## Volleyball Enters Final Stretch; Men's Basketball Tips Off 2007-08 Season

Biola's volleyball team picked up one of its biggest wins in school history last week, knocking off No. 1 and previously-undefeated Fresno Pacific University in five games. It was the first time the Eagles had defeated FPU since 1997 and gave Biola momentum heading into this final week of the regular season.

The Eagles start the week with what should be a first-round playoff preview against arch-rival and No. 5-ranked Azusa Pacific University on Tuesday (Nov. 6) at 7:00 p.m.

The regular season wraps up on Saturday (Nov. 10) as Biola hosts No. 2 California Baptist University at 7:00 p.m.

The NAIA Region II Playoffs begin next week with Biola likely to host a first-round game on Tuesday, Nov. 13. Stay tuned!

### Men's Basketball Team Starts Season With Pair of Non-Counters

It seems like it has been a very long time since March when the Biola men's basketball team last took to the court, but the 2007-08 Eagles are ready to return to action this week.

Biola, which received votes in the NAIA preseason poll, opens things up with an exhibition contest against NCAA Division I Cal State Fullerton on Tuesday (Nov. 6) at Titan Gymnasium in Fullerton at 7:00 p.m.

The Eagles play their final pre-season tuneup on Saturday (Nov. 10) as they host NCAA Division III Claremont College in a scrimmage at Chase Gymnasium at 2:00 p.m.

Biola's regular season begins at the Carroll College tournament in Montana next week with games against Carroll College and Rocky Mountain College.

### Women's Basketball Team Travels to Tennessee for Big Tournament

The Biola women's basketball team already has a pair of games under its belt, splitting two

games at the Holy Names Cougar Classic last weekend. Biola has been shooting the ball well and lost by just four points to No. 24 Westminster College on Friday.

The Eagles now travel to McKenzie, Tenn., for the Bethel College Tournament on Friday and Saturday (Nov. 9-10). Biola opens against tournament host Bethel College on Friday at 6:00 p.m. (Eastern Time).

On Saturday, the Eagles face off against Williams Baptist College at Noon (ET).

### Women's XC Finishes Third at Regionals; Likely Headed to NAIA Championships

Biola's women's cross country team had its top six runners finish in the top 26 overall, placing third at the NAIA Region II Championships on Saturday. The Eagles, ranked No. 6 in the latest NAIA ratings, were edged by just one point by Cal State San Marcos. However, they are likely to earn one of 14 at-large berths to the NAIA Championships in two weeks.

Kristen Schmidt finished third overall with freshman Katie Thede taking seventh.

On the men's side, Brian Ball finished second overall to lead the Eagles to an eighth place finish overall. Ball should also earn an individual berth to the NAIA Championships.

### Golf Wraps Up Fall Season at San Marcos

The Biola men's golf team participated in an individual invitational last week to wrap up the fall portion of the schedule. The golf team returns to the links in February.

### Swimmers off until December

The Biola swim team had a strong showing in a double-dual meet against Cal State East Bay and Pomona-Pitzer. Now, the Eagles return to hard, midseason training and return to competition at the University of La Verne Invitational on December 8.

# BIOLA VOLLEYBALL

## #4 Biola Travels to #5 Azusa, Hosts #2 Cal Baptist to End Regular Season

For the second straight week, the Biola University volleyball team faces a pair of Top-5 teams. Last week, the Eagles split a pair of five-game matches against top-ranked teams. On Tuesday, Biola fell to #3 Concordia, but rebounded just 24 hours later and upset #1 Fresno Pacific on Wednesday.

Biola is heading into the home stretch and has already secured a spot in the NAIA Region II Playoffs which begin on Tuesday, Nov. 13. The Eagles are currently fourth in the region and if the season were to end today, would host Azusa Pacific in the first-round match.

The two teams meet on Tuesday (Nov. 6) at Azusa in what is likely to be a playoff preview. Biola then wraps up the regular season on Saturday (Nov. 10) against #2 Cal Baptist at Chase Gymnasium. First serve is set for 7:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

**#5 AZUSA PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (20-8 overall, 11-7 GSAC):** The Cougars continue to put together a strong season, playing well

and winning the matches they have to win. On Saturday, Azusa Pacific came back from a 2-1 deficit to pull out a five-game victory over #8 Point Loma Nazarene at APU. The win all but secured at least fifth place in the region.

The Cougars have won three straight including the 3-2 victory over Point Loma on Saturday. Sophomore Jill Baker recorded 64 kills during that four-match stretch, averaging just under six kills per game over. Baker leads Azusa Pacific with 533 kills (5.33/game), 56 aces (0.56/game), and is third with 343 digs (3.43/game).

Junior setter Allison Kincheloe is averaging a GSAC-best 13.39 assists per game and also has 357 digs on the season.

Freshman Chelsea Daley adds 313 kills (4.17/game), but along with Baker are the only two Cougars who average 2.5 kills per game or better.

The Eagles snapped a seven-match losing streak to the Cougars with a 17-30, 30-17, 30-23, 30-28 win at Chase Gymnasium earlier this year. Biola has not won at Azusa Pacific since the 2003 season when the Eagles swept the Cougars and is just 17-16 at Azusa. Overall, Biola is 41-27 all-time against APU.

**#2 CALIFORNIA BAPTIST UNIVERSITY (23-3 Overall, 16-2 GSAC):** The Lancers have



quietly put together a strong season, losing just three times on the season with two of them coming in head-to-head battles against #1 Fresno Pacific University. Cal Baptist has won six straight matches—all of which have been dominating sweeps.

Despite losing Angela Willis—one of the teams best players—for the season, the Lancers have continued to play well. Willis' sister, Verania, has recorded 487 kills (5.60/game) to lead the GSAC and the NAIA.

The Lancers have quite the international contingent with the Willis sisters, who hail from Costa Rica, Shi Fei, from China and Yudelka Bonilla from the Dominican Republic.

Fei has 308 kills (3.42/game) while Bonilla adds 270 (3.51/game) ranking them in the top 15 in the conference. Overall, the four foreign players for the Lancers make up 75 percent of the Cal Baptist offense.

The Lancers have won six of the last seven matches between the two teams including a 30-28, 30-20, 30-21 win in Riverside earlier this year. Biola did pull off a dramatic upset over Cal Baptist to end the regular season last year, knocking the Lancers off three games to one at Chase Gymnasium.

Biola leads the all-time series 32-22 and has won 19 of 27 games at Chase Gymnasium, including five of the last six.

# BIOLA CROSS COUNTRY

## Eagle Women Place Third; Men Eighth at NAIA Region II Championships

The Biola University women's cross country team finished third overall, just missing second by one point, while the men's team finished eighth at the NAIA Region II Championships at Woodward Park in Fresno on Saturday.

The Eagle women, who entered ranked No. 6 in the latest NAIA National Ratings, are likely to earn an at-large berth to the NAIA National Championship meet with their strong finish on the 5k course. Biola finished with 75 points overall, just one point behind Cal State San Marcos—ranked No. 11 nationally.

The men finished the meet with 141 points while just 27 points separated the fourth through eighth place teams.

Biola placed two runners in the top seven in the women's race with sophomore Kristin Schmidt taking third in 17:58 and freshman Katie Thede finishing seventh in 18:16.

Overall, the Eagles' five scoring runners finished in the top 25. Senior Anna Thibodo took 18th overall with a time of 18:48 followed by freshmen Sarah Brooks and Erika Perez placed 23rd and 24th respectively with Brooks

running a 19:00 and Perez crossing in 19:06.

Biola's men's team was paced by senior Brian Ball who finished second overall with a time of 24:48. He edged a pair of runners from Cal State San Marcos—including former high school teammate Juan Mejia. It was the third time Ball earned All-Region honors in his career and should earn him a trip to the National Championship as well.

Sophomore Ryan Richert crossed the line in 26:03, good enough for 21st, followed by freshman David Kostelyk who finished 30th with a time of 26:20. Junior Jared Bird was 43rd overall in 27:10 and was followed closely by freshman Kyle McNulty at 45th in 27:16.

The NAIA makes its official announcement on the teams and individuals to qualify for the NAIA's later today. Biola's women's team is likely to earn an at-large berth while Brian Ball should be invited back as an individual.

The NAIA National Championships take place on Saturday, November 17 at the Dr. Wayne E. Dannehl Cross Country Course in Kenosha, Wisconsin.

## Biola Opens 2007-08 Campaign with Exhibition and Scrimmage

The Biola University men's basketball team opens the 2007-08 season this week with an exhibition game at Cal State Fullerton and a home scrimmage against Claremont College.

The Eagles welcome six new faces to the team this year to go along with a number of strong returning players.

Included in the latter group is senior Danny Jones, who earned All-GSAC and NAIA Honorable Mention All-American honors in 2006-07.

The first game is on Tuesday (Nov. 6) as the Eagles travel to Fullerton for an exhibition game against NCAA Division I Cal State Fullerton at 7:00 p.m.

On Saturday (Nov. 10), the Eagles host NCAA Division III Claremont College in a scrimmage at Chase Gymnasium at 2:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

**CAL STATE FULLERTON (2006-07 Record: 20-10 Overall):** The Titans finished the 2006-07 campaign third in the Big West Conference, their season fizzling after a promising start and high expectations.

Cal State Fullerton has a tough task this year in replacing its leading scorer in Bobby Brown, who averaged 20.2 points per game and just over five assists per contest.

The Titans took another hit last week as senior forward Scott Cutley—a preseason all-Big West Selection—fractured his ankle in practice. Cutley, who led the Big West in rebounding last year with 9.5 boards per game, is expected to miss the first six weeks of the season and return in mid-December.

Cal State Fullerton, which was picked to finish third in the Big West by the conference coaches, also returns Marcus Crenshaw, a 5-10 guard, who averaged 11.4 points per game last year.

**CLAREMONT COLLEGE CA (2006-07 Record: 15-10 Overall):** The Stags had



an up-and-down season in 2006-07, winning their first six games of the year, but going just 9-10 after that. Claremont also lost its leading scoring from the 2006-07 season in Mani Maceira, who averaged 19.5 points and 5.3 rebounds a game.

Senior guard Dan Winterbottom does return, though, and brings his 10.1 points per game average with him.

### Scheduling Difficulties

Biola's 2007-08 schedule is a difficult one, peppered with tough non-conference opponents in addition to the ever-difficult GSAC slate.

The Eagles have two big in-season tournaments this year, traveling to Montana in November and to the Bay area in December.

Biola also faces a pair of tough NCAA Division II foes, traveling to play Cal State Los Angeles and hosting Wayne State (Neb.).

The Eagles biggest came could be their regular-season finale on Monday, March 3, as they host arch-rival Azusa Pacific.

## Eagles Head to Tennessee for Second Straight Tournament

The Biola University women's basketball team is off to a 1-1 start after splitting a pair of games last weekend at the Holy Names Cougar Classic.

This week, it's off to another tournament, this time in McKenzie, Tennessee. The Eagles travel east for the Bethel College (Tenn.) tournament which kicks off Friday.

First up for Biola is the host, Bethel College on Friday (Nov. 9) at 6:00 p.m. (ET). On Saturday, the Eagles take on Williams Baptist College (Ark.) at Noon (ET).

Biola suffered a 79-75 loss in its season opener on Friday against #24 Westminster College (Utah). The Eagles shot 46 percent from the field but were unable to keep up with Westminster, which shot 56 percent.

On Saturday, Biola got its first win of the year, beating Holy Names (CA) 74-60. The Eagles again shot over 40 percent with Megann Alberts scoring 19 and pulling down 17 boards.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

**BETHEL COLLEGE TENN (1-1 Overall):** The Wildcats are members of the Tran-



South Conference, which along with the GSAC, are two of the toughest in the NAIA. Both conferences had five teams reach the NAIA

tournament last year with the two conferences representing the final four teams.

Bethel finished last season with a 17-13 overall record, though just a 7-11 mark in the TranSouth. This season, the Wildcats are off to a 1-1 start, beating #25 Lindsey Wilson 74-62 and falling to Campbellsville, 94-73.

Leading the returners for Bethel is senior Whitney Baird, who averaged 15.14 points and 4.45 rebounds per game in 2006-07. Junior center Jelena Budimir, from Serbia, added 11.3 points and seven rebounds per game last year.

**WILLIAMS BAPTIST COLLEGE AR (1-0 Overall):** The Eagles picked up a 73-



60 win over Blue Mountain College to open the season last week and play two more games before facing Biola on Saturday. Williams Baptist is a member of the American Midwest Conference where it posted a 12-15 overall record and a 4-10 mark in the AMC.

The Eagles had a strong first half of the season, but the year ended with five straight losses including a 55-52 defeat to the University of Illinois-Springfield in the conference playoffs.

Sequita Hightower is the Eagles' leading returning player, posting 11.1 points and 1.9 steals per game in 2006-07. However, WBC lost two of its three leading scorers and has seven underclassmen and just three seniors on this year's team.

**Alberts, Matthew Lead Eagles at HNU**

Junior forwards Megann Alberts and Summer Matthews had impressive games to start the season. Alberts scored 37 points and added 26 rebounds while Matthews scored 27 points and pulled down 23 boards as Biola split two games to open the season at the Holy Names Classic.

# BIOLA SWIMMING AND DIVING

## Swimmers Wrap Up November with Strong Showing at Pomona-Pitzer

The Biola University women's swim team split a double dual, beating Cal State East Bay and falling to Pomona-Pitzer, while the men lost a single dual to Pomona-Pitzer on Saturday at Haldeman Pool in Claremont.

The Eagles defeated Cal State East Bay 150-51 but lost to Pomona-Pitzer 123-81. The men lost to Pomona-Pitzer by a count of 148-61.

The women's team pulled out wins in five events overall with freshmen Erika Johnson and April Smith each winning twice. Johnson won the 500 and the 1,000 free while Smith touched first in the 200 free and 200 breaststroke.

Meghan Samsvick, Smith, Christina Piakak and Sarah Warkentin combined for victory in 200 Medley Relay, narrowly edging the team from Pomona-Pitzer.

There were several new national qualifiers for the women: Hannah Lawman, 200 Breast; Emily Mosbacher, 50, 100 Free; Jaclynn Petrilli, 200 Fly; Christina Piakak, 200 Fly; April Smith, 200 Free, 200 Breast.

The Biola men also had a strong showing with six first-place finishes. Zach Perkins won the freestyle sprints (50, 100 Free), Paul Mendoza took the distance freestyle events (500, 1000 Free), and Ben Oviedo won the 200 Back and 200 IM.

Also, Oviedo (200 Back) and Perkins (100 Free) earned national qualifying times.

The Eagles swim just once more in 2007, returning to the pool again on December 8th for the University of La Verne Invitational.
