Home Against Fresno Pacific, Trip to Vanguard Up Next For Basketball Teams

Biola Men's Basketball team looks to snap a three-game losing streak this week with a pair of GSAC games.

First up for the Eagles is a home game against Fresno Pacific University on Tuesday (Jan. 22) at 7:30 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium.

Biola hits the road for its next contest, traveling to Costa Mesa to face Vanguard University on Saturday (Jan. 26) in the next-to-last game of the first half of the conference schedule.

Looming large is the big rivalry game on Tuesday, Jan. 29 at Azusa Pacific, which wraps up the first trip around the GSAC for both teams.

The Eagles have dropped their last three games—all GSAC games and have fallen to 2-5 in conference play. Oddly enough, the last time Biola lost three in a row came last year when the Eagles lost at CBU and Westmont and dropped a home contest to Concordia. Biola will be looking for history to repeat itself as a home win over Fresno Pacific snapped that losing-streak.

Women's Basketball Snaps Streak; Hosts Fresno Pacific

The Biola women's basketball team snapped its losing streak with a hard-fought, overtime win over Concordia on Saturday.

The Eagles return to the courts against Fresno Pacific on Tuesday (Jan. 22), hosting the Sunbirds at 5:30 p.m.

Saturday (Jan. 26), Biola heads south to face No. 3 Vanguard University at 5:30 p.m. in Costa Mesa.

The Eagles snapped their six-game slide with the impressive win over their namesakes from Irvine, overcoming a late deficit to force OT. In the extra frame, Biola again trailed with time running out before a final stand and free throws provided the winning margin.

Swimmers Host Final Dual Meet of 2008

The Biola swim team rounds out the dual meet portion of its schedule on Saturday (Jan. 26), hosting Chapman University in a home dual on at 10:00 a.m. in La Mirada.

The Eagles took their longest trip of the regular season last week, driving up to Fresno Pacific University for duals against the Sunbirds and Concordia University.

Paul Mendoza had a record-breaking day, besting the school's 400 IM mark by nearly four seconds to win the event.

Biola's next action comes at the Pacific Collegiate Swimming Conference meet, which runs Feb. 13-16 in Long Beach. After that, the NAA National Championships wrap up the season at the end of February.

Indoor Track Opens 2008 Campaign at Concordia

The Biola University track and field squads open the 2008 season at the Concordia Indoor Qualifier on Friday (Jan. 25) in Irvine. The Eagles, under the direction of second-year coach Jonathan Zimmerman, had a strong season last year culminating in three NAA All-Americans.

Baseball Hosts Annual Alumni Game

The Biola baseball team takes to the field for its annual alumni game on Saturday (Jan. 26) at Noon on the Biola Baseball Diamond.

The Eagles, who finished 30-24 in 2007 and reached the NAA District III semifinals, return 14 players including 11 starters from last year's squad.

Biola's first regular season games are just around the corner. The Eagles kick off the season by hosting NAA-foe Simpson University (Calif.) in a doubleheader on Tuesday, Jan. 29. First pitch is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on the Biola Baseball Diamond.

BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Hosts Fresno Pacific, Travels to Vanguard Looking to End Slide

After a season-high four-game winning streak, the Biola men's basketball team has dropped its last three games and fallen to 2-5 in GSAC play.

The Eagles will look to right the ship this week as they host Fresno Pacific University on Tuesday (Jan. 22) at 7:30 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium.

Biola then hits the road for the first of the two games to close out the first half of GSAC play. Saturday (Jan. 26), the Eagles head down to face Vanguard University at 7:30 p.m.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

FRESNO PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (13-5 Overall, 4-4 GSAC):

The Sunbirds returned the bulk of their scoring from last season, but have struggled to translate that into many wins in this season. Their pre-GSAC schedule was very easy and in turn they have posted a 9-1 non-conference mark this year. However, things have been a bit tougher in the GSAC as Fresno Pacific is 4-4 thus far.

After opening with a home win over Hope, the Sunbirds dropped four of their next five in conference. Fresno Pacific evened its record and earned back-to-back GSAC wins for the first time this season by beating Azusa Pacific at home and crushing San Diego Christian in El Cajon in its last two games.

Senior forward Adrian Sanchez is leading the team in scoring as he did throughout the 2006-07 season, with 13.4 points per game.

Sophomore forward Todd Brown adds 12.6 ppg and 5.6 rpg with senior forward Jordan Farley contributing 11.4 points and 6.9 rebounds per contest.

The Eagles have had great success against Fresno Pacific, holding a commanding 57-20 lead in the all-time series. Since 1996-97, Biola is 22-1 against the Sunbirds and a perfect 14-0 at home. The Eagles lone loss came in 2003 when Fresno beat Biola 58-56 in Fresno.

VANGUARD UNIVERSITY (11-4 Overall, 5-2 GSAC):

The Lions have won nine of their last 11 games after opening the season at 2-2 and are one of the hottest teams in the GSAC right now.

Their two losses over their last 11 games came at NCAA Division I Cal State Northridge and to No. 3 Concordia.

Vanguard is nearing the halfway point of the conference schedule with an impressive 5-2 record with a big game at Point Loma Nazarene looming on Tuesday.

Sophomore Guards Dennis Hennan and Greg Scott have provided the firepower for the Lions so far this season. Hennan leads the team with 11.5 ppg and adds 5.2 rebounds per contest. He is hitting over 48 percent (37-77) from the three-point line.

Scott is contributing 11.1 points per game and has 89 assists and 22 steals on the season.

Biola has had limited success against the Lions, holding a 49-31 lead in the series. The Eagles have won nine of the last 14 against Vanguard and split the series the last four years. Last season, both games were thrillers with the Lions winning 64-63 at La Mirada and Biola recording a 58-51 victory in overtime in Costa Mesa.

ONE DOWN, ONE TO GO: Biola head coach Dave Holmquist coached his 1,000th career game on Tuesday, Jan. 15 at Westmont. Unfortunately, it was a 73-69 loss to the Warriors. However, he is nearing another impressive milestone which should be reached by the end of this season.

Entering Tuesday's contest against Fresno Pacific, Coach Holmquist is 694-228 in his 27 seasons at Biola and needs just six wins to reach 700 with the Eagles.

BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Looks To Move Up in GSAC With Pair of Games This Week

Biola's women's basketball team will look to build on the momentum of its impressive overtime victory over Concordia on Saturday and try for back-to-back wins for the first time this season during a pair of conference games this week.

First up, the Eagles host GSAC foe Fresno Pacific University on Tuesday (Jan. 22) at 5:30 p.m. in Chase Gymnasium.

On Saturday (Jan. 26), Biola travels to Costa Mesa to face defending GSAC-champion and No. 3-ranked Vanguard University at The Pit.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

FRESNO PACIFIC UNIVERSITY (7-11 Overall, 0-8 GSAC):

The Sunbirds have really struggled this season and are still looking for their first GSAC win as the season nears its halfway point. Even a trip down to San Diego Christian failed to yield a victory last week as Fresno Pacific lost 63-57 in El Cajon.

The Sunbirds posted a 7-3 non-conference record, though five of those victories came against two of the weaker CalPac Schools, William Jessup and Bethany.

In their eight conference games, Fresno Pacific has been outscored 76-57 and has shot a conference-low 37 percent from the field.

Senior forward Keri Cox has carried the bulk of the load offensively, scoring 14.4 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. She also has 33 assists, 16 steals and 10 blocks in 18 games and is shooting over 50 percent from the field.

Sophomore guard Melissa Flores adds 9.4 points and 3.9 rebounds per game for the Sunbirds, though she has been relegated to coming off the bench for FPU in the last few games. Flores and Cox are combining to score 38 percent of Fresno's points this season.

Biola has dropped its last three games to Fresno Pacific, and trails the all-time series 42-14. The Eagles are 5-7 in the last 12 games and split the series five of the last six seasons. Biola is also 4-2 at home since 2001-02 against the Sunbirds.

#3 VANGUARD UNIVERSITY (11-2 Overall, 7-0 GSAC): The Lions continue to put together one of the best teams not only in the GSAC, but also in the country. This season, though, has been a bit rougher than years past as Vanguard graduated four of their five starters from last season's NAIA Semifinal team.



After starting 2007-08 in the top spot nationally, Vanguard has fallen to the No. 3 after losses to Freed-Hardman and Lee University in non-conference play.

The Lions' only returning starter from last season happens to also be the NAIA National Player of the Year, in Jessica Richter. Richter, a transfer from NCAA Division I Syracuse University, leads the team and is second in the conference with a 23.4 ppg average. She also has 39 assists, 32 steals, and is averaging 7.5 rebounds in nearly 33 minutes played per game this year.

Senior forward Melissa Cook is contributing 15.2 points and 8.4 rebounds per game after moving into a starting role this season.

Vanguard holds a 29-25 lead in the all-time series against the Eagles and has won 11 of the last 12 games between the two. Last year, the Lions recorded a pair of lopsided wins, winning 98-72 in La Mirada and showing no mercy in a 117-44 win in Costa Mesa.

Swim Team Wraps Up Dual Meet Season With Home Meet Versus Chapman

The Biola University swimming and diving team wraps up a busy month and ends the regular-season with a home dual meet this week.

On Saturday (Jan. 26), the Eagles welcome Chapman University to Lansing Pool for an early 10:00 a.m. dual meet.

Chapman, a member of the NCAA Division III, pulled off a narrow defeat of the Biola men in a dual at Cal Baptist on Jan. 12. The Panthers edged the Eagles 128-99 in that meet. On the women's side, Biola cruised to a 145-83 victory over Chapman.

As this will be the final meet before the Pacific Collegiate Swimming Conference championship meet Feb. 13-16, it will serve as a final tune-up for the swimmers.

Biola has 14 swimmers who have qualified for the NAIA Championships and another handful that are still looking to make the cut.

In their last meet, the Eagles got a chance to see newcomers Concordia and Fresno Pacific in a dual meet in Fresno.

Freshman Paul Mendoza led the way for

the men's team with a school-record 4:24.61 in the 400 IM. Mendoza also placed first in the 1,000 Free and second in the 500.

Oviedo took top honors in the 200 Fly, knocking a second off his best time of the season and finishing in 2:03.23. He also placed second in the 100 Fly in a 53.51.

For the women, freshman April Smith won a pair of events, taking the 200 Free in 2:02.19 and the 200 Breaststroke in 2:33.17. In addition, she swam an impressive 4:54.76 in an exhibition heat of the 400 IM, adding another qualifying time to her impressive first season.

Junior Christina Piakak took first in the 200 butterfly with a mark of 2:23.50 and was second in the 100 fly in 1:03.54.
