter Allison Kincheloe who directs the offense. Kincheloe leads the GSAC with 13.70 assists/game and also has 31 blocks and 27 aces on the season.

Azusa's big boppers are sophomore Jill Baker and freshman Chelsea Daley who ranks second and third in kills in the GSAC, respectively. Baker has 302 kills (5.30/game) while Daley adds 251 (4.40/game).

Biola leads the all-time series between the two rivals 40-28, but has lost seven straight to the Cougars.

**#2 CALIFORNIA BAPTIST UNIVERSITY (14-2 Overall, 7-1 GSAC):** The Lancers have once again shown that they are a force to be reckoned with in the GSAC and have moved all

the way to #2 in the NAIA already this season. Their only two losses came to NCAA Division II powerhouse Western Washington University and to #1 Fresno Pacific a couple of weeks ago.



The Lancers were dealt a big blow in a win over NCAA Division II #1 Cal State San Bernardino two weeks ago as Angela Willis broke her arm and is out for the year. Willis and

her sister Veronica have provided the bulk of the CBU offense over the last three years.

Veronica is still going strong in her absence, though, averaging a GSAC-best 5.79 kills per game.

Biola is 33-21 against the Lancers all-time and scored a major upset win in the 2006 regular-season finale, beating Cal Baptist 3-1 in La Mirada.

**LAST WEEK:** Biola opened the week with a disappointing 3-0 loss to #1 Fresno Pacific, but rebounded with sweeps over #4 National American and The Master's College.

**JUST WINGIN' IT:** Biola senior Brittany Wing has amassed 999 kills in her four seasons with the Eagles. She needs just one more kill to become just the eighth member of the 1,000 kill club at Biola. Wing also ranks in the top 20 in a number of different career categories including attack attempts (7th), points (8th), kills per game (13th) and assists (14th).

# BIOLA MEN'S SOCCER

## Biola's Tough Stretch Continues with #16 Fresno Pacific and #1 Concordia on Tap

Biola's men's soccer team pulled off one upset and nearly managed to record a second one last week against a pair of nationally-ranked teams.

Much like their volleyball counterparts, the Eagles are in the midst of an extremely difficult portion of their schedule, playing six of eight matches in this stretch against nationally-ranked teams.

This week, the Eagles host #16 Fresno Pacific University in a match with major post-season implications. The teams square off on Wednesday (Oct. 3) at 7:00 p.m. on Al Barbour Field.

On Saturday, Biola travels down to Irvine to face #1 Concordia University at 2:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

**#13 FRESNO PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (7-2-1 Overall, 1-2-0 GSAC):** Despite getting off to a strong non-conference start, the Sun Birds have struggled at the start of the conference schedule. Fresno Pacific lost matches to Point Loma Nazarene and to Azsua Pacific to open GSAC play, but rebounded on Saturday with a 4-2 win over Vanguard.

Leading the way for the Sun Birds is Amaury Nunes, who has 10 goals and an assists on the season already. The senior has scored as many goals as the FPU defense has allowed on the year.

Junior netminder Brandon Cave has a 0.98 goals against average surrendering just 10 goals while making 48 saves and recording four shutouts.

Fresno's offense has been stellar, especially after halftime where 12 of their 18 goals have been scored.

**#1 CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY CA (9-0-0 Overall, 3-0-0 GSAC):** The Eagles have been playing outstanding soccer this season so far and have turned more than a few heads around NAIA soccer circles.

Concordia has not allowed a goal in the

last eight matches after surrendering two to NCAA Division II Cal State Dominguez Hills in a 3-2 win to kick off the season. It has been over 761 minutes since Concordia has allowed a goal against them thanks in large part to senior goalie Mike Borst, who has a microscopic 0.28 goals against average.



**LAST WEEK:** The Eagles nearly pulled off a pair of upsets last week, but ended up have to settle for just one. Biola pulled off an impressive 2-1 win over #20 Vanguard at home on Tuesday, but fell 1-0 at #22 Point Loma Nazarene on Saturday.

Senior Colin Kilpatrick converted on an early PK and junior Nick Bautista knocked home the eventual match-winner as Biola held on for a big win over Vanguard. On Saturday the bounces just didn't go the way of the Eagles as the lone goal came off the foot of a PLNU player, hit the goalie and another defender before finding the back of the net.

## Biola Hosts Fresno Pacific and Travels to Concordia in Search of GSAC Points

Close .... but, no cigar.

It has been one of those seasons for the Biola Women's Soccer team so far as the Eagles have played very well in nearly every match this season, but have walked away with just two wins.

Last week, Biola played to a scoreless tie with #10 Vanguard before falling on a late goal at #5 Point Loma Nazarene on Saturday.

Seven of Biola's eight matches this season have been decided by one or fewer goals and the Eagles have lost four of those.

However, they look to rebound this week against another pair of tough opponents. Biola hosts Fresno Pacific on Tuesday (Oct. 2) at 4:00 p.m., then travels to Irvine to take on #18 Concordia on Saturday (Oct. 6) at Noon.

Here is a closer look at this week's opponent:

### FRESNO PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (5-2-2 Overall, 0-1-2 GSAC):

The Sun Birds are winless in their last three matches after opening the year 5-1-0. Of course, two of those losses came against #2 Azusa Pacific University and #4 Point Loma Nazarene, but they also played to a scoreless draw against Vanguard on Saturday.

Fresno has a strong defense which has allowed just 10 goals this season, though five came in a loss to Azusa Pacific.

The Sun Birds use a platoon at goalkeeper with Justine Caldera and Micah Reyes splitting time in net. Caldera has played the most minutes and has a 0.78 goals against average and four shutouts.

Up front, Ashley Sherr has six goals and five assists on the season to lead the FPU attack.

### #18 CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY (8-2-0 Overall, 2-1-0 GSAC):

The Eagles enter the week in a big first-place tie atop the GSAC standings though its still very early in the season. Concordia was upset to open the conference schedule, falling 2-1 to Cal

Baptist in Riverside. However, they have rebounded nicely with a pair of convincing wins over Hope International and The Master's.

Concordia has outscored its opponents 29-9 this season and has the GSAC's leading scorer in Trina McGee. The sophomore from nearby Whittier Christian has 11 goals on the year including five in two matches last week.



**LAST WEEK:** The Eagles played strong last week despite walking away with just one point. Biola tied #10 Vanguard on Saturday before falling 2-1 at #5 Point Loma. The Eagles hung with the Sea Lions despite playing down two men the final 30 minutes. After tying the match just after half-time, PLNU converted on a penalty kick to go up 2-1 and managed to hang on as the Eagles pressured until the final whistle.

## Biola Women Place First, Men Third at Westmont Invitational

The Biola cross country teams has been off for three weeks, but returns to action on Saturday (Oct. 6) at the Vanguard Invitational at Fairview Park in Costa Mesa.

The Eagles will be able to run against a number of GSAC schools and get a chance to preview the course the GSAC Championship meet will be held on later this month.

Biola's women's squad remained at #9 in the NAIA ratings this week. The Eagles have been ranked in the Top-10 in all but one rating this year and are rated as the second-best team in Region II.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The women's team took top honors and the men finished third while sophomore Kristin Schmidt and senior Brian Ball each won their respective races at the Westmont Invitational on Saturday (Sept. 15).

The Eagle women, who are ranked No.

8 in the latest NAIA National Poll, placed all 10 of their runners in the top 26 out of 79 runners in the field.

Biola finished with 33 points followed by Fresno Pacific with 45 and host Westmont with 61. It was the second meet win in a row for the Eagles.

On the men's side, the order was reversed with the Warriors taking top honors with 32 points followed by Fresno Pacific with 42 and Biola with 54.

Schmidt ran a stellar time of 18:59 and led from start to finish and won by seven seconds. She was followed by freshman Katie Thede, who finished fifth in 19:33.

For the Biola men, Ball had little trouble winning the 8k race, crossing the line in 26:01, 22 seconds ahead of the pack.

Sophomore transfer Ryan Richert placed eighth and finished with a time of 27:25 and was followed by freshman David Kostelyk who was 13th in 28:08.
