Volleyball Begins Final Stretch With “Scary” Week of Games

While little boys and girls across the country are picking out their scariest outfits for trick-or-treating, the Biola volleyball team will be preparing for something scary as well: back-to-back matches against the #1 and #3 teams in the NAIA.

The week begins with the Eagles traveling to Irvine for a match against #3 Concordia University on Tuesday (Oct. 30). The next night (Oct. 31), Biola hosts #1 Fresno Pacific University at Chase Gymnasium. Both matches will begin at 7:00 p.m.

The Eagles close out the week on Saturday (Nov. 3) against The Master’s College in the only remaining match against a non-ranked team.

Biola swept five matches last week including four at the Crusader Classic in Michigan. The Eagles took home the team title at the Classic and junior outside hitter Meghan Warkentin was named the Tournament MVP.

Women’s Basketball Begins 2007-08 Season at Holy Names Tournament

The Eagles open the 2007-08 campaign on Friday and Saturday (Nov. 2-3) at the Holy Names Tip-Off Classic Tournament. The Eagles open against Westminster College of Utah on Friday at 6:00 p.m.

The winner of the Biola/Westminster game will take on the winner of the Holy Names vs. Warner Pacific contest on Saturday at 8:00 p.m. while the losers play at 6:00 p.m.

Biola played a pair of non-counting games this past week. The Eagles hosted a scrimmage against El Camino College and an exhibition against UC San Diego. Biola was narrowly edged 60-54 by the Tritons on Saturday in a game that was moved up to Biola due to the fires in the San Diego area.

The Eagles travel to Tennessee for another tournament on Sept. 9-10.

Cross Country looks for strong showing at NAIA Region II Championships

With a trip to the NAIA National Championships on the line, the Biola men’s and women’s cross country teams head north to Fresno for the 2007 NAIA Region II Championships on Saturday (Nov. 3) at Woodward Park.

The Biola women moved up one spot in the NAIA Ratings to #6 overall after finishing second in the GSAC Championships two weeks ago. The Eagles are looking to earn their first trip to the NAIA National Championship in recent memory.

The men’s teams is in a pack of four teams vying for one of 14 wild card berths into the NAIA Championships. The Eagles would need to finish in the top four to realistically have a shot of qualifying.

Swimming Duals Against Pomona-Pitzer and Cal State East Bay

The Biola University swim team returns to action for its first dual meets of the season, taking on Pomona-Pitzer and Cal State East Bay in a double dual at Pomona on Saturday (Nov. 3).

The Eagles got off to an impressive start two weeks ago at the Pacific Collegiate Swimming Conference relays at Cal Baptist with a number of swimmers already qualifying for the NAIA National Championships in March.

Soccer teams end season on fun note

The Biola University men’s and women’s soccer teams wrapped up their season on Saturday with a co-ed, intersquad scrimmage. The scheduled match against San Diego Christian was canceled due to the fires. The men finished at 7-10-0 and the women were 3-11-2. BIOLA VOLLEYBALL

#4 Biola Plays at #3 Concordia, Hosts #1 Fresno Pacific During Busy Week

The Biola University volleyball team is prepping for another busy week which seems the team taking on the #1 and #3 teams in the NAIA before wrapping things up at The Master's on Saturday.

The Eagles returned from a very successful trip to Michigan where they swept all four matches en route to the Tournament Championship. However, things are a bit tougher here in the GSAC, and that is where Biola finds itself playing the final five matches of the season.

First up is a road contest at #3 Concordia University on Tuesday (Oct. 30). Things don't get any easier as Biola hosts #1 Fresno Pacific on Wednesday (Oct. 31). The week ends on Saturday (Nov. 3) at The Master's College in Biola's only match against an unranked team the rest of the year.

Here is a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

#3 CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY (21-3 overall, 12-3 GSAC): The Eagles continue to roll through another successful season, losing just three matches on the season—twice to #2 Cal Baptist and once to #1 Fresno Pacific.



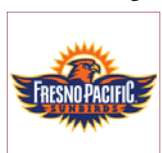
Concordia is without the big, foreign players possessed by the two teams ahead of it in the national poll, but Coach Paula Weishoff's team remains a powerhouse thanks to great recruiting.

Among the top players on the team is junior Tracy Weemer, a former NCAA Division II Freshman of the Year at Cal State San Bernardino. Weemer leads Concordia with 257 kills (3.52/game) and adds 274 digs (3.75/game).

Earlier this season, Biola experienced that first hand as Concordia pulled off a 30-25, 30-18, 30-22 sweep in La Mirada.

Overall, Biola leads the all-time series 32-8, but has just one win against Concordia since 2003.

#1 FRESNO PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (25-0 Overall, 15-0 GSAC): The Sunbirds continue to roll through the NAIA schedule with absolute



precision and seem poised to take home another NAIA National Championship. Fresno Pacific has swept its opponents in its last 13 straight matches and really hasn't been tested since winning in

five at #2 Cal Baptist on Sept. 8. Leading the international contingent is Brazilian Fabiana Loamil, who has 309 kills (4.12/game).

Shu Liu, from Shen Yang, China, is averaging 13.25 assists per game.

The Sunbirds are 39-21 against Biola all-time including a 30-25, 30-17, 30-18 win in Fresno earlier this season. Fresno Pacific has won the last 21 matches against the Eagles, a string which dates back to 1997.

THE MASTER'S COLLEGE (12-14 Overall, 3-11 GSAC): The Mustangs pulled off a



big upset on Saturday, sweeping #10 Point Loma Nazarene in Santa Clarita. Bross Gym, on the campus of The Master's College, is a tough place for opponents to play and could prove a challenge to the Eagles on Saturday.

The Mustangs are led by Amanda Roleder, who has 340 kills (3.95/game) and as many digs on the season.

Biola is 36-1 against The Master's in the all-time series, and has won 33 straight against the Mustangs.

Eagles Prepare to Make Statement at NAIA Region II Championships

The Biola cross country teams continue their post-season push on Saturday (Nov. 3) as they travel north in search of a trip to the NAIA National Championships at Woodward Park in Fresno.

The stakes are high at the regional meet with the winning team securing a berth in the National Championship meet. The other teams must battle for one of 14 at-large spots awarded based on standing in the NAIA Rankings.

In addition, the top seven individuals whose team who ran on a team that did not qualify, will earn an individual trip to the NAIA Championships.

The Eagle women moved up a spot in the NAIA National Rankings and are now #6 in the country after finishing second at the GSAC Championships. The team has been an impressive success story, making a huge one-year turnaround from a program that languished near the bottom of the

GSAC for many years.

Leading the way for the women's team is sophomore Kristen Schmidt, who placed third overall at the GSAC Championships last week. Freshman Katie Thede and senior Anna Thibodo also earned all-GSAC recognition, finishing eighth and 14th, respectively.

On the men's side, senior Brian Ball is well on his way to another NAIA Nationals trip and hopes to bring the rest of the team with him this time. Ball finished second at the GSAC Championships and was an NAIA All-American last year, finishing 26th overall.

Biola will be in the mix with five other teams, battling for third through seventh places in the Regional field. At the GSAC Championships, the Eagles were sixth overall, but finished just 19 points behind third-place Vanguard. Third through seventh place was separated by just 25 points.

Swimmers Head to Pomona for Double Dual Meet on Saturday

The 2007-08 Biola University men's and women's swim teams travel to Pomona for their first dual meet of the season, taking on Pomona-Pitzer and Cal State East Bay on Saturday (Nov. 3).

With the young season just underway, the swimmers are just managing to get into their rhythm, though that hasn't stopped a number of them from qualifying for the NAIA National Championships already.

Two weeks ago, the Eagles kicked off their season at the PCSC relays in Riverside, taking on a number of schools from the Pacific Collegiate Swim Conference, which Biola is a member of.

The Pentathlon, which was held on Friday, consisted of five events that every swimmer competes in. At the end of the five events their total time was tallied, and the ten swimmers with the lowest times received awards. On Saturday, the Eagles returned to compete in a meet consisting only of relays.

Biola came out strong on Friday as April

Smith place fifth overall in the long IM pentathlon for the women. On the men's side, Ben Oviedo and Zach Perkins placed fifth in the long IM pentathlon and the freestyle pentathlon respectively.

On Saturday the Eagles fared well against some strong competition in the relay meet. The women placed 7th overall, just edging out Fresno Pacific whose swim team is in their inaugural year. The men also managed to edge out Fresno Pacific on their way to a fourth place overall finish.

During the weekend there were several national qualifying swims. Qualifiers on the women's side were: Erika Johnson 200, 500 Free; April Smith 100 Free, 100 Breast, 200 IM; and Sarah Warkentin 100, 200, 500 Free. The male qualifiers were: Paul Mendoza 200, 500 Free; Ben Oviedo 100 Back, 100 Fly, 200 IM; and Zach Perkins 50, 200 Free.

The men and women also qualified in the 200, 400, and 800 Freestyle relays and the 400 Medley relay.

Biola Plays First Regular-Season Games at Holy Names Tournament

The 2007-08 Biola women's basketball season officially kicks off this week with the Eagles opening the season with a tournament at Holy Names University in Oakland this weekend.

Biola takes on Westminster College (Utah) on Friday (Nov. 2) in its first regular-season game. Tip-off is slated for 6:00 p.m. Afterward, Holy Names hosts Warner Pacific College in the second game of the Classic.

On Saturday (Nov. 3), the tournament wraps up with the winners from the two games on the first day playing at 8:00 p.m. and the losers playing at 6:00 p.m.

Biola shot well, but turned the ball over too many times, falling 60-54 in an exhibition contest against UC San Diego on Saturday. The Tritons, who reached the NCAA Division II Final Four last season, used a late run to pull away from the Eagles and win the contest.

Biola also took on El Camino College in a scrimmage earlier in the week though an official score was not kept.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

WESTMINSTER COLLEGE UTAH (2006-07 Record: 22-12 Overall):

The Griffins had a strong season last year, reaching the NAIA National Tournament. They beat Point Loma Nazarene in the first round before falling 80-63 to Southern Nazarene in the round of 16.

The Griffins return just four players from last seasons' squad, but do return their two leading scorers in guards Elisa Leader (13.91 ppg, 3.06 rpg) and Shannon Evans (13.12 ppg, 4.59 rpg, 4.59 apg).

Biola is 1-1 all-time against the Griffins. Westminster downed the Eagles 73-61 in Salt Lake City in 2004 the last time the two teams did battle.

HOLY NAMES UNIVERSITY CA (2006-07 Record: 16-13 Overall):

The Cougars finished the 2006-07 season with a disappointing loss to Dominican in the California Pacific Conference Championship semifinals after a promising run through the final two weeks of the season.

Holy Names has just nine players on its preseason roster, but boasts three from the state

of Hawaii. All three were all-state selections and could prove to be dominant for the Cougars when joined with a strong returning cast.

Leading the returners is senior guard Angelita Hutton, who averaged just over 12 points per game for the Cougars in 2006-07. She is joined by senior forward Martha Spivey, who scored 9.07 points per game and pulled down 8.5 boards.

Holy Names has won two of three games between the two schools including a 63-57 win over the Eagles in La Mirada last season.

WARNER PACIFIC COLLEGE OR (2006-07 Overall: 12-16):

The Knights return just one of their three best scorers from the 2006-07 season, which saw them finish with a 12-16 record overall. The leading returner is junior forward Danica Wilson, who scored 10.6 points per game and added 5.5 rebounds. However, Warner Pacific lost their leading scorer, Nicole Brown, to graduation. Brown averaged 18.5 ppg in 2006-07.

The Knights have four seniors on the squad this season, though just one has been a regular starter on the squad. Guard Lindsey Wells started all 30 games for Warner Pacific last year, averaging five points and just over three assists per contest.

The two teams have met on the court just once before and that was way back in January of 1988 when the Eagles lost 72-64.

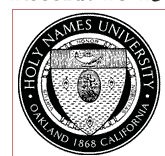
