## Women's Basketball Hosts Dominguez Hills; Men Play Two Division II Games

The Biola University women's basketball team returns to the court after a two-week hiatus to play one final game before heading into Christmas Break next week.

The Eagles host NCAA Division II Cal State Dominguez Hills on Saturday (Dec. 15) at 3:00 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium. (Note the start time has been changed from the original time of 7:00 p.m.)

The Toros, who were picked to win the California Collegiate Athletic Association title by the CCAA coaches at the beginning of the season, are off to a 5-2 start including wins over the GSAC's Azusa Pacific and Concordia.

Biola improved its record to 4-5 with a dominating win over Pomona-Pitzer on Saturday, Dec. 1. The Eagles had all 13 players score in the 88-45 blowout victory in their last court-ign game.

The Eagles have been playing much better basketball as of late, hanging with No. 9 Point Loma Nazarene last week and battling an improved Hope International squad before ultimately falling.

Biola's December schedule is a tough one including Saturday's contest against Dominguez Hills. After Christmas, the Eagles take on the University of British Columbia and Missouri Valley College in the GSAC Challenge Classic at The Master's College on Dec. 28 and 29. However, that tough stretch should help prepare the team for a return to GSAC play in mid-January.

### Men's Basketball Plays Two Tough NCAA Division II Schools Before Christmas

The Biola men's basketball team puts its three-game winning streak on the line against two tough NCAA Division II opponents this week as it wraps up play before Christmas.

Currently, the Eagles lead the NAIA in

scoring defense (52.9 ppg) and opposing field goal percentage (34.9) which has helped them to a 6-3 record this season. The Eagles have also not allowed more than 65 points in game this year.

The week begins on Saturday (Dec. 15) as the Eagles travel to Los Angeles to face Cal State LA at 7:00 p.m. The Golden Eagles are 3-2 on the season and are coming off a stunning home loss to Vanguard on Saturday.

Biola returns home on Monday (Dec. 17) to host Wayne State College (Neb.) at 7:00 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium. The Wildcats are out of Wayne, Neb., and members of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference.

### Women's Swimmers Sweep; Men Split at La Verne Invitational

Despite not seeing action for nearly a month, the Biola swim teams put on a strong showing on Saturday at the La Verne Invitational. The women swept host La Verne and Concordia while the men beat La Verne but lost to the other Eagles.

Of the eight events won by the women's team, seven of them came from freshman led by April Smith, who won three events.

Biola's next competition comes in January as the Eagles travel to Irvine for the UC Irvine Ayers Hotel Invitational on Jan. 5.

# BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

## Eagles Put Winning Streak on the Line Against Two NCAA DII Schools

The Biola men's basketball team puts a three-game winning streak on the line as it takes on a pair of non-conference opponents in the final week before taking a Christmas Break.

The Eagles have rattled off three-straight wins after a pair of disappointing losses in the prior week and stand at 6-3 one-third of the way through the season.

This week, Biola takes on a pair of strong NCAA Division II opponents in what should be a couple of great games.

First up, the Eagles travel to Los Angeles to face off against Cal State LA on Saturday (Dec. 15) at 7:00 p.m.

Biola's final game before Christmas is a home game against Wayne State College from Wayne, Neb. on Monday (Dec. 17) at 7:00 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

**CAL STATE LA (3-2 Overall):** The Golden Eagles are off to a respectable 3-2 record to start the season, but are still reeling from a disappointing 72-69 home loss to Vanguard University on Saturday. Cal State LA has also enjoys the luxury of playing its first seven games at home.

The Golden Eagles are members of the California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA) and play in the NCAA Division II. Cal State LA was picked to finish fifth in the CCAA Pre-Season Coaches Poll after finishing 10th in the conference in 2006-07.

Senior guard Dejon Prejean leads the Golden Eagles in scoring, averaging 18.0 ppg through the first five games. The transfer from Florida International also has team highs of 10 3-pointers, 16 assists and 11 steals.

Junior forward Louis Hamilton has provided a strong, low-post option for Cal State LA. Hamilton, from Detroit, is averaging 14.6 points and 7.2 rebounds per game and is an impressive 30-for-50 from the field.

This will be the 28th meeting between the two schools which are separated by just about 17 miles, though it will be just the first meeting since 2003-04. In that season, the Golden Eagles defeated Biola 70-59 in Los Angeles to snap a six-game series losing streak. Overall, the Eagles are 19-8 all-time against Cal State LA and 10-5 in games at CSULA.

**WAYNE STATE COLLEGE NE (6-4 Overall):** The Wildcats have dropped three of their



last four games since opening the season at 5-1. Each of the three losses in their last four games have come by seven or fewer points and they have

lost their last two road games. On the season, Wayne State is 3-3 on the road.

The Wildcats have not had trouble scoring, averaging just under 73 points per game this season. However, their defense has been surrendering nearly 74 points per contest. Turnovers have also cost them dearly as they are averaging 16.6 turnovers a game.

Sophomore guard Jamar Diggs has been the offensive leader for the Wildcats, averaging 19 points, 5.2 rebounds, 4.4 assists, 1.8 steals and 1.0 blocks per game.

Senior guard Bryce Caldwell has added 15.8 points and is averaging four made three-pointers a games.

On the inside, the Eagles will have to contend with 6-8 center Matt Rathje, who is averaging 12.2 points and 7.2 rebounds per game.

This will be the first meeting between the two schools.

**BIOLA'S DOMINANT DEFENSE:** The Eagles currently rank first in the NAIA in scoring defense, allowing just 52.9 points per game on the season. Biola has not allowed more than 65 points to any team and is holding opponents to an NAIA-low 34.9 shooting percentage.

# BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

## Eagles Host Cal State Dominguez Hills in Final Pre-Christmas Game

The Biola women's basketball team returns to action this week after taking a few days off, hosting one final game before the players head home for Christmas.

The Eagles lone game comes on Saturday (Dec. 15) against NCAA Division II Cal State Dominguez Hills at 3:00 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium. (NOTE: The start time is for Saturday's game has been changed from 7:00 to 3:00!)

After Christmas, Biola will return to action at the GSAC Challenge Classic, hosted by The Master's College on Dec. 28-29.

The Eagles are coming off an impressive 88-45 win over Pomona-Pitzer in its last counting contest. On Saturday, they took the court against the Alumni, handing their elders a big defeat.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponent this week:

**CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS (5-2 Overall):** The Toros were tabbed to win their first California Collegiate Athletic Association title in the school's history after returning all five starters from last season's team which reached the NCAA Division II playoffs for the second time in three seasons.

Already, CSUDH is off to a 5-2 start and boasts wins over Azusa Pacific (53-44) and Concordia (60-47) from the GSAC. Their two losses have come to a pair of teams which have yet to lose a game.

Leading the way for the Toros is the senior backcourt tandem of Brigayle Iglehart and Jessica Liang.

Iglehart claimed the CCAA Newcomer of the Year award and was named a First-Team All-CCAA selection in 2006-07. Currently she leads the team with 15.1 points per game and adds 5.3 rebounds and just under two steals per contest.

Liang led the conference in three-point shooting in 2006-07, hitting 39.9 percent from beyond the arc and averaging 2.56 per game. This season, she is scoring 13.1 points per game and has hit 21 three-pointers.

Senior forward Alana Bailey is contributing 9.7 points per game and leads the team

with 5.9 rebounds a contest.

On Saturday, the Toros cruised to a 60-47 win over Concordia, holding the Eagles to 28 percent shooting from the field.

The Toros have held opponents to just 56 points per game so far this season while allowing just 37.5 percent shooting.

Biola and Dominguez Hills have met 39 times since 1977, but have not played each other since the 2004-05 season. The Toros hold a 23-16 lead in the all-time series.

Biola edged the Toros in the last meeting between the two schools, winning 67-64 in 2004-05.

### BIOLA'S BALL CONTROL

The Eagles have been playing markedly better ball as of late and its been due in large part to better ball control. After committing nearly 30 turnovers a game through the first five games, Biola has committed just 18 turnovers through its last four games.

Better ball control has helped the Eagles to a pair of wins in the last four games and another two near-victories. The first was a five-point loss against a much-improved Hope International team which has lost just twice this season. The other was an impressive showing against No. 9-ranked Point Loma Nazarene, playing neck-and-neck with the Sea Lions before ultimately falling by seven.
