Men's and Women's Soccer Hosts Azusa Pacific on Saturday

Biola's men's and women's soccer teams have each had tough seasons and have been struggling lately. However, on Saturday (Oct. 13) the Eagles play host to their arch-rivals Azusa Pacific which means records can be thrown out the window. Those rivalry games have a way of being close, hard-fought matches despite season records and this year's doubleheader will be no different.

The APU match caps a busy week for the women's soccer team which hosts NCAA Division II Cal State San Bernardino on Monday (Oct. 8) and GSAC foe Hope International on Wednesday (Oct. 10). Both matches start at 7:00 p.m.

The Biola men have just one other match, traveling to Fullerton to face Hope International on Tuesday (Oct. 9).

Volleyball Hosts Westmont, Travels to Vanguard

The Eagles open the second half of the GSAC schedule this week by hosting Westmont College on Tuesday (Oct. 9) at 7:00 p.m. in Chase Gymnasium.

Biola then travels to Costa Mesa to battle for what should be a good match against #18 Vanguard University on Thursday (Oct. 11) at 7:00 p.m.

The Eagles, ranked #4 in the latest NAIA National ratings, have just three losses on the season, all of which have come at the hands of the three teams ahead of them in the NAIA Poll.

Swimmers Open Season at PCSC Relays in Riverside

The Biola University men's and women's swim teams take to the water for the first time this season at the Pacific Collegiate Swimming Conference Relays on

Friday and Saturday (Oct. 12-13). The meet is being hosted by Cal Baptist.

Both Eagle squads placed seventh at the NAIA National Championships last year. The 2007 Biola teams are filled with underclassmen and the meet will offer them a chance to "get their feet wet" in the world of college swimming.

Cross Country and Golf are off this week

The Biola cross country teams performed quite well at the Vanguard Invitational last week and have two weeks of before returning to Costa Mesa for the GSAC Championships. Biola's women, ranked #9 in the NAIA, won their third straight meet while the men ran one of the fastest races in school history en route to placing fifth. #4 Biola Starts Second-Half of GSAC Schedule Hosting Westmont Tuesday

The Biola University women's volleyball team wrapped up the first half of the GSAC schedule with a respectable 7-3 record. The three losses came at the hands of the three teams ahead of them in the conference and in the NAIA poll. The Eagles had little trouble with the other GSAC schools, losing just two games to the fifth through 11th place teams in the conference.

Now, the task becomes repeating the feat during the second half of the schedule to earn one of the four NAIA National Tournament berths from the GSAC conference. There is a lot of volleyball to be played between now and then and in the toughest conference in the country, no match can be taken for granted.

The Eagles open the second half with GSAC matches against Westmont College and Vanguard University. Biola hosts Westmont on Tuesday (Oct. 9) in Chase Gymnasium, then travel to Costa Mesa to face Vanguard on Thursday (Oct. 11).

Here is a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

WESTMONT COLLEGE (10-9 overall, 3-7 GSAC):

The Warriors have won their last three matches after dropping nine of their previous ten. Westmont has been one of those teams in the conference that seems to be able to hang around in each game they play and seem to

be capable of pulling a stunning upset on any given night.

Westmont plays tough defense led by its senior libero Melinda Reese, who is averaging over eight digs per game and is one of the best defenders in the GSAC.

Sophomore middle blocker Katelyn Lowry leads the offensive attack with 3.22 kills and 0.95 blocks per game. Freshman outside hitter Beth Widicus contributes 3.21 kills per game to the Warrior attack.

Biola holds a 41-18 edge in the all-time series including pulling off a 30-26, 30-26, 30-15 sweep over the Warriors earlier this season. The Eagles also hold a 22-7 record against Westmont in La Mirada.

#18 VANGUARD UNIVERSITY (6-9 Overall, 4-6 GSAC): The Lions have been playing a lot better than their record would indicate,

taking #5 National American University to five games two weeks ago and hanging with a number of the top teams in the GSAC.

Vanguard has one the conference's best hitters in sophomore outside hitter Kelsey Wirt.



She has amassed 221 kills (3.88 kills/game) on the season and is also among the team leaders in digs, blocks, services aces and hitting percentage. Wirt posted 17 kills as the Lions were swept

by the Eagles earlier this season.

Biola is 40-7 against the Lions all-time and have won 19 of the last 22 in the series.

LAST WEEK: Biola wrapped up the first half of the GSAC schedule with an exciting 3-1 win over #8 Azusa Pacific on Tuesday but fell 3-0 to #2 California Baptist on Saturday.

1,000 ... JUST IN TIME: Biola senior Brittany Wing recorded 12 kills against #8 Azusa Pacific, giving her 1,011 in her career and making her one of just eight players in school history to record over 1,000. The match may also end up being the final one of her career as she injured her knee late in the match and her return to the court is unlikely.

BIOLA MEN'S SOCCER

Eagles Travel to Hope, Host Arch-Rival Azusa Pacific on Saturday

One of the toughest stretches in the history of the Biola men's soccer team is just about over ... and not a moment too soon.

The Eagles play two matches this week to close out an eight-game stretch which has seen them taking on six nationally-ranked teams including the top two teams in the NAIA Poll.

Last week the Eagles were beaten by #10 Fresno Pacific and #1 Concordia. This week, Biola travels to Fullerton to take on Hope International on Tuesday (Oct. 9) before hosting #2 Azusa Pacific on Saturday (Oct. 13).

Here is a closer look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

HOPE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (8-4-0 Overall, 2-2-0 GSAC): The Royals have been one of the biggest surprises in the GSAC this season. Since joining

the conference in 1999, the Royals are a combined 6-70-2 in GSAC matches, never winning more than two in any season. However, this year they have already reached that plateau and look ready to make a serious run toward the playoffs.

Sophomore midfielder Jose Andrade leads the Royals with eight goals and three assists (19 points) on the season. The transfer from Cal State Northridge has played in just 10 matches this season and scored the match-winner in the 90th minute as Hope upset #9 Westmont last week.

Biola has never lost to Hope (14-0-0) and has just five goals to the Royals all-time.

#2 AZUSA PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (11-0-0 Overall, 4-0-0 GSAC): The Cougars

are once again off to a stellar start one year after reaching the NAIA Championship match. While Azusa and Biola seem to be going in different directions this year, the Eagles would

like to hand the Cougars their first loss of the season.

Azusa Pacific has had little trouble scoring goals this season, outscoring opponents 37-4 through 11 matches. Senior forward Steven Lenhart has tallied 10 goals on the year, good enough for second in the conference thus far.

Junior goalkeeper James Crawford has allowed just four goals and has a 0.45 goals against average.

Azusa holds a slight 25-19-6 edge in the all-time series but is 7-1-1 against the Eagles since 1998. Last year, the Cougars won a heart-breaker in Azusa, scoring twice in the final 10 minutes to send the game to overtime where they eventually won 3-2.

LAST WEEK: Biola managed to do what no other GSAC school had done in 2007 and that is score against #1 Concordia. The Eagles Nick Bautista netted a goal to knot the score at 1-1 on Saturday, but it was not enough as CUI eventually won 3-1.

Biola also lost 1-0 to #10 Fresno Pacific on Wednesday after surrendering an early goal to the Sunbirds.

BIOLA WOMEN'S SOCCER

Biola Hosts Three Matches This Week Culminating With APU Clash Saturday

The Biola women's soccer team has a busy week this week, hosting three matches including a pair of GSAC games.

The Eagles are looking to recover from a frustrating week which saw them play well, but only record a single point.

The Eagles start things off early this week, hosting NCAA Division II Cal State San Bernardino on Monday (Oct. 8). They return to action on Wednesday (Oct. 10) against Hope International University, then close out the week against arch-rival #2 Azusa Pacific University on Saturday (Oct. 13).

Here is a closer look at this week's opponent:

CAL STATE SAN BERNARDINO (5-6-2 Overall): The Coyotes got off to a great start at 3-0-1, but have won just twice in their last nine matches.



Much like Biola, Cal State San Bernardino has a great defense but struggles to get things going offensively. The Coyotes have allowed just 15 goals this season but have scored just 13 of their own—four in the last six matches.

CSUSB has played three other GSAC schools, defeating San Diego Christian (3-2) and Westmont (2-1) and playing to a 1-1 draw with Vanguard.

Junior netminder Leslie Rhodes has a 1.10 goals against average and has made 53 saves this season.

The bulk of the offense has come from freshman Katie Liby, who has scored six of the team's 13 goals.

HOPE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (7-4-1 Overall, 1-3-0 GSAC): The Royals have dropped three straight matches after opening the year with a head-turning 7-1-1 record. Their last three losses have come to GSAC schools including a home losses to #11 Concordia and Westmont and a road loss at Cal Baptist.



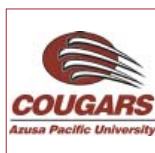
The Royals entered conference play with a decided edge in goals at 18-5, but have been outscored 10-5 in GSAC games.

Freshman forward Harmony Pruitt has

been a scoring machine for Hope, tallying 10 goals on the season with an assist.

The Eagles have never lost to Hope (14-0-0), but came uncomfortably close last season, needing a goal in the second overtime for a 1-0 win in Fullerton.

#2 AZUSA PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (5-6-2 Overall): The Cougars' win over Cal Baptist on Saturday gave them sole possession of first place in the conference on the women's side. It was APU's fourth straight victory with the last three coming via the shutout.



The Cougars have been scoring a lot of goals, led by the eight goals and three assists from sophomore forward Theresa Broad. In goals, APU's anchored by senior Jill Colfer-Martinson, who has a 0.49 goals against average.

Azusa has dominated the series, leading 16-4-2. However, Biola is 2-0-1 in its last three home games against the Cougars.

No. 8 Biola Women Finish First for Third Straight Race, Men Fifth at Vanguard

The Biola cross country teams has been off take a bit of a break before returning to action on Saturday, Oct. 20. The next meet is the GSAC Championship meet, which should serve as a good gauge for both teams as a number of GSAC schools are nationally-ranked at this point in the season.

Biola is having one of its best cross country seasons ever and proved it on Saturday with an impressive performance at the Vanguard Invitational.

The Eagle women, ranked #9 in the latest NAIA National poll, won their third straight meet, edging out #10 Cal State San Marcos by three points.

Biola's women have performed well and have proven to be a deep team this year with 10 different athletes finish in the top seven.

Leading the way this week was sophomore Kristin Schmidt, who won for the second straight week, finishing in 18:06.

Freshman Katie Thede placed third in 18:15 with senior Anna Thibodo just behind her in ninth at 18:38. Freshman Kelsey Gasner placed 11th in 18:52 and freshman Sarah Brooks placed 17th in 19:15 for the women's scoring-five.

The Biola men's squad placed fifth overall with a total team time of 2:11:31, one of the fastest times in school history. The time was better than #14 Vanguard, which finished fourth overall, just two points better than the Eagles.

Senior Brian Ball led the team with a time of 24:53, placing first for the second-straight race. Sophomore Ryan Richert finished in 13th place with a time of 26:09 followed closely by freshman David Kostelyk in 18th with a time of 26:22.

Freshman Kyle McNulty and junior Jared Bird rounded out the scoring five for the Eagles. McNulty placed 30th in 27:02 and Bird took 32nd in 27:05.

BIOLA SWIMMING AND DIVING

Swimmers Take to the Pool at Pacific Collegiate Swimming Conference Relays

The 2007-08 Biola University men's and women's swim teams kick off the season this week, traveling to Riverside for the Pacific Collegiate Swimming Conference (PCSC) Relays on Friday and Saturday (Oct. 12-13).

The PCSC is a group of around 15 schools stretch as far north as Alaska and as far east as Texas and is made up of schools from the NAIA and all three divisions of the NCAA. Biola is a member of this conference as swimming is not a GSAC sport.

The preview meet starts out with a swimmers pentathlon. The swimmers are broken into different groups based on their specialty strokes and compete in a five different events. The best times get the best scores and the winner has the lowest total score.

The relays meet on Saturday features a number of different relays events including some you would not normally see at regular swim meet. Included in the meet will be events like the 1500 Free Relay (three swimmers doing 500 yards each), the 400 IM Relay (four swimmers each doing 100 of one stroke) and the Progressive Free Relay (four swimmers doing a 50, 100, 150, 200).

The 2007-08 men's team returns all of its swimmers from last season's squad. The women's team, on the other hand, welcomes 11 new swimmers including nine freshman to the squad. The women's team is power-packed with a number of freshman who have been swimming nationally-qualifying times during the fall practice sessions along with a number of strong returners.
