## Men's Soccer and Volleyball Off To Important Early-Season Tournaments

The 2007-08 Biola sports season is off to a great start as Men's Soccer and Volleyball open the season with wins. Both teams continue their seasons with crucial early season tournaments as the Men's Soccer team travels to Utah and the Volleyball squad heads to Concordia-Irvine.

The women's soccer team will play its first home match of the season on Saturday (Sept. 1), hosting Oregon Tech at Al Barbour Field.

The nationally-ranked women's cross country team competes in its first meet of the 2007 season, joining the men's squad at the Cal State Fullerton Invitation on Saturday (Sept. 1).

### Women's Soccer Hosts Oregon Tech

Biola's Women's Soccer team opens the home portion of its schedule on Saturday (Sept. 1) against Oregon Tech at 7:00 p.m. at Al Barbour Field.

The Eagles played three matches last week with just one counting in the standings. The Eagles dropped the counter against Cal Poly Pomona 2-1 despite playing well against a tough NCAA DII team.

### #11 Volleyball Plays in Concordia (CA) Labor Day Festival

After opening the season with three wins at the Fresno Pacific Classic last week, the Eagles return to action closer to home at the Concordia Labor Day Festival on Friday and Saturday (Aug. 31-Sept. 1).

Biola, ranked No. 11 in the latest NAIA National Poll, will be facing some tough competition at the tournament as

three of its four opponents are also ranked in the Top 25.

On Friday, the Eagles take on Olivet Nazarene University (Ill.) and No. 6 Albertson College (Idaho). Saturday's opponents are No. 23 Great Falls (Mont.) and No. 25 Westminster College (Utah).

### Men's Soccer Travels to Utah

The Men's Soccer team takes its perfect 1-0-0 record to the state of Utah and the Westminster College Tournament Friday through Monday (Aug. 31-Sept. 3). The Eagles will be taking on Albertson College (Idaho) on Friday, Westminster on Saturday and Olivet Nazarene University on Monday.

While none of the teams Biola will face are nationally ranked, the young Eagles squad needs a strong performance to prepare them for the start of the tough GSAC schedule which is just weeks away.

### Cross Country Opens at Cal State Fullerton Invitational

The Men's and Women's Cross Country teams open the season at the Cal State Fullerton Invitational at Carbon Canyon Regional Park in Brea on Saturday (Sept. 1). The 5k women's race begins at 8:15 a.m. and the 8k men's race at 9:15 a.m.

The women's squad opened the season ranked No. 13 nationally, marking the first time in recent memory either team has garnered national attention.

The men's team has also moved up to start the season, being ranked No. 7 in the NAIA Region II poll.

# BIOLA VOLLEYBALL

## #11 Eagles Face Off Against Tough Competition at Concordia Tournament

After opening with three straight victories last week, the Biola volleyball squad faces its first test of the 2007 season this week at the Concordia University (Calif.) Labor Day Festival.

This two-day, 21-team festival features 11 teams ranked in the NAIA Preseason top-25 poll including six in the top 11.

Three of Biola's four opponents in the classic are ranked including a Friday night match against No. 6 Albertson College.

Here's a look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

### OLIVET NAZARENE IL (2006: 30-16 Overall, 8-1 CCAC):

This will be the first match of the season for the Tigers, who are the defending NAIA Region VII Champs and earned a spot in the NAIA National Tournament in 2006. Five of the starting six are returning for ONU, which lost just three players

overall. Outside hitter Michelle McFadden leads the returners. McFadden was an All-CCAC, All-NAIA Region VII and NAIA Honorable Mention honoree after finishing fourth on the team with 349 kills and second with 121 blocks, despite missing 14 matches.



### No. 6 ALBERTSON COLLEGE ID (0-4 Record):

The Coyotes opened the season at the Westminster (Utah) Tournament where they went 0-4 against nationally-

ranked competition. Three of Albertson's four losses were in five-game matches, including a thriller against No. 1 National American

University. The 'Yotes have used a balanced attack thus far as four players have two or more kills per game. Leading the way is junior outside hitter Kathryn Ely who has 55 kills (2.89 per game.)

### No. 23 GREAT FALLS MT (1-2 Record):

The Argos were also participants in the Westminster Tournament last weekend and

finished with a 1-2 record. They managed a win over Albertson in five games, but were unable to overcome Pt. Loma or National American. Statistics or more information from Great Falls were not available.



### No. 25 WESTMINSTER COLLEGE UT (3-0 Record):

The Griffins are the biggest surprise of the early season as they went a perfect 3-0 against difficult competition

at their own tournament last weekend. Westminster opened with a five-game win over No. 6 Albertson,

then followed it up later that night with a three-game sweep over No. 16 Pt. Loma Nazarene. As if that wasn't enough, the Griffins then closed out the tournament with a 3-1 win over No. 1 National American University.

**LAST WEEK:** The Eagles opened the season with a trio of sweeps, beating Southern Oregon University, Concordia (Ore.) and Oregon Tech at the Fresno Pacific Sunbird Classic. **Meghan Warkentin (Scheenstra)** led the way with 45 kills (5.50 per game).

# BIOLA MEN'S SOCCER

## Eagles Open Season with Win; Travel to Utah for Westminster Tournament

Biola's men's soccer season is off to a strong start after the Eagles dispatched of St. Martin's University 2-0 in their season opener on Friday.

Now, the Eagles make their annual trek to Utah to take part in the Westminster College (UT) Invitational where they will play three matches in four days.

Biola opens on Friday (Aug. 31) against Albertson College of Idaho at 2:00 p.m. The Eagles then face host Westminster at 2:30 p.m. on Saturday (Sept. 1) and close out the tournament on Monday (Sept. 3) against Olivet Nazarene University at Noon. None of the three teams were ranked in the NAIA Preseason poll.

Here is a look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

### ALBERTSON COLLEGE ID (2006: 11-7-1, 9-3-0 CCC):

The 'Yotes are set to open the 2007 schedule on Thursday as they take on Westminster in the first game of the Invitational. In 2006, Albertson won the CCC title and reached the Region I tournament, falling in the semifinals. Senior netminder Jay Gentle, an All-CCC, All-Region I and Honorable mention NAIA All-American, leads the returners. In 2006, Gentle was 10-2 with a 0.97 Goals Against Average and had four shutouts.

### WESTMINSTER COLLEGE UT (1-2 Overall):

The Griffins started off the season with high hopes, but have just one victory in their first two matches. Westminster opened with a 2-1 victory over Cal State San Marcos, but lost 1-0 to The Master's College and 3-2 to Colorado School of Mines. The Griffins will play two more matches before hosting the Eagles on Saturday. Westminster has an odd schedule this season, playing its first nine matches at home before finishing the year with nine straight road contests.

**OLIVET NAZARENE IL (2006: 9-7-1, 5-3-1 CCAC):** The Tigers also play Alb-ertson and Westminster prior to taking



on Biola at the tournament. The Tigers' leading returner is Josh Ayers, who tallied 14 points last year. However, offense may be hard to come by as over half of the team's goals in '06 came from players who are no longer on the team.

**LAST WEEK:** Biola had little trouble defeating Saint Martin's University 2-0 in its season opener at Al Barbour Field.

Senior **Ryan Parker** got things going early, beating a pair of defenders then the Saints' goalkeeper with a blast to the far post in the ninth minute.

Biola's second goal came just 13 minutes later as **Humberto Toscan** scored on a header off a free kick from senior **Colin Kilpatrick**.

Freshman goalie **Tyler Higgins** played strong in net, making five saves to earn the shutout in his first collegiate match.

# BIOLA WOMEN'S SOCCER

## Eagles Open Home Portion of Schedule against Oregon Tech on Saturday

Biola's women's soccer team wrapped up the last of its scrimmages on Saturday and now the Eagles open their home schedule on Saturday (Sept. 1) against Oregon Tech.

Biola was forced to make its regular season debut a bit earlier than expected as the match against Cal Poly Pomona wound up being a counting contest instead of an exhibition. Checkout the breakdown of the game below.

Here's a look at this week's opponent:

**OREGON TECH (1-0-1 Overall):** The Owls are off to a positive start in 2007 after a successful 2006 campaign which saw the team reach the playoffs for the first time in school history. Oregon Tech finished 10-9-1 last season and reached the conference semifinals before losing to top-seed Concordia (Ore).

The 2007 Owls opened the season with a scoreless draw against Southern Oregon on Friday, then beat Holy Names 5-0 on Saturday. Though the second game appeared to be a blowout, Oregon Tech put the match away with four goals in the final 15 minutes of the match.

Junior netminder Jaclyn Unruh posted back-to-back shutouts to open the season, making 15 saves and facing 22 shots. Sophomore forward Marcy Toro scored the first two goals for Oregon Tech in the win over Holy Names, and assisted on the third.

This will be the first-ever meeting between these two schools.

**LAST WEEK:** The Eagles played three matches last week, two scrimmages and their season-opener at Cal Poly Pomona. (The scores and other information for the scrimmages are not released per NAIA rules.)

Biola opened the week against NCAA Division II Cal State LA and wrapped things up against NCAA Division I Cal State Fullerton. Both matches featured an impressive Biola defense clamping down

on a pair of high-flying offenses.

Between those matches, the Eagles and Cal Poly Pomona faced off in what was originally a scrimmage but was changed to a counting contest during the week. Despite a great effort by the Eagles against the NCAA Division II school, Cal Poly Pomona came away with a 2-1 win.

The Eagles looked to have a bit of first-game jitters in the opening 20 minutes of the match, allowing two goals and looking a bit disoriented. However, things settled down from there and the Eagles began to get back into the match.

In the second half, Biola closed within one goal thanks to a great header by sophomore midfielder **Kahlie Reinecke** in the 72nd minute. Reinecke was able to get a head on a beautiful cross off the foot of junior forward **Brittany Neill**.

Freshman netminder **Lauren Gregston** allowed two goals in her collegiate debut, but also made three saves for the Eagles.
