Soccer Teams Host Vanguard, Travel to Point Loma Nazarene

The Biola University men's and women's soccer teams continue with GSAC play this week, hosting Vanguard before traveling to San Diego to face off against Point Loma Nazarene this weekend.

Both teams are coming off disappointing one-goal losses, but hope to rebound at home against a tough Vanguard squad. The Eagle men take on the Lions on Tuesday (Sept. 25) while the women play host on Wednesday (Sept. 26). Both matches are scheduled to kick off at 7:00 p.m. at Al Barbour Field.

On Saturday (Sept. 29), the teams travel to San Diego where they square off against another GSAC power in Point Loma Nazarene. The men get things started at 1:00 p.m. with the women scheduled to kick off at 3:30 p.m.

#5 Eagles Face pair of Top-Five Teams, Host The Master's on Saturday

The Biola Volleyball team, ranked #5 in the latest NAIA National Poll, suffered its first loss of the season last week, but has little time to recover thanks to three matches in five days this week.

The week begins with the always-exciting trip to the Central Valley as the Eagles face #1 Fresno Pacific on Tuesday (Sept. 25) at 7:00 p.m.

Friday (Sept. 28), Biola takes on #4 National American University—the defending NAIA National Champions—at Concordia University in Irvine. The match is scheduled for an 11:00 a.m. tip.

The week wraps up on Saturday as Biola hosts The Master's College in a GSAC match at 1:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

#1 FRESNO PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (14-0 overall, 6-0 GSAC): The Sunbirds are off to another strong start, as has been



their custom for the last 10 or so years. Fresno has not been as dominating as in the past, dropping a number of games this season but ultimately posting a perfect record to start the year nonetheless.

The Sunbirds have a talented squad with four players having 100 or more kills so far. Leading the way is Marin Canaday, who has 172 kills (3.51/game) and also has 36 blocks.

It has been nearly 10 years since Biola last beat the Sunbirds, who lead the all-time series 36-22.

#4 NATIONAL AMERICAN UNIVERSITY (13-2 Overall): The Mavericks had little trouble winning the 2006 NAIA National Championship, going



a perfect 41-0 and losing just a handful of games. However, things have been a bit more rocky in 2007 as NAU has already dropped two matches and have been taken to four or five games on a num-

ber of occasions.

Junior outside hitter Daniela Oliveira leads the Mavericks with 209 kills (5.5/game) and is one of seven players from Brazil on the roster.

This will be the first-ever meeting between the two schools.

THE MASTER'S COLLEGE (8-7 Overall, 2-4 GSAC): The Mustangs are playing



well so far this season despite a 2-4 conference record. The Master's recently took #9 Azusa Pacific to four games and has played tough in defeats to the top teams in the GSAC.

Leading the way is senior outside hitter Amanda Roleder, who has an impressive 214 kills (3.94/game) on the season, the fourth highest total in the conference.

The Eagles hold a 35-1 all-time mark against The Master's and have won 32 straight matches in the series.

LAST WEEK: Biola opened the week with a sweep over Hope International on Tuesday, but struggled in a three-game loss to #3 Concordia on Saturday. The Eagles did not play well against CUI which played one of its best matches of the season.

BIOLA MEN'S SOCCER

Biola hosts Vanguard on Tuesday, Travels to Point Loma Nazarene

The Biola men's soccer team hit the halfway point in the schedule last week and look to improve on its 4-5-0 record through the first nine games.

The Eagles lost 2-1 in a frustrating match up at The Master's College on Saturday, allowing two goals in the final 15 minutes. It was another one-goal loss for Biola which has lost by a single goal in four of their five losses this year.

However, they have a chance to recover this week as they play a pair of matches against two tough teams. The week begins with a home match against #20 Vanguard University on Tuesday (Sept. 25) on Al Barbour Field at 7:00 p.m.

Biola closes out the week on Saturday (Sept. 29) at Point Loma Nazarene at 1:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

#20 VANGUARD UNIVERSITY (5-2-0 Overall, 0-1-0 GSAC): The Lions opened up the year with a perfect 4-0-0 record, but have since lost two of their last three games.

On Saturday, the Lions were beat 2-1 at home by #16 Westmont in their GSAC opener. Vanguard was one of the four teams to play in the Biola Classic, defeating Trinity International but falling to #12 Simon Fraser.

The Lions have not struggled on offense, scoring 17 goals including at least one in each of their seven matches. Three players have three goals each with sophomore forward Christopher Leiva scoring three goals and adding five assists.

Biola holds a 21-13-3 edge in the all-time series and has won 13 of 19 matches at home. Last year, the Lions won 2-1 in overtime in Costa Mesa.

POINT LOMA NAZARENE UNIVERSITY (6-0-0 Overall, 1-0-0 GSAC): Despite winning all six matches to open the 2007 campaign, the Sea Lions did not even receive a vote in last week's NAIA National

Poll. They exacted a bit of revenge by defeating #6 Fresno Pacific 3-1 in San Diego on Saturday in the GSAC opener for both teams, proving they were indeed a team to be reckoned



with in the conference this year.

PLNU has been an offensive force, scoring 27 goals in six matches and allowing just four against. Senior forward Brian Thames has five goals and three assists this year and is the Sea Lions' all-time leading scorer with 40 goals and 23 assists in his career at Point Loma.

Biola and PLNU battled to a scoreless draw at Biola in 2006 and the Eagles lead the all-time series 22-8-2 and are 12-5-1 in San Diego.

LAST WEEK: Biola dropped its GSAC opener to The Master's College, falling 2-1. The Eagles got on the board first thanks to a goal by Derek Friehe in the 36th minute. However, the Mustangs scored a pair of goals in the final 15 minutes to pull out the victory.

Eagles Face Pair of Tough Opponents in Vanguard and Point Loma Nazarene

The Biola women's soccer players are ready to put last week behind them after dropping a pair of games they felt like they should have won. However, things do not get any easier as the Eagles face a pair of nationally-ranked teams this week.

Biola hosts #16 Vanguard University on Wednesday (Sept. 26) at 7:00 p.m. on Al Barbour Field.

The Eagles then travel to San Diego where they take on #4 Point Loma Nazarene at 3:30 p.m.

Here is a closer look at this week's opponent:

VANGUARD UNIVERSITY (6-1-1 Overall, 1-0-0 GSAC): The Lions picked up a 1-0 overtime victory over Westmont

College in their GSAC opener and are undefeated in their seven matches after suffering a season-opening 2-1 loss to Dominican University. The win over the Warriors was their third overtime match already this season.

Vanguard has received strong contributions from a pair of underclassmen: freshman forward Danielle Dintino and sophomore goalkeeper Jillian Foss.

Dintino already has seven goals on the season including a hat trick in a 3-0 win over Trinity International. Foss has a tiny 0.63 goals against average, allowing just six goals this season and making 34 saves.

Vanguard holds an 15-8-1 record in the head-to-head series, though Biola has won the last three games including a 2-1 overtime win in Costa Mesa last year. Four of the last five meetings have gone into overtime including the last three games.

#4 POINT LOMA NAZARENE UNIVERSITY (5-1-1 Overall, 0-0-1 GSAC):

The Sea Lions are undefeated in their last four games (3-0-1) after a stunning 1-0 overtime loss to Cal Poly Pomona at the end

of August. Point Loma Nazarene played to a 1-1 tie with Fresno Pacific on Saturday in the GSAC opener for both teams.

The Sea Lions have one of the best team defenses in the GSAC and have allowed just two goals this season in seven matches. Goalkeepers Grace Lee and Cissy Butler have been solid in net. Offensively, senior forward Becky Torres has six goals and two assists to lead PLNU.

Biola defeated Point Loma 1-0 last year in a huge upset as the Sea Lions entered ranked No. 7 in the NAIA. The Eagles led the all-time series 5-2-3 with five of the 10 games going into overtime.

LAST WEEK: Biola suffered a pair of disappointing losses, falling 4-0 to Cal State San Marcos and losing 3-2 in its GSAC opener against The Master's College.

Biola Women Place First, Men Third at Westmont Invitational

The Biola cross country teams are scheduled to take a bit of a break after a stellar start to the 2007 season. The teams return to action on Saturday (Oct. 6) for the Vanguard Invitational at Fairview Park in Costa Mesa.

The meet will serve as a good preview for the Eagles squad as Fairview is also where the GSAC Championships will be held on Saturday (Oct. 20).

LAST WEEK: The women's team took top honors and the men finished third while sophomore Kristin Schmidt and senior Brian Ball each won their respective races at the Westmont Invitational on Saturday (Sept. 15).

The Eagle women, who are ranked No. 8 in the latest NAIA National Poll, placed all 10 of their runners in the top 26 out of 79 runners in the field.

Sophomore transfer Ryan Richert placed eighth and finished with a time of 27:25 and was followed by freshman David Kostelyk who was 13th in 28:08.

Biola's Women's Golfers head to Phoenix for First-Ever Collegiate Competition

The Biola women's golf team heads to Phoenix to play in its first-ever golf tournament this week.

The Eagles are set to participate in the 2007 Grand Canyon University Fall Classic on Monday and Tuesday (Sept. 24-25). The tournament will be 18 holes each day and is set to be played at the Coldwater Golf Club in Avondale, Arizona.

Biola will be represented by its two women's golfers who will both be playing as individuals.

Senior Jennifer Yoo may turn some heads early on as she is likely to be one of the best golfers in the field. Yoo is a transfer from NCAA Division I Cal State Northridge where she was among the top golfers in the Big West Conference. Head Coach John Lane thinks Yoo could challenge for a place in the NAIA Championships during the season.

Joining her is another senior Stefani Washburn who is returning to her home state of Arizona for her first collegiate golf match.

Biola was led by freshman Greg Bodine, who shot a 21-over 165 on the day, carding a low round of 77 in the morning session. Freshman Tim Goodfriend fired a 28-over 172 followed by C.J. Clark II, who had a 29-over 173. Rounding out the group were seniors Neal Kapur at 178 and Rob Johnson at 202.

"Today was a great opportunity to learn and see what we need to work on," said Head Coach John Lane. "It was a long day lasting nearly 11 hours and was something these guys just weren't used to yet. But I thought the guys conducted themselves well today."

The Eagles return to action on Monday and Tuesday, Oct. 15-16, traveling to Long Beach for the Concordia University Invitational at Skylinks Golf Club.
