Fall Sports Kick Off 2007-08 Athletic Seasons

It seems hard to believe that the 2007-08 school year is right around the corner. But after a warm and relaxing summer vacation, the students are returning to campus and another exciting Biola sports season is about to begin.

The Eagles' fall sports teams have been enduring two-a-days in the Southern California heat and are ready to kick off the 2007-08 school year with a number of preseason games this week.

Volleyball Travels To Fresno

Biola Volleyball begins the year with its annual trek up to the Central Valley for the Fresno Pacific Sunbird Classic on Friday and Saturday (Aug. 24-25).

The Eagles, who open the season ranked No. 11 in the NAIA Preseason Poll, will take on three teams from Oregon. They open against Concordia University OR and Southern Oregon University on Friday, then take on Oregon Tech on Saturday.

Biola returns nine letterwinners and all seven starters from the 2006 team, which finished 20-12 and ranked No. 12 in the final NAIA National Rankings.

Women's Soccer Plays Three NCAA Exhibition Matches

Biola's Women's Soccer team embarks on an ambitious schedule with a trio of road scrimmages this week—all against tough NCAA schools.

The Eagles take on two NCAA Division II schools to start the week, facing Cal State LA on Monday (Aug. 20) at 7

p.m. and Cal Poly Pomona on Thursday (Aug. 23) at 6 p.m.

The weeks wraps up with Biola traveling to face NCAA Division I Cal State Fullerton on Saturday (Aug. 25) at 7:00 p.m. in its final scrimmage.

Biola opens the regular season on Sept. 1 at home against Oregon Tech.

Men's Soccer Plays Two Scrimmages, Hosts Home Match on Friday

The Biola Men's Soccer team is coming off another successful season and will look to keep the momentum going in 2007. However, it will be difficult as a number of new faces take to the pitch for the Eagles as they kick off the year at Cal State LA on Monday (Aug. 20) at 4:30 p.m.

The week continues with an early morning match at Cal Poly Pomona on Thursday (Aug. 23) with the scrimmage set to kick off at 10:00 a.m.

Biola's regular season begins on Friday (Aug. 24) as the Eagles welcome Saint Martin's University to Al Barbour Field for a 5:00 p.m. match. Saint Martin's is an NCAA Division II school from Washington State which is in its first season. For the Saints, it will be just the second match in the program's history.

Cross Country and Golf Begin in Sept.

The Biola cross country teams open the season in September while the inaugural men's and women's golf seasons tee off next month as well. More information on both of these teams will be available in next week's issue of EagleSports Weekly.

Biola Tips off 2007 Season at Fresno Pacific Classic

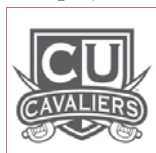
Biola opens the 2007 season with a trip up to Fresno to take part in the annual Fresno Pacific Sunbird Classic. The Eagles face three NAIA schools from Oregon, taking on Concordia (Ore.) and Southern Oregon on Friday (Aug. 24) and Oregon Tech on Saturday (Aug. 25).

The Eagles will be looking to kick off the season right, especially after being ranked No. 11 in the NAIA's Preseason poll released last week.

While none of the teams Biola faces in Fresno were ranked in the poll, the Eagles will be looking to get the season going in the right direction with three victories.

Here's a look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

CONCORDIA OR (2006: 13-15, 10-8 Cascade Conference): The Cavaliers lost five players from last year's squad—including two All-Region I players—and have seven newcomers on the roster in 2007. This will be the first match of the season for the young Concordia squad as well as the first action for Biola. The Eagles are 1-1 all-time against the Cavaliers. Their last meeting came in 2003 at the Fresno Classic with Biola winning 3-0.

SOUTHERN OREGON (2006: 18-9, 15-3 Cascade Conference): The Raiders have been among the best teams in the Cascade Conference recently, winning the conference title three times in the last four seasons and finishing second in 2006. Southern Oregon was picked to finish second in the CCC's preseason poll and even picked up a few votes in the NAIA Preseason poll. The Raiders lost just one starter from last year's team and return the majority of their offense. They are led by junior middle blocker Mia Wortel who averaged 4.06 kills, 1.20 block and 1.14 digs per game last year.

OREGON TECH (2006: 21-9, 12-6 Cascade Conference): The Owls are coming off an impressive season in which they finished third in the tough Cascade Conference. However, they are also a young team having lost five players from the 2006 squad. Senior outside hitter Krista Wooley led OIT with 4.38 kills and 3.83 digs per game last year. Michelle Klaja, another senior outside hitter, returns after missing last season due to an injury. She posted 2.79 kills and 3.49 digs per game in 2005.

The star outside hitter was married this summer and will be going by her married name of Warkentin this year. If that name sounds familiar, Meghan's new sister-in-law is Michelle Warkentin who played for the Eagles from 2000-03 and whose name can be found all over the Biola volleyball record book.

BIOLA MEN'S SOCCER

Biola Men's Soccer Kicks Off 2007 on Friday

Biola's men's soccer team kicks off the 2007 season with a pair of non-counting contests before playing their first regular-season match on Friday. All three games this week are against NCAA Division II teams.

The Eagles finished the 2006 season with a 9-6-1 record, earning yet another NAIA playoff berth. However, the 2007 squad features just nine returning players and 10 new faces. The team is quite young with just six upperclassmen, but expectations are still high, nonetheless.

Here are a look at the upcoming opponents Biola faces:

CAL STATE LOS ANGELES (2006: 13-8-2, 10-6-0 CCAA): The Golden Eagles open the season ranked No. 17 in the NCAA Division II Pre-season poll and were selected by the CCAA coaches to finish fourth in the conference. Senior Morten Marthinsen, a Third-Team All-American last year, leads the CSULA offense. In 2006, Marthinsen led the Golden Eagles to the NCAA Far West Region Championship thanks to his 13 goals and 31 points.



CAL POLY POMONA (2006: 8-8-3, 6-7-3 CCAA): The Broncos struggled offensively last season, scoring just 25 goals in 19 matches. They have been picked to finish fourth out of the five teams in the CCAA South Division this year. While offense may be hard to come by, Cal Poly Pomona's defense has been strong. The Broncos allowed just 27 goals and had four shutouts on the season. Cal Poly Pomona will need to look to a new group of freshman and transfers to provide some much-needed offense.



SAINT MARTIN'S UNIVERSITY (First Year Program): The Saints have just added men's soccer for the first time in the school's history and the team will begin play on Thursday at Cal State LA. Saint Martin's

joins a tough Great Northwest Athletic Conference, which has produced the Far West Region's representative to the NCAA Division II National tournament in all but one of the last five seasons. The Saints are coached by Rob Walker, who has assisted on the US National Team coaching staff and has years of experience coaching high school teams.



GET THIS PARTY STARTED: Biola has had great success in season-openers through its history. The Eagles are 22-19-6 in the season openers and are 27-16-4 in home openers. Under Head Coach Bryan Kuderman, the Eagles are undefeated, going 4-0-1 to kick off the season.

KUDERMAN'S KOACHING: After five seasons, Coach Kuderman has put together the best overall coaching record in school history at 55-31-6 (.603 winning percentage). He has guided the Eagles to at least nine wins each year and helped them reach the playoffs in three of his five seasons.

Eagles Play Three Tough Scrimmages to Open 2007 Season

Biola's women's soccer team has put together one of its most ambitious schedules in the programs' 16-year history.

The schedule opens with four scrimmages against NCAA schools, starting with last Friday's trip to UC San Diego. While official score is not kept at these scrimmages, Biola's coaches were pleased with the way the Eagles handled the Tritons' vaunted offense.

Up next are three more NCAA opponents before the regular season kicks off on Sept. 1. While official scores are not kept at these matches either, the experience will go a long way to help Biola's young team.

Here's a look at this week's opponents:

CAL STATE LOS ANGELES (2006: 9-7-3, 7-6-3 CCAA): The Golden Eagles finished third in the CCAA last year and return all 11 starters from that team. Still, they were picked to finish fourth in the CCAA Southern Division in 2007. Leading the way is senior midfielder Erika Prado who scored two goals and added eight assists. Also returning to the squad is senior goalkeeper Reyna Coca, who earned second-team all-CCAA honors with a 1.23 goals against average.

CAL POLY POMONA (2006: 8-9-2, 6-8-2 CCAA): While the game against Cal Poly Pomona will be a scrimmage for Biola, it will be a counter for CPP. The 2006 season got off to a strong start for the Mustangs, but they lost seven of their last nine after a 6-2-2 start. Despite being a young team, the Broncos return their top two scorers in junior forward Pamela Leyva and sophomore forward Mary Carroll. Leyva scored nine goals and had five assists while Carroll had 10 goals and one assist.

CAL STATE FULLERTON (2006: 12-8-2, 4-2-1 Big West): Biola's final tuneup comes against NCAA Division I Cal State

Fullerton. The Titans are coming off their second consecutive trip to the NCAA



Tournament and their second-straight Big West Conference Tournament title. Fullerton returns eight starters and 14 letter winners off of last season's squad which is led by first-year head coach Demian Brown.

COACH SILZER'S SUCCESS: In six seasons of coaching at Biola, Head Coach Mike Silzer has led the Eagles to a record of 63-34-12. The 63 victories are exactly half of the 126 victories in the program's history and his .633 winning percentage is the best at Biola.

HOME KICK OFF: The Eagles open the 2007 regular season at home next week, hosting Oregon Tech at 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 1.
