## Volleyball Begins GSAC Play With Home Match on Thursday

The Biola volleyball team turned a few heads around the NAIA volleyball world last weekend by winning four matches at the Concordia University Labor Day Festival including three against Top-25 teams.

Now, the Eagles take the momentum from those matches into play in the toughest volleyball conference in the NAIA: the Golden State Athletic Conference.

First up is Vanguard University. The Lions received votes in the NAIA pre-season poll and turned heads with great play of their own this weekend. Biola hosts Vanguard on Thursday night (Sept. 6) at 7:00 p.m. in Chase Gymnasium.

The Eagles wrap up the week with a trip to Santa Barbara on Saturday (Sept. 8) where they take on Westmont College. The Warriors also had a good weekend and always seem to pose a threat to the Eagles when the two meet up Murchison Gymnasium.

### Women's Soccer Faces Cal State Dominguez Hills

The Biola women's soccer team continues a brutal non-conference schedule this week, making a trip to Carson on Tuesday (Sept. 4) to face off against NCAA Division II Cal State Dominguez Hills.

The Toros are one of the top teams in the West Region and played to a 1-1 tie with Azusa Pacific just over a week ago.

The match, which begins at 7:00 p.m., is the second of four matches against NCAA schools this season. After the match, the Eagles start a long layoff playing just twice in the next 19 days.

### Men's Soccer Continues Road Stretch with Trip to Bay Area

The men's soccer squad had a rough start to its current five-game road trip, losing the first three games last week in Utah. The Eagles will look to get back on the winning track in the final two games of that trip this week.

Biola travels to face Dominican University on Friday (Sept. 7) and heads to Menlo College on Saturday (Sept. 8).

### Cross Country Competes in UC Irvine Invitational

While it may not have been that big of a surprise to Biola Cross Country fans, the Eagles strong performances at the Cal State Fullerton Invite last week may have surprised some in the XC community.

The Eagles have not had much success in cross country recently, but this year things have changed. Head Coach Jonathan Zimmerman has the Eagle women ranked No. 13 in the NAIA while the men are just out of the Top-25 and may sneak in after a strong showing last week.

Biola looks to continue its success this week at the UC Irvine Invitational on Saturday (Sept. 8) at Central Park West in Huntington Beach.

# BIOLA VOLLEYBALL

## #11 Eagles Open GSAC Play Against Vanguard, At Westmont

The Biola volleyball team made quite an impression on the other schools at the Concordia Labor Day Festival last week, knocking off three NAIA Top-25 teams including a pair of dominating sweeps over red-hot teams on Saturday.

Thanks to the strong showing, the Eagles will likely crack the Top-10 when the first rating is released Wednesday.

Early indications are that the Golden State Athletic Conference—already known as the best volleyball conference in the NAIA—could be especially tough in 2007.

For example, three other GSAC teams (Fresno Pacific, Cal Baptist and Concordia) are expected to join the Eagles in the Top-10 on Wednesday. In addition, Azusa Pacific, Point Loma Nazarene and Vanguard should be in the Top-25 with Westmont receiving votes as well. That means eight of the 11 GSAC schools could be rated among the best 30 in the country, more than double the amount of any other conference.

Biola opens GSAC play this week, hosting Vanguard University on Thursday (Sept. 6) at 7:00 p.m. The Eagles then travel to Westmont College on Saturday (Sept. 8) for a 5:00 p.m. match.

Here's a closer look at the teams Biola will be facing this week:

**WESTMONT COLLEGE (6-2 Overall, 0-0 GSAC):** The Warriors are off to an impressive 6-2 start to 2007. They opened



the year going 4-0 and winning the Roberts Wesleyan Volleyball Tournament in Rochester, New York. Last week they went 2-2, losing twice on Saturday in five-game marathons at the Concordia Labor Day Festival.

Sophomore middle blocker Katelyn Lowry leads the team with 96 kills (3.20/game) and also has 39 blocks (1.30/game) including 12 solo.

Biola holds a 40-18 all-time edge in the series between the two schools, but is just 17-10 against the Warriors at Murchison Gymnasium in Santa Barbara.

**WARKENTIN NAMED GSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Junior outside hitter

Meghan Warkentin (Scheenstra) was named the GSAC Player of the Week. She recorded 79 kills (5.64/game) with a .392 hitting percentage to lead No. 11 Biola to four wins in as many matches at the Concordia Labor Day Festival last week. She also had 40 digs (2.86/game), six aces, four blocks and three assists.

**VANGUARD UNIVERSITY (2-2 overall, 0-0 GSAC):** The Lions opened the season with a strong showing of their own last



week, falling in five games to a pair of Top-25 teams, then rebounding with a two sweeps on Saturday. Even in Friday's losses, Vanguard proved that it will be a formidable opponent in the GSAC this season.

Senior outside hitter Kim Wynn has led the Lions through their first four matches with 3.76 kills and 3.71 digs per game. Sophomore outside hitter Kelsey Wirt, a 2006 All-GSAC selection, is contributing 3.59 kills and 3.76 digs per game.

Biola is 39-7 all-time against Vanguard, but just 3-2 in the last five matches.

# BIOLA MEN'S SOCCER

## Biola Looks to Rebound During Trip to the Bay Area

After opening the season with a strong showing against Saint Martin's University, the Biola men's soccer team has struggled recently, dropping three matches at the Westminster College Tournament in Utah.

The Eagles will look to rebound this week, though, as they travel to the Bay area for a pair of games. Biola faces Dominican University on Friday (Sept. 7) before traveling to Menlo College on Saturday (Sept. 8). Both matches are non-conference and are set to kick off at 4:00 p.m.

Here is a closer look at the upcoming opponents for Biola:

### DOMINICAN UNIVERSITY CA (0-3-0 Overall):

The Penguins are winless in their first three matches of the year, but—in their defense—they have played three tough opponents. Dominican is coming off a pair of losses at the hands of Westmont and Azusa Pacific last week at the Westmont Classic and opened the year with a 1-0 loss to NCAA Division II San Francisco State.

The Penguins—like the Eagles—have not scored a goal in their last three matches. That could mean either a 0-0 draw or a chance for both teams to get on the scoreboard for the first time in a while.

Dominican won the only meeting between the two schools so far, a 2-1 victory back in the day. Last season, a match at Biola between the two was cancelled after no game officials showed up for the contest.

### MENLO COLLEGE CA (1-1-0 Overall):

The Oaks, an NCAA Division III school in the California-Pacific Conference, split their first two matches of the 2007 season. Menlo beat Cascade College (Ore.) 3-0, but lost to Northwest University (Wash.) 2-1. The Oaks have a home match against George Fox University (Ore.) on Friday afternoon.

In their win over Cascade, the Oaks received goals from Kristian Hagen, Mar-

tin Saravia and Roberto Parada. They also received strong play in goal by Brandon Evangelista, who made 11 saves to earn the shutout and the win.

Biola and Menlo have played twice before with the Eagles coming out on top both times.

**LAST WEEK:** Despite outshooting the opposition in all three matches last week, the Eagles went 0-3 in their trip to Utah.

Biola opened with a disappointing showing against Albertson College, losing 4-0 despite allowing just eight shots. Against Westminster, the Eagles had numerous chances including hitting the post three different times, but failed to score in a 1-0 loss.

The trip ended with another 1-0 loss, this time at the hands of Olivet Nazarene. Again, the shots were there for the Eagles, but they were unable to convert.

The Eagles have now gone over 332 minutes since scoring their last goal, the longest stretch since the 2001 season. That year, Biola won just two matches.

## Biola to Face Cal State Dominguez Hills Before Nine-Day Layoff

After playing five matches (including three scrimmages) over the last two weeks, the Eagles have just two matches in the next 19 days. The first of those matches will come on Tuesday (Sept. 4) against NCAA Division II Cal State Dominguez Hills.

The Eagles have looked very impressive on defense so far this year and their offense is coming around as they get more games under their belts.

Tuesday's match will be the second against an NCAA school with two more matches coming up later in the season. Biola also took on three NCAA schools in scrimmages including Division I Cal State Fullerton on Aug. 25.

Here is a closer look at this week's opponent:

**CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS (2-0-1 Overall):** The Toros are traditionally one of the best teams in the NCAA Division II Far West Region. Despite missing out on the playoffs last season, they have nine seniors and look ready to make another run in 2007.

Already they are off to a strong start, going undefeated in their first three matches against some stiff competition.

Cal State Dominguez Hills opened the season with a 2-1 win over Nebraska-Omaha, ranked No. 6 in the NCAA Division II poll. The Toros followed that up with a 1-1 draw against Azusa Pacific, ranked No. 2 in the NAIA, and downed Grand Canyon University 4-0 in Phoenix.

Senior forward Corrie Hirokawa has tallied three goals already this season with junior forward Kelly Matosian adding two goals and an assist.

In goal, the Toros are young, but talented. Freshman netminder Alyssa Congdon is 2-0-0 on the season, allowing just one goal in 180 minutes so far. Sophomore Rachel Rood and freshman Alison Bosler split time in the tie with APU with Bosler surrendering the late goal to send the match to overtime.

The last time these teams met in a regular season match came in 2002 when the teams played to a 0-0 draw.

**LAST WEEK:** The Eagles opened the home portion of their schedule with a non-conference match against Oregon Tech on Saturday (Sept. 1). Biola forward **Bryna Neill** tapped home a rebound in the 33rd minute to give the Eagles a 1-0 win.

While the goal came early, it proved to be the match-winner as the Biola defense shut down the Owl attack, limiting them to just four shots in the second half.

**GREGSTON EARNS GSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS:** Freshman netminder **Lauren Gregston** was named the GSAC Women's Soccer Defensive Player of the Week last week after making four saves and earning her first collegiate shutout and win in the Eagles' 1-0 victory over Oregon Tech on Saturday.

## Off to Strong Start, Eagle Cross Country Travels to UC Irvine Invitational

The Biola University Men's and Women's Cross Country teams are coming off a very impressive showing last week in the year's first competition.

This week, the teams look to continue their early success while running at the UC Irvine/Asics Invitational on Saturday (Sept. 8) at Central Park West in Huntington Beach.

The race is usually stacked with quality teams and provides a chance for the Eagles to see where they stand at this point in the season compared to the top teams in the region.

As mentioned before, the key to being ranked high in the NAIA is the "team time." This is the total time of the five runners which score points at each event.
