Volleyball Hosts Bryan College and San Diego Christian College

Due to the annual Torrey Conference held on campus this week, there will be just two home contests and both will involve the #4-ranked Biola University volleyball team.

Fresh off a marathon five-game win over #15 Vanguard last week, the Eagles return to the friendly confines of Chase Gymnasium where they host Bryan College (Tenn.) and San Diego Christian College this week.

Biola opens the week with a matchup against non-conference foe Bryan College on Monday (Oct. 15) at 7:00 p.m. On Tuesday (Oct. 16), the Eagles return to GSAC play against San Diego Christian College also at 7:00 p.m.

Women's Soccer Hits the Road for a Pair of Games

The Biola women's soccer team plays three of its final four matches on the road beginning with a pair this week.

Coming off impressive performances in their last three matches, the Eagles hope to carry that momentum into the home stretch. That stretch starts with a trip to Santa Barbara on Tuesday (Oct. 16) where Biola takes on Westmont College at 3:00 p.m.

On Friday (Oct. 19), the Eagles travel north for a non-conference match at NCAA Division I Cal State Bakersfield at 7:00 p.m.

Men's Soccer Travels to Westmont With Playoff Aspirations Intact

Biola's men's soccer squad wrapped up an incredibly difficult stretch where six of its last eight matches came against teams ranked in the NAIA Top 25.

The Eagles still have a strong chance of reaching the NAIA Region II playoffs should they win their final three matches of the year, two of which are on the road.

That final push begins this week as Biola travels to Santa Barbara to take on Westmont on Wednesday (Oct. 17) at 3:00 p.m. It is the

only match for the Eagles this week but could likely be a huge match for Biola.

Cross Country Runs for GSAC Titles

The Biola cross country teams begins its final push on Saturday (Oct. 20) at the 2007 GSAC Championships at Fairview Park in Costa Mesa.

The Eagle women are ranked #7 in the NAIA and will likely challenge for its first-ever GSAC team title. On the men's side, Biola looks to move past a number of other GSAC schools in their final tune-up before the NAIA Region II race on Saturday, Nov. 3.

Men's Golf Heads to Concordia Invitational

Biola's men's golf team returns to the links for the first time in almost a month, traveling to Long Beach for the Concordia Invitational at the Skylinks Golf Course on Monday and Tuesday (Oct. 15-16).

The team—in just its first year as a varsity program—placed sixth at The Master's Invitational to open the season.

Biola Swimming Off For Two Weeks

After kicking off the season at the PCSC Relays last week, the Biola men's and women's swim teams take a two week break before returning to action on Saturday, Nov. 3 in a dual against Pomona-Pitzer.

#4 Biola Hosts Early Week Matches, Travels to PLNU on Saturday

The Biola University women's volleyball team plays three matches this week, opening up with two at home and wrapping it up at Point Loma Nazarene.

The Eagles have won two straight after falling to #2 Cal Baptist, including a thrilling 3-2 win over #15 Vanguard on Thursday.

Biola opens the week with a non-conference match against Bryan College of Tennessee on Monday (Oct. 15) at 7:00 p.m. On Tuesday (Oct. 16), the Eagles return to GSAC play to take on San Diego Christian at 7:00 p.m.

The week ends with Biola traveling to San Diego to face Point Loma Nazarene on Saturday (Oct. 20) at 3:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

BRYAN COLLEGE TN (16-6 overall): The Lions hail from Dayton, Tennessee, and are members of the Appalachian Athletic Conference and the NAIA's Region XII. Currently, Bryan College is in second place in the AAC and ranked atop the Region XII rankings with a 16-6 overall record.

The Lions had a nine-match winning streak snapped on Friday in a five-game loss to conference rival University of Virginia-Wise. Despite the loss, Bryan has still won 13 of its last 15 matches.

The Lions are ranked 13th in the NAIA in kills per game (15.11) and 16th in hitting percentage (.269). Bryan College's offense is led by middle blocker Robin Renfroe and outside hitter Gabby Claxton.

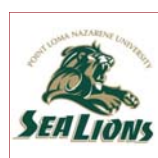
Renfroe is averaging 3.5 kills and 1.4 blocks per game and also has 55 aces on the season. Claxton adds 3.17 kills per game and has 44 blocks on the season.

SAN DIEGO CHRISTIAN COLLEGE (6-17 Overall, 0-12 GSAC):

The Cougars have struggled through the first-half of the GSAC schedule, winning just three games in conference play through their first 12 matches.

San Diego Christian was missing stats for nine non-conference matches but for their 12 conference matches the Cougars were led by outside hitter Meggan Chapin. The junior from Oregon has 133 kills (3.02/game). Paige Vandebroek adds 113 kills (2.63/game).

#10 POINT LOMA NAZARENE UNIVERSITY (13-8 Overall, 5-7 GSAC):



The Sea Lions opened up the second half of the conference schedule with a shocking five-game loss at Westmont College last week.

With the loss, Point Loma has now dropped two of its last three matches with a showdown against #15 Vanguard looming on Tuesday.

Point Loma leads the GSAC with 2.72 blocks per game and has the top three individual blockers in the conference.

Outside hitter Melissa Boer leads the Sea Lions with 259 kills (3.70/game).

Biola swept Point Loma when the two met earlier this season in La Mirada.

Eagles Travel to Westmont for Lone Match of the Week

Despite playing through an incredibly difficult schedule, the Biola men's soccer team still has a realistic chance of making it to the postseason.

The road will not be easy as it is likely the Eagles will need wins in each of their final three matches in order to qualify. Biola is currently in a four-way tie for sixth in the conference and holds wins over two of the teams with and a match remaining against the other: Cal Baptist.

The NAIA Region II playoff field was expanded recently to include eight teams. Traditionally, all but one school in the regional playoffs has come from the GSAC. If Biola can finish among the top seven in the conference, it is likely the team will make the playoffs.

The Eagles open the final push with a match on Wednesday (Oct. 17) at Westmont College at 3:00 p.m. It will be the lone match for the team this week.

Here is a closer look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

WESTMONT COLLEGE (5-7-0 Overall, 1-6-0 GSAC): The Warriors, traditionally one of the best teams in the GSAC,

have fallen on tough times this year. They have lost six straight matches after opening the conference schedule with a win over then-#20 Vanguard. In their defense, the last four matches have come against nationally-ranked teams and they have played well in three of the four.

While the losses have been mounting, most of the matches have been heart-breaking, last-second losses. Last week, the Warriors held a 2-1 lead over #2 Azusa Pacific before the Cougars scored once in the final 10 minutes of regulation and again in overtime to pull out the win.

The main problem for Westmont has been on the offensive side of the ball. The Warriors have been outscored in GSAC play by a 13-5 margin and have just 15 goals on the season.

Five of those goals have come off the foot of senior midfielder Johnny Alcatraz, a transfer from UC Santa Barbara. He also has five assists on the year giving him a part of 10 of the Warriors' 15 goals.

Junior midfielder Sammy Montemer has added three goals and two assists, including a pair of match-winners.

Westmont has dominated the all-time series, leading 41-10-8. Last season the Warriors knocked off the Eagles 1-0 in La Mirada.

LAST WEEK: Biola wrapped up a tough eight-game stretch with a strong showing last week, defeating Hope International 2-0 before falling to #2 Azusa Pacific by the same score.

Colin Kilpatrick and Derek Friehe netted goals as the Eagles survived an overly-physical game against Hope. Freshman netminder Tyler Higgins recorded four saves to earn the shutout.

On Saturday, Biola was unable to record the upset over APU, despite playing a strong game throughout.

Biola Begins Three-Game Road Trip With Trips to Westmont, Bakersfield

The season is beginning to wind down for the Biola women's soccer team, but the race for the playoffs is just heating up.

It has been two years since Biola last made the playoffs, but there is a good chance the Eagles may be able to sneak into one of the final spots with a strong showing in their final four matches.

Biola is in eighth place in the GSAC, one point behind Fresno for seventh and three behind Vanguard for sixth. Should the Eagles record wins in their final three conference matches, it is possible they could make the NAIA Region II tourney.

However, the road is a tough one and the road is where Biola finds itself for three of its final four matches.

This week, the Eagles travel to Santa Barbara for a match against Westmont College on Tuesday (Oct. 16) at 3:00 p.m. and head to Bakersfield to face NCAA Division I Cal State Bakersfield on Friday (Oct. 19) at 7:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at this week's opponent:

WESTMONT COLLEGE (7-5-1 Overall, 4-2-1 GSAC): For the first time in nearly a decade, the Warriors find themselves un-



ranked in the NAIA National Poll. Westmont struggled to a 4-4-0 record out of the gate, but has since lost just once in its last six matches, including a stunning overtime win over #4 Point Loma Nazarene in Santa Barbara.

The Warriors have scored 18 goals this year with 12 coming in the first half. After taking early leads, Westmont uses its suffocating defense to thwart any scoring chances by its opponents.

Eleven different players have scored for the Warriors, led by the four goals from junior forward Amy Lawson.

In goal, Roxanne Love has allowed just six goals (0.60 GAA) on the season.

CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD (3-10-1 Overall): The Roadrunners are in their second year of the five-year transition process

moving the athletics program from NCAA Division II to Division I.



This is the first season in which CSUB has played the majority of games against NCAA Division I competi-

tion. The 'Runners have struggled this year and have won just once in their last eight matches, recording a 3-0 win over Houston Baptist on Friday.

Cal State Bakersfield has scored just eight goals on the season with four coming in the last two matches. Leading the Roadrunners is sophomore forward Alexa Vickroy, who has four goals on the year.

GABBING THE SPOTLIGHT: Freshman forward Gabby Jolin netted a hat trick on Wednesday in Biola's 5-1 win over Hope. Jolin, who teamed up with freshman Tara Roetter on the three goals, now has five goals on the season—all of which have come in the last four matches she has played.

Biola Harriers Look for Strong Showing at the 2007 GSAC Championships

The Biola cross country teams are beginning to head into the home stretch of season with the conference and regional championships meets on the horizon.

The Eagles begin the final push on Saturday (Oct. 20) with the 2007 GSAC Championship race at Fairview Park in Costa Mesa. The women's 5K race begins at 3:30 p.m. with the men's 8K race following at 4:30 p.m.

The Biola University women's team moved up in the NAIA National rankings to #7 overall and sit in second in the regional rankings.

The Eagle women have a strong shot at winning their first-ever GSAC title. The main competition in the meet comes from #3 Azusa Pacific. APU edged Biola by 16 points at the Cal State Fullerton Invitational to start the season in the only race between the two thus far. However, it should be the first of three races between the two

over the next five weeks.

On the men's side, Biola's Brian Ball will look to continue his dominance and has a strong shot at taking the individual title. He established a new course record at Fairview Park with a 24:44.40 during the Vanguard Invitational two weeks ago.

APU and Concordia are the odds-on favorites to battle for the team title. But Biola's focus will be on beating out the other four teams in the middle of the pack in Vanguard, The Master's, Fresno Pacific and Westmont College.

The Eagles are receiving votes again in the national poll and can move ahead of a number of teams ranked higher with a strong performance in the race Saturday.

At the Vanguard Invitational two weeks ago, the women placed first and the men took fifth with the third fastest team time in the meet. If Biola can repeat that success, it should be a great meet for the Eagles.
