Basketball Teams Open GSAC Play at San Diego Christian College

Despite the fact that it isn't even Thanksgiving yet, the Biola University men's and women's basketball teams open conference play this week, traveling to El Cajon for a matchup against San Diego Christian College.

The women head down south first, taking on the Hawks on Tuesday (Nov. 20) at 5:30 p.m. While normally the teams play doubleheaders, the men's game was moved to Wednesday (Nov. 21) at 7:30 p.m. to give the Eagles an extra day to recover from their trip to Montana last week.

The men wrap up the week with a post-Thanksgiving game against NCAA Division III University of Redlands on Saturday (Nov. 24) at 7:30 p.m.

The Biola women's squad played two home games last week, winning an exhibition contest against the Melbourne Roos, but falling to the high-octane offense of Olivet Nazarene on Thursday.

The Biola men's team split a pair of games at the Carroll College (Mont.) Classic to open the season over the weekend. The Eagles downed Rocky Mountain College, but ran out of gas and lost to Carroll the following night.

Both teams play three games next week with two of them at home including the men's home opener on Thursday (Nov. 29) against Point Loma Nazarene.

Volleyball Heads to NAIA National Championships

The Biola volleyball team punched its ticket to the NAIA National Championships last week with a win over Azusa Pacific in the Region II quarterfinals. The Eagles then were defeated by Fresno Pacific in the semifinals on Friday. The Sunbirds ended up winning their fifth-straight Regional title with a sweep over No. 2 California Baptist in the finals.

Biola earned the No. 4 seed in the NAIA Tournament and has been placed in Pool D with host Columbia College (Mo.), the University of Mobile (Ala.) and Campbellsville University (Ky.).

The tournament opens on Wednesday, Nov. 28 and runs through Saturday, Dec. 1. A full preview will run in next week's edition of *EagleSports Weekly*.

Cross Country Runs Strong at NAIA National Championships

The Biola Women's Cross Country team placed 11th overall and Brian Ball from the men's team took seventh at the NAIA National Championships on Saturday at the Dannehl XC Course in Kenosha, Wisconsin.

Sophomore Kristen Schmidt earned NAIA All-American honors with an 11th place finish to pace the women's squad. Ball also earned NAIA All-American honors for the second straight season with his seventh-place finish.

The season wrapped up as one of the most successful in school history with the women's team ending the season ranked No. 8 in the NAIA and finishing in the top 11 nationally. As a team, the Biola women had not made it out of the regional tournament since 2004 and were ranked in the lower half of the GSAC.

Head Coach Jonathan Zimmerman was named GSAC co-Head Coach of the Year for guiding the team to its best finish in over a decade.

On the men's side, the Eagles had floundered at the bottom of the GSAC standings for numerous years until breaking out this season. Despite barely missing out on a trip to the National Championships, the Eagles had one of the fastest teams in school history with nearly everyone returning in 2008.

#4 Biola Travels to NAIA National Championships

The Biola University volleyball team earned a trip to the NAIA National Tournament last week with a three-game sweep over arch-rival Azusa Pacific University in the NAIA Region II Quarterfinals.

The Eagles seemed a bit uninterested in advancing much farther than that as they were quickly dispatched by No. 1 Fresno Pacific on Friday in the regional semifinals. The Sunbirds then went on to sweep No. 2 California Baptist to claim their fifth-straight regional crown.

However, the Eagles earned an at-large berth to the 20-team NAIA National Tournament and secured the fourth overall seed.

The NAIA Tournament is being played at Columbia College in Columbia, MO and runs from Wed., Nov. 28 through Sat., Dec. 1.

The tournament is broken down in five pools of four teams with each team playing the other three teams in its pool during the first two days of competition. The top two teams from the pools each advance to the tournament portion of the schedule.

Biola has been placed in Pool D with No. 7-seed and host Columbia College (Mo.), the University of Mobile (Ala.) and Campbellsville University (Ky.). The winner of the pool advances straight to the quarterfinals while the second place team must defeat the second team from pool A to secure a spot in the quarters.

The top four seeds in the national tournament went to the four GSAC schools. Fresno Pacific was awarded the top seed and will head Pool A. Cal Baptist is the No. 2 seed and in Pool B with Concordia University holding the third seed and heading up Pool B.

National American University managed to work its way back into the top five and is atop Pool E with the sixth seed Lindenwood (Mo.) joining them.

As it turns out, just five of the top 10 teams in the final NAIA rankings made it to the National tournament. No. 5 Azusa Pacific and No. 9 Point Loma Nazarene were denied entry as the NAIA limits each region to four representatives. No. 7 Dickinson State, No. 8 College of Idaho (Albertson), and No. 10 Southern Oregon lost in their regional tournament and did not get an at-large berth.

Should all four GSAC schools win their pool, it would set up a potential all-GSAC semifinal that would mirror last week's NAIA Region II semifinals—at least in seeding.

BIOLA AT THE NAIA TOURNAMENT

This will be Biola's seventh trip to the NAIA National Championships, but just its second since 1999. The Eagles are 26-14 all-time at the NAIA Tournament and have at least reached the quarterfinals in each of their trips.

Biola has made it to the championship game twice once in 1985 and again in 1997. The Eagles were defeated in the semifinals in 1998 and in 2003 and lost in the quarterfinals in 1986 and 1996.

BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

Eagles Open GSAC at San Diego Christian; Face Redlands on Saturday

The Biola men's basketball team opened the 2007-08 season last week with a split of games at the Carroll College (Mont.) Classic. Now, the focus turns to the GSAC where they Eagles will again be battling for a top spot in the conference and a return to the NAIA National Tournament.

The GSAC schedule opens with a road trip to El Cajon to face San Diego Christian College at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday (Nov. 21). The Hawks bounced Biola out of the GSAC tournament last year, downing the Eagles 64-53 in the first round.

After a few days off for Thanksgiving break, Biola returns to action with a non-conference contest at the University of Redlands on Saturday (Nov. 24) at 7:30 p.m.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

SAN DIEGO CHRISTIAN COLLEGE (2-2 Overall): The Hawks enter Wednesday's matchup with the Eagles at 2-2, but not having played since Nov. 10. SDCC opened the season with a pair of wins in the Bethany University Tip-Off Classic, downing UC Santa Cruz 97-73 and beating Bethany University 100-93.



However, the Hawks have dropped their last two games, both against NAIA Division I teams. SDCC lost 93-54 to Westminster of Utah and was edged 74-72 by Madonna University.

The Hawks are much different this season than they were in 2006-07 when they shared the GSAC title with Concordia. They lost their head coach and six players from last year's squad and have eight freshman on this season's team.

The vast majority of the Hawks' offense comes from 6-5 junior forward Bayo Arigbon, who averages 23 points and 18.5 rebounds per game thus far. Arigbon had an incredible 40 points and 30 rebounds in San Diego Christian's win over Bethany.

The 6-2 junior guard Kevin Dillon has been a steady contributor as well, scoring 14.7 points per game and reaching double-digits in all four contests this year.

Biola is 30-13 all-time against San Diego Christian. The Eagles have won just twice in the last nine trips to El Cajon, but did beat the Hawks 59-49 last year.

UNIVERSITY OF REDLANDS (1-1 Overall): Gone are the days of the run-and-gun offense operated by former Head Coach Gary Smith, who retired at the end of the 2006-07 season. The current Bulldog's team has entered into a new offensive era under first-year coach Jim Ducey and are scoring just over 60 points per game so far.



Redlands is off to a 1-1 start this season, opening with a 65-61 win over Menlo College. The Bulldogs then fell 64-55 to Chapman University the following night.

Sophomore Patrick Coffey, a 5-11 guard, has led the team through the first two games, averaging 15 points per contest.

The Redlands/Biola rivalry dates back to the late 1960s when the two teams were both members of the NAIA. Coach Holmquist and Coach Smith have battled each other since Holmquist took over at Biola 26 years ago.

Oddly enough, Biola's school records for the fewest and the most points in a game were set against Redlands. The fewest came in a 1980 District playoff game when Biola beat UR 37-24. Last season, the Eagles beat the Bulldogs 138-105 to set the highest scoring game mark. In that game, Matt Emadi scored 32 points on 13-16 shooting from the field to lead six Biola players in double-figures.

Overall, the Eagles led the all-time series 20-3 and have won the last 13-straight against the Bulldogs.

BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Opens Conference Play at San Diego Christian College on Tuesday

The Biola women's basketball team played its first two home games of the 2007-08 season last week and came away with an exhibition win but a loss in the counting game.

Now, the focus turns to the Golden State Athletic Conference, which is one of the toughest in the NAIA. Biola opens play in the GSAC on Tuesday (No. 20), traveling to El Cajon to face San Diego Christian College at 5:30 p.m.

The Eagles looked sharp against the Melbourne Roos traveling team on Monday, pulling away late for a 63-54 win.

On Thursday, Biola hosted Olivet Nazarene, which plays a fast, up-tempo game, firing three-pointers at will and substituting its five players on the court every minute. Despite opening up a 15-point lead in the first half, the Eagles eventually lost 98-92.

It was the highest-scoring game in school history, breaking the mark set last season in a 95-90 loss to Cal Baptist.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

SAN DIEGO CHRISTIAN COLLEGE (1-1 Overall):

The Hawks opened the season last weekend with a split at the Cal Tech Tournament. SDCC opened with a 73-61 loss to Occidental, but rebounded with a 69-33 drubbing of host Cal Tech on Saturday.

The Hawks' roster has taken a big hit since the beginning of the season as five players will miss Tuesday's game due to injuries or academic issues.

Stats were only available for San Diego Christian's first game against Occidental. In that contest, the Hawks received 18 points each from junior guard Dorchella James and freshman forward Vernessa Roberts. Senior guard Courtney Ash added 15 points, but the Hawks received just 10 points from their other four players.

San Diego Christian held a 53-52 lead with just over seven minutes to go in that

contest, but was outscored 21-8 down the stretch.

Leading the Hawks is first-year coach Kelsey Dillon, a former NAIA All-American at Azusa Pacific University. Dillion was the GSAC Defensive player of the year in 2003 and capped her career with All-America honors in 2005. Last season, she coached at Vista High School.

Dillion has a major uphill climb as coach at SDCC as the Hawks are 24-122 since joining the GSAC in 1999-2000. Biola is 14-3 against San Diego Christian all-time and has won five straight and 11 of the last 12 in the series.

MATTHEWS ON THE REBOUND

Junior forward Summer Matthews has been a rebounding machine for the Eagles through their first five games this season, averaging 11.8 boards per game including just over five on the offensive glass. In addition, Matthews has scored 16 points per contest and is shooting an impressive 69 percent from the field.

She scored 23 points and had 15 rebounds against Olivet Nazarene on Thursday despite sitting out a large part of the second half after receiving an elbow to the mouth.
