Basketball, Swimming Return to Action With Home Contests This Week

It's a new year and the winter sports at Biola University will kick it off with home contests this week after taking some time off for Christmas Break.

Men's Basketball Hosts The Master's; Travels to Undefeated California Baptist

The Biola men's basketball team is riding high after going 2-0 at the Bethany University tournament to improve to 9-4 on the season. The Eagles continue to lead the NAIA in scoring defense and opposing field goal percentage. Biola is holding opponents to just over 56 points per game and 37 percent shooting through 13 games this season.

The Eagles return to GSAC play this week, hosting The Master's College on Tuesday (Jan. 8) at 7:30 p.m.

On Saturday (Jan. 12) comes a big road game for Biola, which travels to Riverside to square off against undefeated and #15-ranked California Baptist University.

The Eagles have been playing well since a pair of disappointing conference losses at the end of November. Biola is 6-1 since that point with its only loss coming on the road to NCAA Division II Cal State Los Angeles. However, the Eagles have posted a win over another NCAA Division II opponent—Wayne State College—and defeated NAIA Division II #5 Evangel College in their last outing.

Women's Basketball Looks to Get Back on Winning Track

The Biola women's basketball team looks to put a frustrating start to the 2007-08 season in the past, opening the new year with a pair of GSAC games this week.

The road will not be easy to start, though, as the Eagles open 2008 with a home game against No. 6-ranked The Master's College on Tuesday (Jan. 8) at 5:30 p.m.

On Saturday (Jan. 12), the Eagles travel to Riverside to take on No. 21-ranked California Baptist at 5:30 p.m.

Biola has struggled through the first half of the season, going 4-8 and dropping five of their last six games. The Eagles have been able to stay close in most of their games with five of their eight losses coming by seven or fewer points. Hopefully, 2008 will see Biola pick up wins in those close games.

Swimming Hosts First of Two Home Meets

The Biola swim team opened 2008 on Saturday at the UC Irvine Invitational. The meet featured a number of top NCAA Division I schools and gave the Eagles a chance to get back into action after break.

This week, Biola takes part in a pair of meets. On Friday (Jan. 11), the Eagles host Grand Canyon University at 1:00 p.m. This will be one of just two home meets for Biola this year with the other coming in two weeks against Chapman University.

On Saturday, the Eagles travel to Riverside to take part in a quad-meet at California Baptist University. Other teams at the meet include Chapman University and Grand Canyon University.

Coach Holmquist Nearing Another Pair of Milestones

Biola Men's Basketball Head Coach Dave Holmquist is nearing another pair of coaching milestones. Coach Holmquist will coach his 1,000th game on Tuesday (Jan. 15) at Westmont College. In addition, he is just seven wins away from recording his 700th victory as the coach of the Eagles.

Overall, Coach Holmquist is 729-268 in his 30 years of coaching. He has amassed a record of 693-225 and a winning percentage of .755 in 27 seasons at Biola.

BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Heads Back Into GSAC Play Against The Master's and Cal Baptist

Coming off a stretch which has seen the team win six of its last seven games, Biola returns to GSAC action this week looking to keep the momentum going.

The Eagles re-open GSAC play with a home game against The Master's College on Tuesday (Jan. 8) at 7:30 p.m. at Chase Gymnasium.

On Saturday (Jan. 12), Biola travels to Riverside for a game with undefeated and #15-ranked California Baptist University. The game is slated for a 7:30 p.m. tip-off.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

THE MASTER'S COLLEGE (8-5 Overall, 2-1 GSAC):

The Mustangs are off to a strong start this season and have already made a bit of noise around the GSAC with their impressive 80-72 win over #3 Concordia back on Nov. 20. The Master's opened the season with a 5-2 mark before splitting its last six games.

The Mustangs have relied heavily on junior guard Ryan Zamroz and senior forward Eric Durso through the first 13 games. The duo has combined to average 33 of the teams' 71 points so far this season. Zamroz leads the way with 19.4 ppg and adds a team-best 47 assists while Durso is contributing 13.6 ppg and 7.7 rpg.

The Mustangs will be without their third-leading scorer in guard Nick Walker. Walker and reserve center Eric Noubissi were not listed on The Master's rosters post-break. Walker, a transfer from NCAA Division I Texas Southern, had been averaging 8.5 ppg and added a team-high 18 steals.

Biola leads the all-time series with the Mustangs 59-17 and have won 12 of the last 15 games. The Eagles are 10-1 in the last 11 games played at Chase Gymnasium.

#15 CALIFORNIA BAPTIST UNIVERSITY (11-0 Overall, 3-0 GSAC):

The Lancers are off to an amazing start at 11-0 and escaped with a 54-50 win at Fresno Pacific on Saturday to remain perfect on the season.

The victory sets up a big showdown for first place in the GSAC standings as Cal Baptist travels to face #10 Point Loma Nazarene (12-1, 3-0 GSAC) on Tuesday.

The Lancers have crushed the competition

so far, outscoring their opponents by an average of 19.5 ppg with Saturday's win at FPU being its closest win of the season thus far.

Junior forward Mark Roussin is leading CBU with 17.5 points and 6.9 rebounds per game. Roussin, an All-GSAC pick last season, has led the team in scoring in eight of its 11 games this year.

Biola is 52-34 all-time against Cal Baptist and has won 18 of the last 24 games in the series. In Riverside, Biola is 17-14 since 1965-66 and 3-4 in the last seven at CBU.

DEPENDABLE DEFENSE: The Eagles continue to lead the NAIA in scoring defense and opponent field goal percentage through the first half of the season. Biola is holding its opponents to 56.3 ppg and a 34.7 field goal percentage.

HOLMQUIST NEARING TWO MORE MILESTONES:

Biola Head Coach Dave Holmquist is nearing two more coaching milestones. The first one will happen next Tuesday (Jan. 15) when he will coach his 1,000th game. It is fitting that it will come against long-time rival Westmont College. He will be just the 40th collegiate coach and the seventh NAIA Coach to coach 1,000 games.

Coach Holmquist is also nearing his 700th win at Biola, needing just seven victories to achieve that mark. In his 30 seasons of coaching, Holmquist is 729-268 overall (.732 winning percentage) and is 693-225 (.755 winning percentage) in 27 seasons at Biola.

BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Eagles Look To Rebound Against Two of the GSAC's Best

The Biola women's basketball team returns to action this week, looking to improve on a frustrating first half of the season that has left them with a 4-8 overall record through 12 games.

The Eagles look to turn things around in 2008 as they return to GSAC play this week. First up for Biola is a home game against #6 The Master's College on Tuesday (Jan. 8) at 5:30 p.m. in Chase Gymnasium.

On Saturday, the Eagles travel to Riverside for a game against #21 California Baptist University at 5:30 p.m.

Here is a closer look at Biola's opponents this week:

#6 THE MASTER'S COLLEGE (10-2 Overall, 2-1 GSAC):

The Mustangs have opened the season with a strong showing as one of three GSAC teams ranked in the NAIA Top 10. Their lone losses on the season have come on the road at the hands of #1 Union (Tenn.) and #2 Vanguard.

The Master's plays an up-tempo style of basketball, throwing a hard, full-court press at opponents and forcing them into quick turnovers. Typically, that keeps up for about the first 10 minutes of the half before the Mustangs relax a bit and, usually with a comfortable lead. This up-tempo offense has helped the team average 85.6 ppg, reaching the 100 point mark on three different occasions.

The backcourt combo of Annie Gillespie and Amanda Durocher lead The Master's offense this year, scoring 14.7 and 14.0 ppg, respectively.

Erica Inge and Jenn Ayers-Stamper are huge threats for the Mustangs off the bench. Inge is scoring 11.7 ppg and has a team-best 60 assists while Ayers-Stamper is contributing 10.9 ppg.

In the post, Stacy Nanninga is a dominating force, averaging 10.9 points, 6.8 rebounds, 1.8 blocks, 1.7 steals per game.

Despite holding a 28-19 lead in the all-time series, the Eagles have not had much success against The Master's in recent years.

Biola is 4-18 against TMC since the start of the 1996-97 season and has lost six straight.

#21 CALIFORNIA BAPTIST UNIVERSITY (8-2 Overall, 2-1 GSAC):



The Lancers are off to a great start under the direction of first-year coach Danelle Bishop, who coached at Azusa Pacific University the previous four seasons. Under her direction the Lancers, who finished 14-17 last season, are off to an impressive 8-2 start and are ranked #21 in the NAIA.

Junior guard Nicole Davis has shined in Coach Bishop's new system, scoring 22.7 ppg which ranks her second in the GSAC. She also has 6.9 assists, 2.1 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game.

Davis is one of five Lancers scoring in double-figures this season. Guard Erin Greenberg is scoring 12.5 points and adding 5.0 rebounds per contest while forward Romeka Randolph has 11.8 points and 6.3 rebounds a game.

Biola's overall mark against the Lancers stands at 37-26 and the Eagles have won 14 of the last 18 games in the series. Biola swept the season series in 2006-07, winning at home 73-66 and holding on for a 95-90 win at Riverside.

Swimmers Start Busy Month With Home Meet Versus Grand Canyon University

The Biola University swimming and diving teams kicks off a busy month with a pair of meets this week.

To start things off, the Eagles host Grand Canyon University on Friday (Jan. 11) in one of just two home meets this year. Grand Canyon is an NCAA Division II school in its first year of swimming.

Both teams travel east to Riverside to take part in a four-team meet at California Baptist University on Saturday (Jan. 12). Chapman University will round out the quartet of teams at the quad-dual meet.

After taking part in just four meets from October through December, the Eagles will participate in five meets this month as they prepare for the conference and NAAI Championships in February and March.

The month opened with Biola taking part in the UC Irvine/Ayers Hotel Invita-

tional which featured a number of strong NCAA Division I schools.

Having spent just three days in practice since returning from Christmas Break, the Eagles used the meet as more of a structured practice than a real competition.

Up next are four-straight dual meets including the two this week. The majority of swimmers already have qualified for the NAAI Championships, so dual meets give them a chance to get experience in their events before then. With 17 underclassmen on the two teams, the experience is quite valuable.

Dual meets also gives swimmers a chance to participate in events they are not accustomed to swimming in. Since each swimmer can only swim in three events at a dual meet, they must be able to swim in different events to help the team earn points.
