#5 Volleyball Hosts #2 Concordia on Saturday in Key GSAC Match

Coming off its most impressive victory of the young season, the #5-ranked Biola Volleyball squad prepares to welcome #2-ranked Concordia University to the Richard Chase Gymnasium on Saturday (Sept. 22). Before that big showdown, the Eagles travel to GSAC foe Hope International University for a match on Tuesday (Sept. 18).

The Eagles looked outstanding in a three-game sweep over No. 7-ranked Point Loma Nazarene on Saturday at Biola. With the win, the Eagles remain perfect on the 2007 season at 11-0 and are now 4-0 in the GSAC.

Women's Soccer Hosts Cal State San Marcos, Opens GSAC at The Master's

Biola's women's soccer team plays one final pre-conference tune-up, taking on Cal State San Marcos on Thursday (Sept. 20) at Al Barbour Field at 7:00 p.m. The Eagles then open GSAC play at The Master's College on Saturday (Sept. 22) with a 2:00 p.m. match against the Mustangs.

The Eagles came from behind last week to defeat Trinity International University 2-1 on Friday. It was just the second match in 13 days for Biola, but proved to be an outstanding match as the Eagles improved to 2-2-0 on the season and 2-0-0 against NAIA opponents.

Men's Soccer Opens Conference Play at The Master's

The Eagles went 1-1 in the Classic, defeating Trinity International University 2-1 in overtime, but falling to Simon Fraser University 1-0 in the championship match. Biola is now 4-4-0 on the season.

The inaugural Biola Men's Golf team opens play on Tuesday (Sept. 18) at The Master's College Invitational in Sunland.

The tournament features a number of NAIA Region II teams and should be a good way to indoctrinate the new team to Collegiate Golf. This tournament will be a one-day event with the teams playing 36 holes.

Head Coach John Lane is excited about leading the new squad and says that while the first year is always tough, he still hopes the teams work hard and improve quickly.

Cross Country Takes a Bit of a Break After Great Showing at Westmont

Biola's women's Cross Country team, ranked #8 in the latest NAIA poll, won the Westmont Invitational on Saturday with Kristin Schmidt taking top honors overall. On the men's side, the Eagles were third with Brian Ball winning the individual title. Biola takes two weeks off before returning to the course on Saturday (Oct. 6) for the Vanguard University Invitational in Costa Mesa.

BIOLA VOLLEYBALL

One Down, Five to Go in Tough Stretch for #5 Biola

The Biola Volleyball team, ranked #5 in the latest NAIA National Poll, picked up a big win on Saturday, defeating #7 Point Loma Nazarene in three games at Chase Gymnasium.

That match was the first of a grueling eight-match stretch featuring contests against six teams ranked in the Top-10 including all four teams currently ranked above the Eagles.

Biola will take on a much-improved Hope International team on Tuesday (Sept. 18) before returning home to play #2 Concordia University on Saturday (Sept. 22). The Eagles then face off against No. 1 Fresno Pacific (Sept. 25), #4 National American (Sept. 28), The Master's College (Sept. 29), #10 Azusa Pacific (Oct. 2) and #3 California Baptist (Oct. 6).

Here's a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

HOPE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY (3-4 overall, 1-3 GSAC):

The Royals are off to a pretty good start to the 2007 season with a pair of wins against Dominican and a GSAC victory over San Diego Christian College in four games last week. Even in defeat Hope has turned a few heads including taking a game from No. 3 Cal Baptist in Riverside on Saturday.

Leading the way for the Royals is sophomore outside hitter Jillian Lane, who had 85 kills (4.47/game) through the first five matches of the season.

Biola is 20-1 all-time against the Royals with the lone defeat coming in Fullerton on October 23, 2003.

#2 CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY (11-1 Overall, 3-1 GSAC):

The Eagles, one of the GSAC's top teams over the last three seasons, is off to another strong start in 2007. Concordia has lost just once this season, falling in four games to #3 Cal Baptist at home last week. That loss aside, the Eagles have been tough to beat.

Leading the way has been the one-two punch of juniors Tracy Weamer and Stephanie Scheele. Weamer, a transfer from NCAA Division II power Cal State San Bernardino, has 112 kills (3.61/game) and 104 digs (3.35/game) on the season. Scheele is not too far behind with 100 kills (3.12/game).



Biola holds a 32-7 lead in the all-time series, but Concordia has won five of the last six meetings, including both matches last season.

JUST WINGIN' IT: Senior opposite hitter Brittany Wing had a great week last week, recording 28 kills in two matches. At San Diego Christian, she had a team-high 12 kills, the bested that with a 16 kill performance against Point Loma Nazarene. For the season, Wing has 94 kills (2.85/game) and also has 26 blocks (0.79/game).

PERFECTO!: Junior outside hitter Kelsey Mitchell recorded an impressive 14 kills without an error as Biola defeated Point Loma on Saturday. On the evening, she posted a .519 hitting percentage, the second-best overall percentage on the season.

BIOLA MEN'S SOCCER

Eagles Open GSAC Play at The Master's College

After eight matches and a very long road trip, the Biola men's soccer team is finally ready to start the 2007 GSAC portion of the schedule, traveling up to Santa Clarita to square off against the Master's College on Saturday (Sept. 22).

It's hard to believe that Biola has already played nearly half of its schedule already, but the first eight were just warm-ups for the real test: the GSAC.

Conference teams had an impressive pre-conference record of 54-9-4. While Biola's 4-4-0 record so far looks respectable, the Eagles enter GSAC play in last place. The conference also boasts five teams in the NAIAs Top 20, including three in the top seven. All that to say it looks like another strong year for the GSAC.

Here is a closer look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

THE MASTER'S COLLEGE (4-0-2 Overall, 0-0-0 GSAC): The Mustangs are undefeated so far this season and are 2-0-0 at home. Offense does not seem to be an issue for The Master's as the team has already scored 27 goals in just six games this season. That

includes an 11-0 thrashing of La Sierra and an 8-1 win over William Jessup.

Five players have scored three or more goals for the Mustangs, led by senior defender Syian Wignal, who has six goals and one assist.

Freshman midfielder Doug Harrell and senior midfielder Justin Mohrig each have 11 points with Harrell scoring four goals and adding three assists and Mohrig tallying a team-best five assists.

The only knock against the Mustangs up to this point may be with their schedule. While they have had little trouble scoring goals against weaker opponents, they have been harder to come by against the good teams. The Master's did defeat Westminster (Utah) 1-0, but played to 1-1 ties with Mesa State College (an NCAA Division II School) and Holy Names University.

LAST WEEK: Biola went 1-1 during the Biola Classic last week, defeating Trinity International University 2-1 in overtime before falling 1-0 to Simon Fraser University in the championship match.

The Eagles received a pair of goals from senior forward Ryan Parker on Friday against Trinity, including a brilliant shot for the match-winner just 38 seconds into overtime.

On Saturday, the Eagles and the Clan were scoreless through most of the match despite both teams having a number of quality chances. However, Simon Fraser was able to break through late in the game and hold off Biola's upset attempt, claiming the Classic Title.

JUST A WALK IN THE PARK(ER): Biola's Ryan Parker has already scored five goals this year, almost half of the offensive output for the Eagles. Parker, who had just three goals in limited action in 2006, has scored three game-winning goals. He has also added an assist and leads Biola with 11 total points.

Biola Hosts Cal State San Marcos, Travels to The Master's on Saturday

After playing just twice in the last two weeks, the Biola women's soccer team plays two games in three days this week. The Eagles wrap up their pre-conference schedule with a home match against NAIA Region II for Cal State San Marcos on Thursday (Sept. 20) before heading up to The Master's College to open GSAC play on Saturday (Sept. 22).

Here is a closer look at this week's opponent:

CAL STATE SAN MARCOS (3-4-1 Overall): The Cougars snapped a four-game losing-streak last week, recording wins over Cal Baptist and The Master's. Cal State San Marcos, an independent member of NAIA Region II, is 3-2-0 so far against GSAC schools with a match against Point Loma Nazarene scheduled for Tuesday.



Sophomore forward Clarissa Hidalgo leads the Cougars with three goals while Randi Leyva and Taylor Ziencina have each added two.

While the Cougars are 2-0-0 at home this year, they have been able to win just once in four road games. The one victory was Saturday's 4-1 win over The Master's College in Santa Clarita.

Biola escaped San Marcos with an overtime victory in 2006 as Natalie Thornton scored midway through the second overtime period to give the Eagles a 1-0 win.

THE MASTER'S COLLEGE (1-3-1 Overall): Much like the Eagles, the Mustangs have a very young team with 14 new



players under the direction of first-year head coach Curtis Lewis. Unlike Biola, the Master's have struggled on defense, allowing 17 goals through the first five matches and winning just one match. The Mustangs' victory was

a 3-0 win at Corban College, but was book-ended by a 7-0 loss to Concordia (Ore.) and a 2-1 overtime loss to George Fox.

The Master's has only been shutout once this year and has received three goals and an assist from freshman midfielder Sarah Goff.

LAST WEEK: Biola pulled out a come-from-behind 2-1 victory over Trinity International University on Friday as senior Bryna Neill scored the eventual match-winner in the 61st minute. The Eagles allowed the Trojans to score in the third minute, but heavy pressure led to an own goal to tie the match. Biola's defense held TIU to just six shots after surrendering the initial goal.

BRYNA'S BRILLIANCE: Senior forward Bryna Neill leads the Eagles with two goals this year after netting just one in 14 games during the 2007 season.

Biola Women Place First, Men Third at Westmont Invitational

The Biola cross country teams are scheduled to take a bit of a break after a stellar start to the 2007 season. The teams return to action on Saturday (Oct. 6) for the Vanguard Invitational at Fairview Park in Costa Mesa.

The meet will serve as a good preview for the Eagles squad as Fairview is also where the GSAC Championships will be held on Saturday (Oct. 20).

LAST WEEK: The women's team took top honors and the men finished third while sophomore Kristin Schmidt and senior Brian Ball each won their respective races at the Westmont Invitational on Saturday (Sept. 15).

The Eagle women, who are ranked No. 8 in the latest NAIA National Poll, placed all 10 of their runners in the top 26 out of 79 runners in the field.

The Biola men's golf team will hit the links for the first time as the Eagles begin their inaugural season this week.

First up: The Master's College Fall Invitational on Tuesday (Sept. 18). The Eagles will open up with a busy day of 36 holes at the Angeles National Golf Club in Sunland, CA. The course, designed by legendary golfer Jack Nicklaus, was ranked one of the Top 30 courses in the world recently by *Leisure Golf Magazine* and should provide a tough challenge for the participants.

For Biola's first two rounds of collegiate golf, Head Coach John Lane is just looking to see how his players respond to and what type of team he has. The team, which consists of five golfers at this point, has played numerous practice rounds and buckets off range balls, but has yet to face off against another team.

The NAIA Region II boasts a number

of tough teams including Point Loma Nazarene, Cal Baptist, Concordia University and Cal State San Marcos. All four teams were ranked in the NAIA Preseason Poll released by Golf World at the end of August.

Leading the way for the Eagle men will be a pair of seniors, Neal Kapur and Rob Johnson. Joining them are junior C.J. Clark II and a pair of freshman in Greg Bodine and Tim Goodfriend.

College golf is a bit different from PGA golf in that the tournament are typically over two days, with golfers playing 36 holes on the first day and 18 on the second.

Teams are made up of five individual players. Each round, the four lowest scores are added together to determine the team score. The team with the lowest total at the end of the tournament is the winner. Each tournament will also have an individual winner determined by the lowest overall score.
