Soccer Teams Host Season Finales on Saturday against San Diego Christian

It is hard to believe that the fall sports seasons are already winding down, but the men's and women's soccer teams wrap up the regular season this week.

Both teams travel to California Baptist during the week before wrapping things up on Saturday at home against San Diego Christian College.

The men's team is up first in both matches. The Eagles open things up at Cal Baptist on Tuesday (Oct. 23) at 3:00 p.m. and finish the season at home against San Diego Christian on Saturday (Oct. 27) at 4:30 p.m.

For the women, Biola travels to Riverside to face Cal Baptist on Wednesday (Oct. 24) at 3:00 p.m. before wrapping up the 2007 campaign at home against San Diego Christian on Saturday (Oct. 27) at 7:00 p.m.

During Saturday's matches, the teams will be honoring their departing seniors during a ceremony before each contest.

Volleyball hosts Hope, Travels to Michigan for Madonna Tournament

The Biola volleyball team plays a total of five matches this week as the Eagles travel to Michigan for the 2007 Crusader Classic Tournament hosted by Madonna University this weekend.

The Eagles open the week with a GSAC match against local rival Hope International University on Tuesday (Oct. 23) at 7:00 p.m. before making the long trip on Friday and Saturday (Oct. 26-27).

Biola will play the University of Michigan-Dearborn and Walsh University on Friday before taking on host Madonna University and Lee University on Saturday.

Women's Basketball kicks off with pair of non-counting contests

While the fall sports season are just about to wrap up, the winter sports seasons are just

around the corner. The Biola women's basketball team opens up the 2007-08 season this week with a pair of non-counting games.

On Wednesday (Oct. 24), Biola welcomes El Camino College to Chase Gymnasium for a scrimmage beginning at 6:00 p.m. The Eagles play again on Saturday (Oct. 27), traveling down to La Jolla to face NCAA Division II UC San Diego in an exhibition game at 7:00 p.m.

GSAC Basketball Coaches pick preseason favorites

The GSAC preseason basketball coaches poll was released late last week with no surprises at the top of either poll.

On the men's side, Concordia, which reached the NAIA Finals last year, was tabbed #1 in the poll with 10 first place votes. Azusa Pacific was picked second with Point Loma Nazarene third and Biola picked fourth.

The women's poll was a bit closer than expected though Vanguard, which was ranked #1 nationally throughout most of last season, earned nine first place votes. Point Loma and Azusa Pacific were a close second and third, respectively. The Eagles were tabbed to finish eighth, though in a close mix between fifth and ninth places overall.

#4 Biola Hosts Hope International, Travels to Michigan for Tournament

The Biola University volleyball team is prepping for a busy week which opens with a home GSAC match against Hope International on Tuesday (Oct. 20) at 7:00 p.m.

After that, the Eagles travel to Livonia, Michigan, for the Crusader Classic Tournament hosted by Madonna University on Friday and Saturday (Oct. 26-27).

Here is a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

HOPE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (6-13 overall, 3-11 GSAC): The Royals have improved noticeably since last season and have given a number of teams a good run already this season. Just last week, Hope took #5 Azusa Pacific to four



games before ultimately falling to the Cougars. The Royals three wins have come against San Diego Christian and The Master's.

Leading the way for Hope is Jillian Lane, who has 273 kills (4.01/game), 303 digs (4.46/game) and 18 aces.

Biola is 21-1 all-time against the Royals. Earlier this season, the Eagles swept Hope 30-24, 30-20, 30-17.

UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN-DEARBORN (20-14 Overall): The Wolves are out of the Wolverine-Hoosier Athletic Conference, an eight-team conference in NAIA Region VIII. They are currently in third place in the conference and fifth in the region.



Freshman outside hitter Courtney Provencher leads UMD with 366 kills (2.75/game) while senior middle blocker Kristi Igo adds 334 (2.55/game).

This will be the second time these teams have faced each other with Biola sweeping the Wolves at the Fort Lewis CO touney in 2003.

WALSH UNIVERSITY (22-5 Overall): The Cavaliers are the defending champions of the American Midwest Conference and compete in the NAIA Region IX where they are currently second behind #17 Mt. Vernon Nazarene.



A pair of Megans lead the way for the Cavs as Megan McDonald has 339 kills (3.8/game)

and Megan Kelly adds 307 (3.4/game).

Biola last faced Walsh in the 2003 NAIA Tournament where the Eagles prevailed 3-2 in a pool play match.

MADONNA UNIVERSITY MI (24-8 Overall): The Crusaders entered the season ranked



#7 in the preseason poll. However, they struggled out of the gate and currently unranked despite being first in the WHAC. Madonna was swept in a pair of matches by Point Loma Nazarene earlier this season.

Leading the way for the Crusaders is Lubovj Tihomirova, who has nearly 1/3rd of the team's kills with 645 (5.86/game). After that, Mary McGinnis has 375 kills (3.41/game).

LEE UNIVERSITY TN (14-11 Overall): The Flames are currently second in Region XIII, but are a ways behind University of Mobile. Lee had won 10 of its last 11 matches before a four-match losing streak which included losses to National American University and Dickenson State, both ranked in the NAIA Top 10.



The Flames are led by the 363 kills (4.0/game) from Tina Questel and is the only one who has more than 2.5 kills per game on the roster. The last time these two teams met was in 1995 when Biola swept Lee.

Eagles Wrap Up Regular Season against Cal Baptist and San Diego Christian

The Biola men's soccer team plays its final two regular-season matches this week, traveling to Riverside to face off against California Baptist University before hosting San Diego Christian College in the season finale.

The Eagles travel east to take on Cal Baptist on Tuesday (Oct. 23) at 3:00 p.m. With the threat of fire and smoke in the area, the game time and date may be changed. Updates will be available on the Biola Athletics website at (<http://athletics.biola.edu>).

The regular season wraps up on Saturday (Oct. 27) with the annual Senior Night contest against San Diego Christian College. Before the match starts, Biola will honor its departing seniors with a special ceremony, with the match kicking off at 4:30 p.m.

Here is a closer look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

CALIFORNIA BAPTIST UNIVERSITY (6-8-1 Overall, 2-6-0 GSAC):

The Lancers are struggling through a season similar to Biola's as both teams find themselves with just two wins just a year after reaching the NAIA playoffs. Cal Baptist has lost five straight games after back-to-back wins over Hope and San Diego Christian. Two of those losses came in double overtime.

After scoring 21 goals through the first 10 matches, the Lancers have scored just four goals in five matches since and have been outscored 14-4 during the five match losing streak.

Cesar Nava and Christian Diaz lead the Lancers in scoring with seven and five goals, respectively. Nava has recorded a goal and two assists over the last five matches.

In goal, Adam Kramer has started 10 of the 15 matches on the season and posted a 4-5-1 record with a 1.41 goals against average.

Biola holds an 18-6-1 series lead over the Lancers, but has lost the last four

matches played between the two in Riverside. Last season, Biola scored with just under three minutes remaining in regulation to defeat CBU 2-1 in La Mirada.

SAN DIEGO CHRISTIAN COLLEGE (6-9-0 Overall, 0-8-0 GSAC):

The Hawks opened the season strong, winning five of their first six games. However, since that point, they have won just once in their last nine games. Eight of those were GSAC contests where SDCC has scored just one goal and has gone 579:09 without scoring a goal in a conference match.

Antonio Sa and Jacob Allen each have 11 points on the year with Sa recording five goals and Allen adding three.

Biola has lost just twice in 17 matches against San Diego Christian all time. The Eagles have scored at least five goals against the Hawks in each of the last three meetings including winning 5-2 in El Cajon last season.

Biola Opens Season This Week With Games Against El Camino, UCSD

The 2007-08 Biola University women's basketball team kicks off the season this week with a scrimmage and an exhibition contest.

The Eagles kick off the new season with a scrimmage against El Camino College on Wednesday (Oct. 24). The scrimmage will begin at 6:00 p.m. and consist of two 20-minute halves with a few 10-minute periods if time allows. While no "official" score will be kept, the game will give Head Coach Ken Crawford a chance to see his squad in game situations and try out numerous combinations.

Saturday (Oct. 27), Biola travels to La Jolla to square off against NCAA Division II powerhouse UC San Diego in an exhibition contest at 7:00 p.m. The Tritons won the Division II West Region title and reached the National Semifinals in 2006-07. Despite losing a total of eight players from that team, UCSD is one of those traditional powerhouse programs that continues to find strong players year after year.

Biola's first regular season game comes on Friday, Nov. 2 as the Eagles take on Westminster College (Utah) in the first day of the Holy Names Tournament.

Six New Faces Join the Biola Squad

Coach Crawford had a busy off-season, adding a number of talented players to the Biola roster.

In the post, the Eagles added Christina Barclay, a 6-foot-4 post player from Santa Rosa's Montgomery High School.

Barclay, an All-North Bay League pick, averaged 12 points and 11.5 rebounds during her senior season with the Vikings, helping Montgomery to a 29-4 record and a spot in the CIF NorCal semifinals.

Biola also added depth at forward with the addition of Megan Jackson from Buena High School in Ventura, Jenna French from nearby La Serna HS, and Jessi Conicelli from Arrowhead Christian in Redlands.

Jackson scored 7.3 points and had 5.5 rebounds a game, helping the Bulldogs to a 23-6 record and a spot in the CIF Southern Section Division I-AA quarterfinals.

French is coming off an amazing senior season at La Serna where she averaged 20.1 points,

13.9 rebounds and 2.2 assists on the season, helping the team win its third straight Del Rio League title and finish 26-4 overall. The 5-11 post player was named the Whittier Daily News girls basketball Player of the Year and also earned All-CIF first-team honors for her efforts.

Conicelli comes to Biola from Arrowhead Christian Academy where she averaged 20.1 points and 14.7 rebounds per game, and earned CIF Player of the Year honors for Division IV-AA as well as Christian League MVP honors.

Rounding out the newcomers are guards Charrise Reese and Chardonnay Nelson.

Reece, a 5-4 point guard, is also from Santa Rosa's Montgomery High School. Reece, who was a four-time All-North Bay League selection, averaged 8.8 points per game and added 5.8 assists and 4.5 steals per contest to lead the Vikings to a 29-4 record.

Nelson, who returns to La Mirada after two seasons at Dominican University, averaged 12 points and six rebounds as a sophomore, earning all-California Pacific Conference honors. As a freshman, she scored seven points and had four rebound a game en route to being named Cal Pac Freshman of the Year.
