## Men's Soccer Hosts Biola Classic Soccer Tournament This Weekend

It's been a while since the Biola University soccer team has hosted a regular-season tournament, but that is exactly what will be happening this weekend.

The Eagles welcome in Trinity International University (Ill.), Simon Fraser (B.C.) and Vanguard University to Al Barbour Field on Friday and Saturday (Sept. 14-15) for the Biola Classic.

The Classic opens on Friday with Simon Fraser taking on Vanguard and Biola hosting Trinity International. On Saturday, the Eagles take on Simon Fraser with Vanguard facing Trinity International.

Biola is coming off a 2-0 week which saw them outscore their two opponents 9-1 and improve to 3-3-0 on the season.

### Women's Soccer Takes on Trinity International University

Biola's women's soccer squad returns home for a non-conference match this week against Trinity International University on Friday (Sept. 14) at 4:30 p.m.

Trinity, who will also take on Vanguard University on Saturday as part of the Biola Classic, is 3-2 on the year and could prove to be a good challenge for the young Biola squad.

The Eagles are coming off an impressive display against one of the best team in NCAA Division II, falling 1-0 to Cal State Dominguez Hills on Monday.

### Volleyball Heads to San Diego Christian, Hosts No. 6 Point Loma Nazarene

The No. 5-ranked Biola volleyball teams continued its perfect start to the

2007 season with a pair of wins to open GSAC play last week.

Biola travels to San Diego Christian on Tuesday (Sept. 11) for a GSAC match before returning home for what should be a thriller against No. 6 Pt. Loma Nazarene University on Saturday (Sept. 15). That match is scheduled for a 7:00 p.m. start.

The Eagles and the Sea Lions will likely be the two teams battling for the fourth and final GSAC berth to the NAIA National Championships in November.

### Cross Country Heads to Westmont Invitational

Biola's cross country teams will face a number of GSAC teams for the first time this season as they travel to the Westmont Invitational in Santa Barbara on Saturday (Sept. 15).

The Westmont Invitational, which has been run since 1979, will feature seven GSAC teams (including Biola) along with Cal State San Marcos, another NAIA Region II team.

The Eagles had another strong showing at the UC Irvine Invitational last week with Kristin Schmidt placing second overall on the women's side and Brian Ball taking seventh in the men's race.

# BIOLA VOLLEYBALL

## No. 5 Eagles Host 6 Pt. Loma Nazarene in Key GSAC Match on Saturday

The Biola volleyball team continued its perfect start to the 2007 season with a pair of victories to open GSAC play last week.

The Eagles, ranked No. 5 in the NAIA National Poll released last week, beat #20 Vanguard University in four games on Thursday and swept Westmont in Santa Barbara on Saturday.

Biola continued GSAC play this week, traveling down to El Cajon to face San Diego Christian College on Tuesday (Sept. 11). The Eagles then return home for a huge GSAC match against No. 6-ranked Point Loma Nazarene University on Saturday (Sept. 15) at 7:00 p.m.

Here's a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

### SAN DIEGO CHRISTIAN COLLEGE (4-7 overall, 0-2 GSAC):

The Hawks earned their first regional rankings in nearly six years thanks to a 4-5 record at two season-opening tournament. SDCC went 2-2 at the Embry-Riddle Classic, defeating Concordia (Mich.) twice, and followed that with a 2-3 showing at the Concordia University Labor Day Tournament.

However, the Hawks dropped their first two GSAC matches last week including a 3-1 home loss to Hope International.

SDCC is led by junior outside hitter Meggan Chapin, who has 123 kills (3.29/game) and recorded 20 in the four-set loss to Hope on Saturday.

Biola is 19-4 all-time against the Hawks and has not lost to SDCC since 2002.

### #6 POINT LOMA NAZARENE UNIVERSITY (7-2 Overall, 1-1 GSAC):

The Sea Lions started the year strong, beating then-No. 1 National American University in their first match, but falling to Westminster in their second. On Saturday, PLNU dropped its second match of the year in a three-game sweep at the hands of No. 2 Concordia.

Junior outside hitter Melissa Boer leads the Sea Lions with 110 kills on the season (4.07/game). She also has 101 digs (3.74/game), 14 blocks and 13 aces.

Biola holds a slim 32-25 edge in the all-time series, though PLNU is 12-5 since 2000. Last year, the teams each won in five-game thrillers on their home court.

**STARTING THINGS OFF RIGHT:** The Eagles are off to a great start at 9-0 on the season—the fifth-best start in school history. The school record? In 1996, Biola opened up with a 23-0 record and finished the season at 30-5, reaching the NAIA National Semifinals. The Eagles other undefeated starts came in 2002 (15-0), 1977 (14-0) and 1988 (12-0).

### WARKENTIN NAMED NAIA NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Junior outside hitter **Meghan Warkentin (Scheenstra)** was named the NAIA National Player of the Week for the week of Aug. 27 - Sept. 3. She recorded 79 kills (5.64/game) with a .392 hitting percentage to lead No. 11 Biola to four wins in as many matches at the Concordia Labor Day Festival last week. She also had 40 digs (2.86/game), six aces, four blocks and three assists.

# BIOLA MEN'S SOCCER

## Eagles Host Four-Team Biola Classic Tournament on Friday and Saturday

The Eagles closed out their season-long five-match road trip with a pair of victories last week, defeating Dominican University (Calif.) 3-0 and downing Menlo College (Calif.) 5-1.

Biola wrapped up the road trip winning just two of the five matches, but still sit at a respectable 3-3-0 on the season.

This week, the Eagles host the first regular-season tournament at Biola in recent memory in the 2007 Biola Soccer Classic. The field features fellow GSAC foe Vanguard University as well as Trinity International University (Ill.) and Simon Fraser University (B.C.)

Biola faces Trinity on Friday while Vanguard plays Simon Fraser. On Saturday, the Eagles take on SFU with Vanguard playing against Trinity. There will also be a women's soccer game on each day, bringing the total to three games a day.

Here is a closer look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

**TRINITY INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY IL (0-4-1 Overall):** The Trojans finished 2006 with an 11-7-3 record and reached the NAIA Region VII semifinals. However, they have not been able to carry that success into 2007 and are still looking for their first win of the season.

TIU has struggled offensively, scoring just three goals in five matches. However, they have allowed just nine goals with five coming in a 5-2 loss to No. 19 Lindenwood University.

Unfortunately, stats for Trinity International were not available as of press time.

These two teams have met on the pitch before, back on August 31, 1996. In that match, the Eagles defeated the Trojans at home by a 4-0 score to open the season.

**SIMON FRASER UNIVERSITY BC (6-1-0 Overall):** The Clan started out the season with five consecutive shutouts before losing 2-1 to Whitworth College. Simon

Fraser junior netminder Thomas Lindley has been solid this year, allowing just the two goals in six matches and posting a 0.34 goals against average. He has made 14 saves and been credited with four shutouts.



Sophomore Lucas Barrett leads the Clan with three goals while junior Justin Carvary has two goals and a pair of assists.

The Eagles are 0-4-0 against SFU all-time including a 2-1 loss when the teams last met in 2005.

**LAST WEEK:** Biola's Ryan Parker, Shalom Bako and Jake Ravenscraft each scored goals to lead the Eagles to a 3-0 win over Dominican University on Friday. The match was plagued with fouls and cards, but Biola managed to overcome the rough play for its first win in four matches.

Parker added another goal on Saturday and Humberto Toscan scored a goal and added an assist as the Eagles overcame an early one-goal deficit and beat Menlo 5-1. The goal was Parker's third of the year.

## Eagles Return to Action against Trinity International University on Friday

Biola looked very impressive in a 1-0 loss to NCAA Division II power Cal State Dominguez Hills in their only match of the week last week.

Despite facing 28 shots, the Eagles managed to turn away the high-scoring Toro offense and even had a couple of late chances to salvage a tie.

Biola will play just its second match in 13 days, taking on Trinity International University on Friday (Sept. 14) as part of the Biola Soccer Classic. The match will kick-off at 4:30 p.m.

Here is a closer look at this week's opponent:

**#23 TRINITY INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (3-2-0 Overall):** The Trojans picked up wins in their first three matches of the year before losing their last two. TIU's first loss was a 3-1 defeat at the hands of No. 9 McKendree University on Sept. 1. That was fol-

lowed by a surprising 2-0 loss to unranked Indiana Wesleyan University on Sept. 7.

The Trojans have yet to play a home match and will be playing their sixth and seventh road contests of the year this weekend.

While complete team stats were not available from TIU, it is safe to say that offense is not a problem for the Trojans. They have scored 15 goals in five matches so far this year including an eight goal outburst against Jamestown College (N.D.).

This will be the first match between these two schools.

**LAST WEEK:** The Eagles played just one match last week, but it proved to be a good one. Biola took on NCAA Division II powerhouse Cal State Dominguez Hills in Carson and played well despite losing 1-0.

Biola netminder Lauren Gregston made 14 saves and faced 28 shots to keep

the Eagles in the match. The only mistake she made on the night came in the 38th minute, though there wasn't that much she could do about it. As the Eagles defense was under pressure by the Toro offense, the final Biola defender passed the ball back to Gregston. She went to clear the ball, but it hit an oncoming CSUDH attacker and bounced into the open net.

The Eagles offense tried to get back into the match, but had trouble getting past the Toro defense. They had two great chances to score, one in each half. In the 25th minute, freshman forward Tara Roetter snuck behind the defense of the Toros and took the ball down the near side but her shot was saved by Toro defender Alysia Barone.

In the 88th minute, Roetter had another chance with a header toward the Toro net, but again Barone was there to thwart the attempt.

## Biola Travels to Santa Barbara for the Westmont Invitational on Saturday

The Biola cross country teams will be facing their first GSAC opponents this season as they head to the Westmont Invitational in Santa Barbara on Saturday (Sept. 15). The men's 8k race begins at 9:30 a.m. with the men's 5k race starting at 10:20.

Biola will be racing against six other GSAC schools in Fresno Pacific University, The Master's College, Vanguard University, San Diego Christian College, Point Loma Nazarene University and host Westmont College.

In addition, fellow NAIA Region II opponent Cal State San Marcos will be participating, giving the Eagles an early chance to see how they fare against other Regional opponents.

The Westmont Invitational has been around since 1979. That first year, Biola's Gary Wolliscroft won the men's event with a time of 27:29 on the five mile course. Overall, the Eagles have done well in the

meet and are looking to improve their team time this year compared with the other schools in the meet.

**LAST WEEK:** The Biola women took top honors in the Collegiate Race at the UC Irvine Invitational on Saturday (Sept. 8). Biola placed six runners in the top 17 and eight in the top 23 overall.

Leading the way for the Eagles was sophomore Kristin Schmidt, who placed second overall. Anna Thibodo was sixth with Katie Thede in ninth. The women's course was a bit shorter than expected as a course-marking error led to an unplanned shortcut.

On the men's side, Biola's Brian Ball took seventh overall in a field of 195 runners as the Eagles finished 10th overall. David Kostelyk was 40th and Ryan Richert placed 50th as the Eagles ran one of their best team races in a number of years with each runner dropping time from last year.
