## Basketball Teams Head to Post-Christmas Tournaments

The Biola University Men's and Women's Basketball teams head wrap up the 2007 year with a pair of two-game tournaments this weekend.

The men's team heads north the Bay area for the Bethany University Christmas Classic on Thursday and Friday (Dec. 27-28).

The women remain close to home for their tournament, traveling to Santa Clarita for The GSAC Challenge Classic hosted by The Master's College on Friday and Saturday (Dec. 28-29).

### Biola Men Head to Bethany University Tournament

The Biola men's team is coming off a big win in its last game, knocking off NCAA Division II Wayne State University 50-48. The victory helped assure the Eagles of a winning record heading into the new year.

To close out the year, Biola heads to the Bethany University Christmas Classic this weekend. The Eagles take on host Bethany University on Thursday (Dec. 27) at 7:30 p.m. and face Evangel University (Mo.) on Friday (Dec. 28) at 3:30 p.m.

Bethany has struggled early on this season, going 0-14 through the first half of the year. The Bruins are led by 6-3 junior guard George Golden, who is averaging 14.1 points per game and adds 6.3 rebounds per contest. He is the only player on the team scoring in double-digits on the season.

Bethany has played five GSAC teams this year and lost each time. Biola leads the all-time series against the Bruins 16-2.

Evangel comes into the tournament with a 9-2 record and is ranked No. 5 in NAIA Di-

vision II. The Crusaders have been outscoring opponents by over 15 points per game and their two losses have come by just two points in each game.

Junior guard Jackson Capel is Evangel's biggest threat, scoring 20.3 points per game and leads the team with 40 three-pointers on the season.

The Eagles won the only other meeting between these two schools, downing the Crusaders 83-78 back in 1986.

### Eagle Women Participate in GSAC Challenge Classic at The Master's College

Biola's women's team looks to get back on the winning track this week at the GSAC Challenge Classic at The Master's College.

The Eagles face off against the University of British Columbia on Friday (Dec. 28) at 2:00 p.m., then take on Missouri Valley College on Saturday (Dec. 29) at 4:00 p.m.

British Columbia is off to a great start at 16-2 including a nine-straight. Their lone two losses came to NCAA Division I Arkansas and Canadian powerhouse Simon Fraser.

The Thunderbirds are led by Erica McGuinness, who scores 15.4 points per game. Leanne Evans adds 11.3 points and 10.6 rebounds per contest.

This will be the first meeting between the two schools.

Biola also faces Missouri Valley College, an NAIA Division II school from Marshall, Missouri.

The Vikings are 5-3 on the season and have lost two of their last three contests heading into the tournament this weekend.

Senior forward Bonnie Johnson is the catalyst of the team, scoring 21.3 points per game and adding 9.3 rebounds per contest.

This is also the first meeting between these two schools.
