Volleyball Travels to Missouri for NAIA National Championships

The Biola volleyball team looks to cap off an impressive season with a strong finish at the 2007 NAIA National Championships which take place this week in Columbia, Missouri.

The Eagles earned the fourth seed in the tournament thanks to a 28-7 record thus far—their best record since the 2003 season.

The Championships begin with pool play games on Wednesday and Thursday (Nov. 28-29) with the top two teams from each of the five pools advancing to bracket play, which begins on Friday (Nov. 30).

Biola opens the tournament with a single match on Wednesday, battling the University of Mobile (Ala.) at 1:30 p.m. (CT). Thursday, the Eagles take on Campbellsville College (Ky.) at 11:15 a.m. (CT) and close out pool play at 8:15 p.m. (CT) against Columbia College (Mo.), the tournament host and seventh overall seed.

The rest of the schedule will be determined once the pool play games are finished. A complete schedule is included on page three.

Biola is making its seventh trip to the NAIA National Championships and has reached the quarterfinals in each of its previous trips. The Eagles have twice finished as the National Runner-up, the last coming in 1997.

Men's Basketball hosts Point Loma on Thursday in Home Opener

The Biola men's basketball team finds itself in the middle of a busy stretch, playing four games in eight days including three this week.

The Eagles open the week with a GSAC game at Hope International on Tuesday (Nov. 28) at 7:30 p.m.

On Thursday (Nov. 30), Biola plays its home opener against Point Loma Nazarene at 7:30 p.m. The game should be a great contest

as the Eagles and Sea Lions are likely to be among the top teams in the GSAC and this early-season match-up could weigh heavily on the standings at the end of the season.

Biola wraps up the week with a non-conference home game against NAIA foe Cal State Maritime on Saturday (Dec. 1) at 7:30 p.m.

The Eagles crushed San Diego Christian 79-42 in their GSAC opener on Tuesday and are 2-1 overall and 1-0 in the conference.

Women's Basketball plays trio of games including two home contests

The Biola women's basketball team also has a busy week this week with three games in the course of six days.

First up is a road contest at GSAC foe Hope International on Tuesday (Nov. 28) in Fullerton.

The Eagles then return home for their next two games, hosting Point Loma Nazarene on Thursday (Nov. 30) and NCAA Division III Pomona-Pitzer College on Saturday (Dec. 1). All games begin at 5:30 p.m. with the last two at Chase Gymnasium.

Biola opened GSAC play with a thrilling 69-62 win over San Diego Christian on Tuesday to run its record to 3-3 on the season and 1-0 in GSAC play.

#4 Biola Looks For Strong Finish at NAI A National Championships

The Biola University volleyball team has earned a trip to the 2007 NAI A National Championships and heads to Columbia, Missouri this week with high expectations.

The Eagles earned an at-large berth to the 20-team tournament and secured the fourth overall seed with their fourth place finish in the NAI A Region II Tournament two weeks ago.

The NAI A Tournament is being played at Columbia College and runs from Wed., Nov. 28 through Sat., Dec. 1.

It is broken down in five pools of four teams with each team playing the other three teams in its pool during the first two days of competition. The top two teams from the pools each advance to the tournament portion of the schedule.

Biola has been placed in Pool D with No. 7-seed and host Columbia College (Mo.), the University of Mobile (Ala.) and Campbellsville University (Ky.). The winner of the pool advances straight to the quarterfinals while the second place team must defeat the second team from pool A to secure a spot in the quarters.

The top four seeds in the national tournament went to the four GSAC schools. Fresno Pacific was awarded the top seed and will head Pool A. Cal Baptist is the No. 2 seed and in Pool B with Concordia University holding the third seed and heading up Pool B.

National American University managed to work its way back into the top five and is atop Pool E with the sixth seed Lindenwood (Mo.) joining them.

As it turns out, just five of the top 10 teams in the final NAI A rankings made it to the National tournament. No. 5 Azusa Pacific and No. 9 Point Loma Nazarene were denied entry as the NAI A limits each region to four representatives. No. 7 Dickinson State, No. 8 College of Idaho (Albertson), and No. 10 Southern Oregon lost in their regional tournament and did not receive an at-large berth.

Should all four GSAC schools win their pool, it would set up a potential all-GSAC semifinal that would mirror last week's NAI A Region II semifinals—at least in seeding.

Here is a close look at the three other teams in Biola's pool:

UNIVERSITY OF MOBILE AL (35-5 Overall):



The Rams earned a trip to the NAI A Championships by virtue of winning the Region XIII title with a sweep over Loyola University (La.). It is the first trip to the NAI A Tournament for Mobile which is in just its third season of varsity competition.

The Rams have three players averaging three or more kills per game, led by sophomore outside hitter Whitney Knight, who has 4.48 kills per game average. Junior outside hitter Syretta Baldwin adds 3.86

kills per game.

This will be the first-ever meeting between the two schools.

#24 CAMPBELLVILLE COLLEGE KY (33-7



Overall): The Tigers opened up the season winning 21 of their first 22 games before going 6-5 in their next 11. Campbellsville finished up the season with a pair of five-game wins to claim the Region XI title and advance to its first-ever NAI A Championship.

Leading the way for the Tigers are a pair of outside hitters in freshman Teresa Masava and senior Misty Tarbet who have 5.0 and 4.9 kills per game, respectively.

The game will also be the first meeting between the two schools.

#6 COLUMBIA COLLEGE MO (29-7 Overall):



The Cougars earned a spot in the NAI A Tournament as the host of the NAI A tournament despite a five-game loss in the Region V championship match to Lindenwood University. The loss snapped a 14-game winning streak for the Cougars.

Columbia's international contingent is led by Brazilian Daniela Brazolino and China National Yi Zhang-Li. Brazolino has 3.5 kills per game while Zhang-Li adds 3.2 kills.

The Eagles will be looking to snap some unfortunate bad luck against the Cougars, who have managed to beat Biola three times in the NAI A Tournament. The Eagles were swept three times by Columbia, the last coming in the 2003 semifinals.

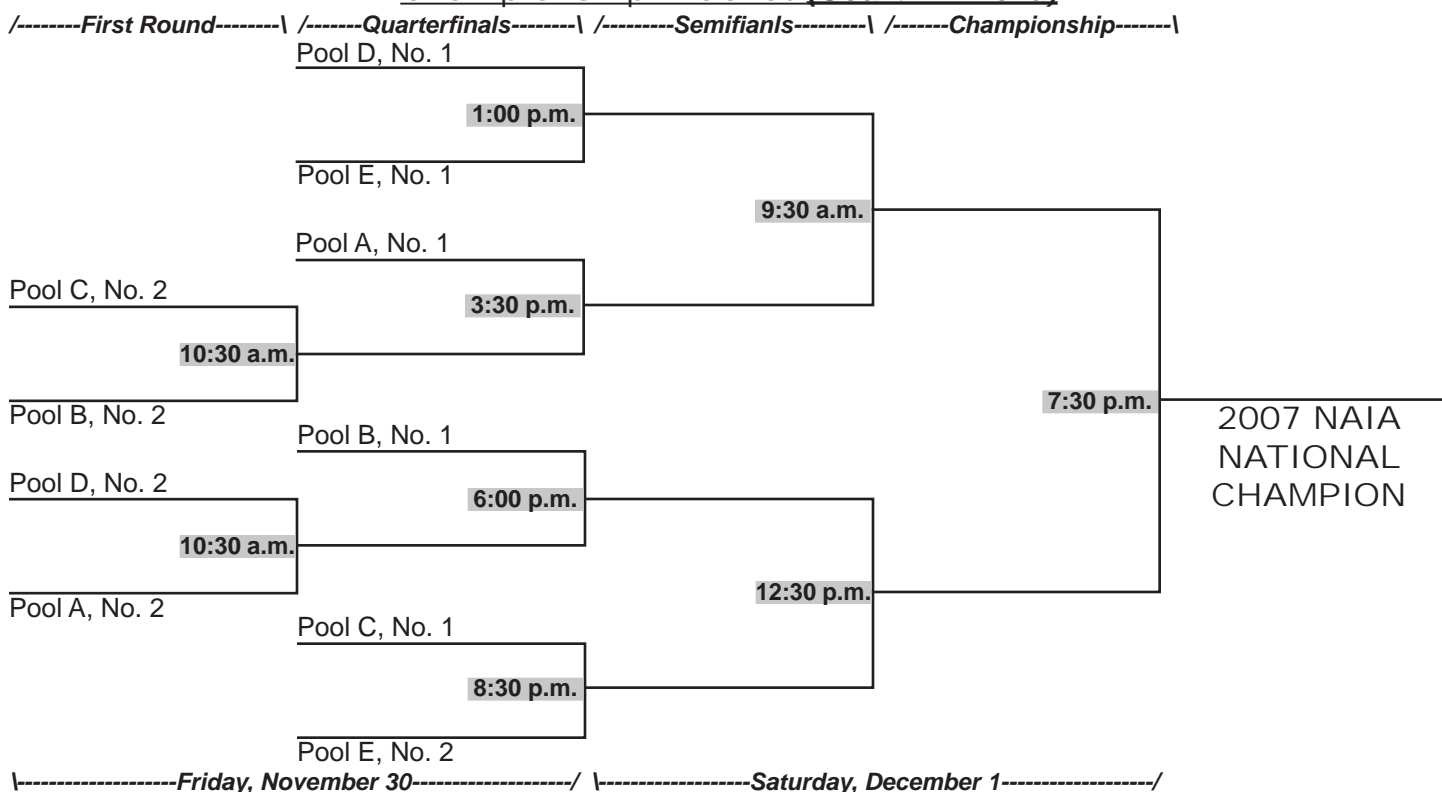

Biola Begins Busy Week at Hope; Hosts PLNU in Home Opener

The Biola men's basketball team starts a busy stretch by playing three games this week and a total of four over a stretch of eight days.

The week begins with a return to GSAC action as the Eagles travel to Fullerton to battle Hope International University on Tuesday (Nov. 27) at 7:30 p.m.

On Thursday (Nov. 29), Biola plays its first home game of the season, hosting Point Loma Nazarene University in a game that will surely hold major weight in the GSAC standings.

The Eagles ring in December with a non-conference matchup against Cal State Maritime Academy on Saturday (Dec. 1) at 7:30 p.m.

Biola has been busy over the last week, winning its GSAC opener on Wednesday at San Diego Christian, then following that up with a non-conference victory over the University of Redlands on Saturday.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

HOPE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (0-4 Overall, 0-1 GSAC):

The Royals have gotten off to a bit of a slow start this season, dropping their first four games, though three of the four were by fewer than 10 points. Hope opened its GSAC schedule on Tuesday with a 72-55 loss at Fresno Pacific University.

The Royals have struggled in GSAC play since joining the conference in the 1999-00 season, having won just six conference games over that stretch and finishing last or tied for last each season. Their last victory came during the 2004-05 season when the Royals upset Vanguard in overtime.

Through four games in 2007-08, junior forward Marko Torovic has led the way, averaging 15.0 points and 7.5 rebounds.

Biola holds a 31-1 all-time series lead over the Royals with the lone loss coming in a 106-101 loss in La Mirada during the 1994-95 season.

#22 POINT LOMA NAZARENE UNIVERSITY (5-1 Overall, 1-0 GSAC):

The Sea Lions are off to a strong start and shocked the GSAC on Tuesday with a 69-65 win at Azusa Pacific in the conference openers for both schools. Point Loma's lone loss of the season came on at the hands of #26 Westminster College, falling 94-

93 in overtime.

The Sea Lions are led by junior guard Curtis Carlson, who is averaging 17.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. He has led the team in scoring in each of its last four games including a season-high 33 points in Point Loma's win over Olivet Nazarene.

Joining the Sea Lions' cast is senior guard Josh Sanderson (13.0 ppg, 26 assists) and junior center Craig Austin (11.2 ppg, 4.5 rpg).

Biola holds a 48-29 lead in the all-time series, though Point Loma has been victorious in the last five games in the series.

CAL STATE MARITIME (3-3 Overall):

The Keelhaulers are new members to the NAIA and are playing basketball in the Cal Pac Conference which makes Saturday's game an important regional contest.

Cal State Maritime nearly pulled off an impressive upset over the GSAC's Fresno Pacific University earlier this season, but ultimately fell 78-72 in Morrow Bay.

The Eagles downed the Keelhaulers 74-54 last season in the first-ever meeting between the two schools. That game came as part of the Holy Names Classic Tournament to open up the 2006-07 season. Danny Jones and Rocky Hampton dominated inside, combining to score 35 points and haul down 16 rebounds.

Eagles Play Three Games This Week Including Pair of Home Contests

The Biola women's basketball team got off to a quick start in conference play with a thrilling 69-62 win over San Diego Christian College on Tuesday in El Cajon.

The Eagles have little time to celebrate, though, as they play three games this week including a pair of GSAC contests.

The week begins in Fullerton as Biola faces off against Hope International on Tuesday (Nov. 27) at 5:30 p.m.

On Thursday (Nov. 29), the Eagles return home for a GSAC contest against Point Loma Nazarene. The Sea Lions enter ranked #9 in the NAIA and will provide Biola with its first strong challenge of the season.

The Eagles wrap up the week with a non-conference home game against NCAA Division III Pomona-Pitzer College on Saturday (Dec. 1) at 5:30 p.m.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

HOPE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (8-1 Overall, 1-0 GSAC):

The Royals are off to an incredible start this season, opening with eight wins in their first nine games. Their lone loss was a 73-60 defeat at the hands of Carroll College (Mont.). Since that loss, Hope has rattled off seven straight wins including a shocking 78-62 win over Fresno Pacific in its GSAC opener.

The bulk of the Royals scoring has come from senior guard/forward Jasmine Nault, who is averaging 25.9 points and 7.8 rebounds a game. Nault has scored 30 or more points on three occasions this season and accounts for nearly one-third of the team's scoring.

Brittani Philbrook and Sarah Nylander have each contributed 12.1 points per game for the Royals.

Hope and Biola split a pair of contests last year with each team winning on the other's home court. The Eagles hold a 21-3 lead in the all-time series, though Hope has won three of the last five games between the two.

#9 POINT LOMA NAZARENE UNIVERSITY (3-1 Overall, 0-1 GSAC):

The Sea Lions suffered their first loss off the season in their GSAC opener, falling 65-53 at Azusa Pacific on Tuesday. Point Loma Nazarene had opened

the season with three impressive wins including a 117-84 shellacking of Olivet Nazarene in its final pre-GSAC games.



The Sea Lions have three players scoring in double-digits, led by senior guard Brittany Dove.

Dove is averaging 13.0 points per game on 58 percent shooting.

Colleen Planeta has a 12.0 point per game average with Meghan McGuire contributing 10.0 points and 6.5 rebounds per contest.

Biola holds a slim 30-26 edge in the all-time series between the two schools, but the Sea Lions have won 11 of last 12 games.

POMONA-PITZER COLLEGE CA (0-5



Overall): The Sagehens are still looking for their first victory after the season and have yet to really come close through their first five games. Pomona-Pitzer, which had won 15 of the last

24 SCIAC titles, are shooting just 35 percent on the season and have been outscored by a combined total of 90 points in five games.

Deidre Chew has been the offense force for the Sagehens and is scoring 15.0 points and adding six rebounds per game. Anja Hughes-Stinson is the only other player averaging double-digits, scoring 10.0 points per game.

Biola is 9-4 all-time against Pomona-Pitzer though the last time the two teams met came during the 2003-04 season.
