Holmquist to Coach 1,000th Game as Men's Basketball Heads to Westmont

Travel back with me, if you will, to the year 1975. It was the first year for a new TV game show called Wheel of Fortune, Jaws is a hit on the big screen and some where in the Central Valley a 24-year-old Dave Holmquist is preparing to coach his first collegiate game.

Thirty-two years and 999 games later, Coach Holmquist is ready to add another feather to his hat as he prepares to coach his 1,000th career game. The historic milestone will come on Tuesday (Jan. 15) as the Eagles travel to face Westmont in a GSAC game.

While it will surely be a memorable day for Coach Holmquist, he will surely be the first to tell you that he would rather have a victory than anything else.

Saturday (Jan. 19), the Eagles return to the friendly confines of Chase Gymnasium for a GSAC game against No. 3 Concordia University at 7:30 p.m.

Biola split a pair of games last week, beating The Master's College 77-65 at home, but losing 68-61 on the road to No. 15 California Baptist. The Eagles currently are 10-5 on the season and 2-3 in GSAC play.

Women's Basketball Heads to Westmont; Hosts Concordia

The Biola women's basketball team closes out its two-game road trip this week, heading west to Santa Barbara for a GSAC game against Westmont College on Tuesday (Jan. 15). The Eagles are currently just one game back of the Warriors for sixth in the conference standings.

On Saturday (Jan. 19), Biola hosts the first of two GSAC games, facing Concordia University at 5:30 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium. Concordia also has just a pair of conference wins and is tied with Westmont for sixth place. However, the crosstown Eagles are just 1-2 in conference road games so far this season.

Last week, Biola had a tough time against

two nationally-ranked teams. The Eagles hung tough with No. 6-ranked The Master's on Tuesday, but ultimately lost 77-63 in a game that was much closer than the final score indicated. On Saturday, Biola got off to a slow start and was never able to recover in an 88-68 loss at Cal Baptist. The Eagles are currently 4-10 and 1-4 in the conference

Swimmers Head North To Fresno for Duals against Two New Swim Teams

The Biola swim team is in the midst of its busiest month of the season, taking part in five meets in 21 days. This week, the Eagles travel up to Fresno Pacific for a pair of dual meets against two of the NAIAs newest swim programs: Fresno Pacific University and Concordia University (Calif.).

The two schools are in their first seasons as varsity programs but are already off to strong starts. The Eagles faced Concordia at an invitational meet at La Verne earlier this season, though both teams were without key people.

This will be the first time Biola swims against Fresno Pacific. The Sunbirds have been able to put together a surprisingly strong team already, anchored around a talented set of transfers.

The Eagles round out the dual meet schedule next weekend as they host Chapman in a home dual on Saturday, Jan. 26 at 10:00 a.m. in La Mirada.

Spring Sports Begin Practice for Upcoming Seasons

The 2008 spring sports seasons are right around the corner with nearly all of the teams already practicing. Baseball began practicing last week while softball and track and field opened this week. Tennis and Golf are scheduled to begin practicing next week with the spring semester beginning on Jan. 28.

Biola Travels to Westmont for Holmquist's 1,000th Game

Biola saw its four-game winning-streak snapped last week at the hands of No. 15 California Baptist, but looks to rebound from that with a pair of wins this week.

Tuesday (Jan. 15), the Eagles head to Santa Barbara for a GSAC game against Westmont College. The Warriors are struggling this season and Biola will have extra motivation to win as it will be the 1,000th game coached by Head Coach Dave Holmquist.

On Saturday (Jan. 19), the Eagles will have their hands full as they welcome No. 3-ranked Concordia University (Calif.) into Chase Gymnasium for a 7:30 p.m. showdown.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

WESTMONT COLLEGE (7-6 Overall, 1-4 GSAC):

It has been a bit of a rebuilding year this season for the Warriors, who are having to replace five seniors lost from last year's squad. The area hardest hit has been inside where the Warriors lost All-American forward Santiago Aguirre.

The rebuilding process has been hard as the Warriors have started GSAC play with just one win in their first five games.

Last week, Westmont dropped a pair of conference games including a two-point loss at Fresno Pacific after leading throughout much of the game. Those losses snapped a four-game winning streak the Warriors had managed to put together, though just one of those victories came against a team with a .500 record or better.

Freshman forward Dan Rasp has been a key factor for the Warriors thus far, leading the team with 15.6 ppg and adding 4.9 rpg.

Junior guard Tyler Dutton has scored 11.7 ppg, which is right around his career average of 11.1.

Westmont leads the all-time series between the two schools 47-43 and has won four of the last five games in the series. Biola's last win at Westmont came during the 2003-04 season when the Eagles downed the Warriors 76-64 in front of a standing-room only crowd of nearly 2,000 fans at Murchison Gymnasium.

#3 CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY CA (13-1 Overall, 4-1 GSAC): The Eagles continue to be one of the top teams not only in the GSAC, but in the NAIA as well, posting an incredible 156-40 record (.796 winning percentage) dating back to the 2002-03 season. This year,

Concordia is off to another great start, winning 13 of its first 14 games. The one blemish came at The Master's where the Mustangs opened the GSAC season with a shocking 80-72 win.



Just last season, the Eagles reached the NAIA Championship game and returned four of five starters from that squad. However, that talented group now consists mostly of seniors, which is accounting for just over 60 percent of the team's scoring this season.

Leading the pack is senior Ryan Reed, a transfer from The Master's, who is averaging 16.4 points per game. Fellow senior Rafael De Silva is contributing 14.4 points.

Biola leads the all-time series 22-10, but dropped both contests to Concordia last season. Biola is 4-2 in home games dating back to the 2001-02 season and has won two of the last three such games.

HOLMQUIST NEARING TWO MORE MILESTONES: Biola Head Coach Dave Holmquist is nearing two more coaching milestones. The first one will happen Tuesday (Jan. 15) when he will coach his 1,000th game. He will be just the 40th collegiate coach and the seventh NAIA Coach to coach 1,000 games.

Coach Holmquist is also nearing his 700th win at Biola, needing just six victories to achieve that mark. In his 31 seasons of coaching, Holmquist is 730-269 overall (.731 winning percentage) and is 694-226 (.754 winning percentage) in 27 seasons at Biola.

BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Looks To Move Up in GSAC With Pair of Games This Week

The Biola women's basketball team is seeking to get back in the win column this week, looking for a "W" against a pair of GSAC foes.

First up is a trip out to Santa Barbara to face Westmont College in a conference contest on Tuesday (Jan. 15) at 5:30 p.m. in Murchison Gymnasium.

The Eagles then return home to Chase Gymnasium to take on Concordia University on Saturday (Jan. 19) at 5:30 p.m.

Last week, Biola played well against a pair of ranked opponents but were unable to walk away with victories.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

WESTMONT COLLEGE (10-3 Overall, 2-3 GSAC):

The Warriors have had quite the Jekyll and Hyde season thus far, posting a perfect 8-0 non-conference record, but winning just two of five GSAC games this season. The Warriors split a pair of conference games last week, defeating Fresno Pacific on the road, but falling to Vanguard and seeing its eight-game winning streak come to an end.

Westmont's non-conference success may be owed in part to playing weaker opponents as just three of their eight games came against teams above .500. Most GSAC fans will tell you that this conference is the great equalizer, though.

The Warriors welcomed back forward Ali Mooty in December after the All-American missed nearly nine months due to a broken foot. Mooty, who averaged 18 points and nine rebounds a game last season, has played an average of 14 minutes over the last six games and has scored 7.2 ppg with 4.2 rpg.

Sophomore forward Alisha Heglund is leading the way for Westmont with 12.3 ppg, 5.9 rpg and adds 10 blocks.

Westmont holds a 12-7 edge in the all-time series since re-instating women's basketball as a varsity sport in 1998-99. The Eagles have had trouble winning at Westmont, winning just twice in 10 games there.

CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY CA (8-7 Overall, 2-3 GSAC):



The Eagles have dropped five of their last seven games after opening the season with a 6-2 record. Some of that can be chalked up to having such a young team. Of the 17 players on the Concordia roster, there is just one senior and three juniors.

The Eagles have struggled from the field this season and rank last in the GSAC with a .386 shooting percentage on the season. The do make up for it with three-pointers hitting just over 36 percent while holding teams to under 28 percent.

Leading the way for Concordia is sophomore guard Kayanna Nichols, who has tallied 12.8 points per game with 32 assists and 17 steals to go with. However, she is averaging just 9.2 points per game in the Eagles' five GSAC contests.

There are five other players averaging between six and eight points per contest led by sophomore forward Lauren Sahli with 8.3 ppg.

Concordia holds a 29-18 series edge and has won the last six games. Biola's last win against CUI was a 71-63 win in Irvine during the 2003-04 season. Biola is 10-12 all-time against Concordia in La Mirada.

Swimmers Continue Flurry of Activity with Trip to Fresno Pacific

The Biola University swimming and diving team continues its hectic month with a trip north to Fresno this week.

The Eagles, who are in the midst of a stretch of five meets in 21 days, take part in a dual-meet with NAIA newcomers Fresno Pacific University and Concordia University (Calif.) on Saturday (Jan. 19). The meet is scheduled to begin at Noon.

Both Fresno Pacific and Concordia are participating in their first seasons as varsity swim programs. Despite being in the GSAC in most other sports, the teams (along with Biola) are part of the Pacific Collegiate Swimming Conference as the GSAC does not have enough teams yet to support swimming.

Fresno Pacific has turned a number of heads already this season as they have brought in a number of talented transfers and freshman to make the team strong in its first year of competition. Concordia has also found a couple of strong swimmers, but is still a few years away from being a serious threat in the region.

This will be the furthest trip of the regular season for the Eagles, who are used to frequent day-trips to Riverside or other places in and around Los Angeles.

Biola had a busy week last week, hosting a dual meet against another new swim program in Grand Canyon University before traveling to Riverside for a four-way meet with Chapman, Grand Canyon and Cal Baptist.

The Eagles swept GCU in the home dual, winning 132-58 on the women's side and 87-48 on the men's.

At Cal Baptist, the women beat Grand Canyon and Chapman but lost to CBU while the men beat Grand Canyon but fell to Chapman and Cal Baptist.
