Eager to put a frustrating week behind him, the Biola men's basketball team returns to the court this week for a pair of non-conference games.

First up for the Eagles is a cross-town game against Whittier College on Tuesday (Dec. 4) at 7:30 p.m.

Biola wraps up a busy stretch of games on Saturday (Dec. 8) by hosting Pomona-Pitzer College. That game will also tip-off at 7:30 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium

The Eagles are coming off a disappointing week which saw them drop two of three games including a pair of GSAC contests. However, the season is still young and there are a lot of basketball games ahead of this team.

Biola's win over Cal State Maritime on Saturday (Dec. 1) gave the Eagles a 4-3 record heading into this week.

Women's Basketball Hosts Annual Alumni Game on Saturday

The Biola women's basketball team has already played nearly one-third of its schedule and will take a much-needed break this week capped by the annual Alumni Game on Saturday (Dec. 8) at 5:30 p.m.

The Eagles game against their "seasoned" opponents is their only action this week but should be an entertaining contest. The alumni squad is comprised of players who stay in shape and probably won't need to use the oxygen tank more than once or twice during the game.

Leading the way for the alums will be the Biola assistant coaches Bethany Miller and Nicole Klasey, who do not want to have to hear about the varsity squad winning throughout another season.

Biola's final game before Christmas comes on Saturday, November 15, when the Eagles

host NCAA Division II Cal State Dominguez Hills at Chase Gymnasium at 7:00 p.m.

Last week, Biola played to a 1-2 record, falling twice in a pair of GSAC games, but rebounding with an 88-45 win over Pomona-Pitzer College in a non-conference game on Saturday (Dec. 1). Biola is now 4-5 on the season.

Swim Team Returns to Action at University of La Verne Invitational

It has been nearly a month since the Biola University swim team was last in action. However, the Eagles return to action on Saturday, (Dec. 8) as they travel to La Verne for the annual University of La Verne Invitational.

Biola will be favored to win the majority of races at the meet, which features Mills College, Concordia University and host La Verne.

The will take nearly another month off before the UC Irvine Invitational meet comes around in January, which kicks off a stretch of five-straight meets in the month.

Volleyball Wraps Up Season With NAIA Semifinal Appearance

The Biola volleyball team concluded the season with an impressive run through the NAIA National Tournament, reaching what turned out to be an all-GSAC semifinal before falling to eventual champion Fresno Pacific.

Junior middle blocker Kristen Peterson and junior outside hitter Meghan Warkentin were named to the NAIA All-Tournament team for their performances at the Championships. Warkentin also was named an NAIA First-Team All-American for the second straight season.

The Eagles posted a 32-8 overall record in 2007, their best mark in nine years, and finished fourth in the GSAC with a 14-6 mark.

BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

Eagles Look to Rebound With Pair of Non-Conference Games This Week

The Biola men's basketball team had a rough week last week, dropping a pair of conference games before wrapping things up with a blowout win over Cal State Maritime on Saturday.

The Eagles will look to right the ship with a pair of contests against non-conference foes this week.

Biola hosts cross-town opponent Whittier College on Tuesday (Dec. 4) at 7:30 p.m. in Chase Gymnasium.

The Eagles wrap up the week against another local team in Pomona-Pitzer College on Saturday (Dec. 8). That game will also be at 7:30 p.m. in Chase Gymnasium.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

WHITTIER COLLEGE CA (3-1 Overall):

The Poets have gotten off to a strong start this season and are out of the gate with three wins in their first four contests. Their lone defeat came at the hands of Holy Names University, which handed Whittier a one-point loss in late November.

The Poets are member of the Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC) and play in the NCAA Division III. During the 2006-07 season, Whittier finished seventh in the SCIAC with a 3-11 conference mark and a 9-16 overall record.

Whittier's leading scorer through its first four games has been guard Marcus Gibson, who has averaged 15.5 points thus far. The junior from Fullerton has shot 50 percent from the field including hitting 13-of-22 from beyond the arc.

Jeff McLean is not far behind with a 14.0 ppg average. McLean, a junior forward from Massachusetts, has scored 56 points in 86 minutes this season and is averaging 4.8 rebounds per game with eight steals on the season.

Despite being just about seven miles apart, the two teams have met just four times since the 1983-84 season with the Eagles winning all four contests.

Overall, Biola holds a 14-10 lead in the all-time series and has won the last nine games between the two schools. The last meeting came in 2005-06 when Biola edged the Poets 81-69 in La Mirada.

POMONA-PITZER COLLEGE CA (2-4 Overall):

The Sagehens have been busy over the last few weeks, playing five games in the last two weeks including three in as many days last weekend. Pomona-Pitzer went 1-2 at the Redlands Invitational last weekend, defeating West Coast Bible College 69-57 before falling to Whitworth (Wash.) and Chapman to take fourth in the tournament.



The Sagehens' offense has centered around a pair of big post players this season. Their leading scorer has been senior forward Jabbari Reynolds with 14.2 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while sophomore forward Justin Sexton has 13.6 points and 8.6 board per contest.

Under the direction of head coach Charles Katsiaticas, Pomona-Pitzer has been one of the most dominate teams in the SCIAC the last decade, winning six of the last 10 conference titles and 10 since 1985. The Sagehens finished tied for second in the conference in 2006-07 despite an impressive 16-8 overall record.

Biola is a perfect 12-0 against Pomona-Pitzer dating back to the start of the series in 1996. Last year, the Eagles got a scare before finally defeating the Sagehens 95-89 in Claremont. Danny Jones scored 25 points and added seven rebounds and seven assists to lead Biola and was one of five players to score in double-digits for the team. Despite shooting 62.5 percent from the field, it took a big defensive stand for the Eagles to pick up the win.
