Volleyball Hosts #5 Azusa Pacific in Regional Playoff Game Tuesday

Biola's volleyball team wrapped up the regular season on Saturday, but begins the only season that really matters this week: the post-season.

The Eagles earned the No. 4 berth in the NAIA Region II Playoffs and open against a familiar foe in Azusa Pacific University. The two teams will meet for the second time in eight days, this time at Chase Gymnasium with a trip to the NAIA National Championships on the line. The match will be on Tuesday (Nov. 13) at 7:00 p.m.

Despite both teams being ranked in the top five in the NAIA, just four teams from the region can advance to the NAIA National Championships. That means the winner of Tuesday's match will advance while the loser will go home.

The Eagles never trailed in a 30-27, 30-26, 30-22 sweep over the Cougars on Tuesday. However, they fell in four to #2 Cal Baptist in their regular season finale.

Cross Country Heads to NAIA National Championships

The Biola Women's Cross Country team earned one of the at-large berths to the NAIA National Championships on Saturday (Nov. 17) at the Dannehl Cross Country Course in Kenosha, Wisconsin.

Biola's women's team was ranked No. 8 in the final NAIA ratings and are coming off a third place finish at the NAIA Region II Championships.

Joining the women's team will be Biola's Brian Ball, who qualified for the men's championships with a second-place finish at the NAIA Region II Championships two weeks ago. Ball will be making his third trip to the NAIA Championships with his sights set on earning All-American honors for the second-straight year.

Men's Basketball Opens Season in Montana

Biola's men's basketball team tips off its regular season at the Mountain West Bank Classic hosted by Carroll College of Montana on Friday and Saturday (Nov. 16-17).

The tournament pits the Eagles against a pair of tough teams from the Frontier Conference. Biola opens on Friday against Rocky Mountain College, a team that knocked off #8 Azusa Pacific by 15 points last week.

On Saturday, the Eagles take on host Carroll in what should be another good matchup. Tip off for both games is 8:00 p.m. MT.

Women's Basketball Hosts Pair of Games

The Biola women's basketball team is off to a 2-2 start and opens the home portion of the schedule this week with a pair of games.

On Monday (Nov. 12), the Eagles play an exhibition contest against the Melbourne Roos, a traveling squad from Australia. The two teams clashed last season with the Roos pulling out a late victory. Tip off for that game is scheduled for 7:00 p.m.

Biola then plays host to Olivet Nazarene University (Ill.) on Thursday (Nov. 15) at 5:30 p.m. in its first official home game. The Tigers received votes in the NAIA preseason poll and play an up-tempo style of offense. They enter the trip averaging 92.7 ppg.

#4 Biola Hosts #5 Azusa Pacific in NAIA Region II Playoff Opener

It all comes down to this.

After 34 regular-season games, Biola's volleyball season comes down to just one match. That match is an NAIA Region II First-Round Playoff match against—who else—Azusa Pacific University. The winner-take-all match will be on Tuesday (Nov. 13) at 7:00 p.m. in Chase Gymnasium.

Despite ranking #4 and #5 in the final NAIA National Ratings, the loser of Tuesday's match between the Eagles and Cougars will be left out of the NAIA National Championships since the NAIA mandates that no more than four teams from any region advance to the final tournament. That means the loser of Tuesday's match will see 16 teams ranked below them go to Missouri while they stay home.

As if that scenario wasn't enough motivation, the Eagles are taking on their arch-rival in Azusa Pacific. The two teams are no strangers to postseason battles as they have battled in the playoffs four times in the last seven seasons with the Cougars winning all four matches.

Here is a closer look at Azusa Pacific:

#5 AZUSA PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (21-9 overall, 12-8 GSAC):



The Cougars wrapped up their season on Saturday with an impressive five-game win at Vanguard University, spoiling senior day for the Lions and winning in Costa Mesa for the first time in five years. The victory helped Azusa Pacific wrap up fifth place in the GSAC.

Sophomore outside hitter Jill Baker was named to the All-GSAC team on Monday after carrying the Cougars on her back this season. Baker leads APU with 592 kills (5.48/game) and 368 digs (3.41/game) this year, adding 61 blocks and 56 aces. She posted a season-high 37 kills in the Cougars' win at Vanguard Saturday.

Junior setter Allison Kincheloe also earned All-GSAC honors after averaging a GSAC-best 13.39 assists per game for APU. Kincheloe also has 385 digs (3.41/game) on the season.

Freshman Chelsea Daley had been a welcome addition to the team, recording 313 kills (4.17/game) before an injury ended her season two weeks ago.

Biola has defeated the Cougars in both matches between the two rivals this season. In the first match, the Eagles came out slow but rallied back for a 17-30, 30-17, 30-23, 30-28

win. Four Biola players record double-digit kills with Jessica Buffum leading the way with 15.

The second match was dominated by the Eagles, who never trailed in the match and cruised to a 30-27, 30-26, 30-22 win at Azusa.

Biola holds a 42-27 lead in the all-time series and is 21-9 in matches in La Mirada.

Warkentin, Buffum named All-GSAC; Seltzer named GSAC Coach of the Year

Junior outside hitter Meghan Warkentin and Jessica Buffum were named to the 2007 All-GSAC team as announced by the conference office on Monday.

Warkentin finished third in the conference in kills with 413 (4.05/game) and added 189 digs and 42 blocks.

Buffum had 317 kills on the season (2.99/game) with 276 digs and 55 blocks.

Coach Seltzer guided the Eagles to a 27-6 record—their best since the 2003 season. In six seasons at Biola, Seltzer has guided the Eagles to a 144-57 overall record, winning at least 19 matches each season.

More Milestones: Biola's Katie Stevens had 16 digs in Saturday's match against #2 Cal Baptist, giving her 1,008 in her two seasons with the Eagles. Lost in the excitement of Biola's upset win over #1 Fresno Pacific was the fact that Meghan Warkentin reached the 1,000 kills mark for her career with a team-best 23 on the night. She now has 1,042 in two seasons with the Eagles.

Women's Team and Brian Ball Head to NAIA National Championships

The Biola University women's cross country team and Brian Ball from the men's team head to Wisconsin this week for the 52nd Annual Men's and 28th Annual Women's NAIA Cross Country National Championships.

The races will be held at Dr. Wayne E. Dannehl Cross Country Course in Kenosha, Wisconsin on Saturday (Nov. 17). The men's race will start at 10:30 a.m. (CST) while the women's starts at 11:45 a.m. (CST).

The Biola women's team earned one of 14 at large berths into the championships thanks to a strong third-place finish at the NAIA Region II Championships two weeks ago in Fresno.

The team was ranked #8 in the final NAIA National Ratings and has a realistic chance of finishing in the top five come Saturday.

Eight runners will represent the Biola women's team with seven competing in the race and one going as an alternate. Those eight runners are sophomore Kristin Schmidt, freshman Katie Thede, senior Anna Thibodo, freshman

Sarah Brooks, freshman Erika Perez, senior Amanda Stephens, freshman Connie Andersen and freshman Kelsey Gasner.

"Kristin, Katie, and Anna have been our front trio all season and they are well prepared for the national meet," said Biola Head Coach Jonathan Zimmerman. "All three will be in the hunt for All-American honors.

"Our pack of Sarah, Erika, Amanda, Connie, and Kelsey has been steadily improving as a unit and are very capable of racing as a strong group, said Zimmerman. "We have great depth with this squad and would anticipate that they will do well."

Biola's Brian Ball will represent the men's team, earning an individual berth on the strength of a second place finish in the NAIA Region II Championships.

Ball, who is making his third trip to the NAIA National Championships, earned NAIA All-American honors in 2006 and is looking to repeat again this season.

BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Opens 2007-08 Campaign with Exhibition and Scrimmage

With a pair of practice games out of the way, the Biola University men's basketball team will tip off its 2007-08 season with a trip to Montana this weekend.

The Eagles open the season at the Mountain West Bank Classic hosted by Carroll College of Montana.

The tournament opens on Friday (Nov. 16) as Biola takes on Rocky Mountain College at 8:00 p.m. MT. The Bears are coming off an impressive win over #8 Azusa Pacific University last week.

On Saturday (Nov. 17), Biola takes on host Carroll College in what promises to be a good game. Both teams received votes in the preseason NAIA Ratings and match up well with each other.

The Eagles play their first five games on the road and do not play at Chase Gymnasium until hosting Point Loma Nazarene on Thursday, Nov. 29.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

ROCKY MOUNTAIN COLLEGE MT (4-0 Overall):

As mentioned above, the Bears turned a lot of heads around the NAIA with a dominating 105-84 win over #8 Azusa Pacific University last week. RMC shot 61 percent from the field in that game and also hit 10 three-pointers.

Leading the way for the Bears is senior Elijah Swan, who is averaging 20.5 points per game through the first four games of the season. He is 13-for-24 from beyond the arc and averages four rebounds and 2.8 assists per game.

Junior Chase Sukut is not too far behind with 19.8 points per game with junior Nate Miller contributing 18 points per contest.

Rocky Mountain opened the season against three Canadian schools before blowing out APU and are averaging 91.5 points per game through its first four games.

Biola won the only other meeting be-

tween the two schools, downing the Bears 87-61 back in 1996-97.

CARROLL COLLEGE MT (5-1 Overall):

The Saints have already played six games this season, not including an exhibition against NCAA Division II Dixie State last week. Carroll traveled to the same tournament in Canada as Rocky Mountain, suffering their only loss to the University of Calgary.

Junior guard Chad Vaculin has played in just four games so far this year, but has averaged 17.5 points and 3.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 2.3 assists in each of those contests.

Junior wing Edar Zuniga has scored 15 points per game and added nearly four rebounds per contest for the Saints.

This will be the first time Biola has face Carroll College in basketball.

LAST WEEK: Biola saw its first action of the season last week, losing 78-58 in an exhibition contest to NCAA Division I Cal State Fullerton. On Saturday, the Eagles played their final preseason tuneup, hosting a scrimmage against Claremont College.

Biola Hosts Melbourne Roos and Olivet Nazarene This Week

The Biola University women's basketball team wrapped up a trip to Tennessee with a 1-1 record, bring its season mark to 2-2 overall. This week, the Eagles play their first two games at Chase Gymnasium.

On Monday (Nov. 12), Biola hosts the Melbourne Roos—a travel team from Australia—in an exhibition contest. The Roos have already played three games in the states on their roadtrip and have another four after their matchup with Biola. Tipoff is at 7:00 p.m.

The Eagles only other game this week is their first official home game on Thursday (Nov. 15) against Olivet Nazarene University (Ill.). That game will begin earlier than usual, tipping-off at 5:30 p.m.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

MELBOURNE ROOS: This will be the second straight season Biola takes on the Roos. In 2006, the Eagles lost a close game to Melbourne prior to the start of the season.

The eight young women who make up the Roos are looking to showcase their talents to American coaches in hopes of earning a scholarship offer.

The exhibition contest should be a good one as the Roos have shot well from the field in their previous three games and play solid defense all around. The Eagles may be a bit tired, but should be ready to play after returning from Tennessee on Saturday night and participating in Midnight Madness on Sunday evening.

OLIVET NAZARENE UNIVERSITY IL (2-1 Overall): The Tigers have incorporated a version of the high-flying, high-scoring offense used by the University of Redlands men's basketball team in the last few years.



So far in 2007-08, ONU is averaging 92.7 points per game and has scored over 100

points in two of their three games.

The Tigers offense consists mostly of attempting to score lots and lots of points by quickly shooting three pointers and substituting a fresh set of five players every 30-60 seconds.

Senior guard Hilary Disch leads the team with 23.0 points per game and has drilled 10 of 30 three-point attempts in their first three games.

Senior forward Maggie Siller adds 11.3 points and 9.3 rebounds, shooting 50 percent from the field in the first three games.

The Eagles opened the Bethel College tournament last week with a 67-47 loss to the host team, but rebounded with a 64-48 win over Williams Baptist on Saturday. Biola's win over Williams Baptist was especially sweet as WBC had knocked off #13 Cumberland in its first game of the tournament. Junior forward Summer Matthews continued her solid play and is now averaging 14.3 points and 11 rebounds a game through the first four games of the season.
