The Biola men's basketball squad continued its hot play as of late with a pair of GSAC wins this week including a stunning 85-62 win at No. 10 Point Loma Nazarene on Thursday. The Eagles also crushed Hope 85-29 on Tuesday.

The women's team opened the week with an impressive 96-85 win over Hope on Tuesday, but lost 80-51 at Point Loma Nazarene and 78-69 at Chapman University in a non-conference game to round out the week.

The baseball squad kicked off the GSAC schedule with a doubleheader split against San Diego Christian, losing 5-2 in the opener and winning 10-1 in the nightcap.

Softball swept a non-conference doubleheader with Bethany in its home-opener, winning 10-0 and 9-1 with both games lasting just five innings.

BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

Eagles Look to Keep Streak Going With Two Big Games This Week

THISWEEK: The Biola men's basketball team begins its final push as just six games remain in the regular season. The Eagles travel to The Master's on Tuesday (Feb. 12) for a big GSAC road game before returning home for a showdown against Cal Baptist on Saturday (Feb. 16). Both games start at 7:30 p.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (14-9 overall, 6-7 GSAC) have won four of their last five games after a season-long four-game losing streak. Biola opened play last week with an 85-29 shellacking of Hope International on Tuesday. The Eagles then followed that up with an 85-62 upset victory at #10 Point Loma Nazarene on Thursday...As the regular season begins to draw to a close, all eyes begin watching the GSAC standings. Currently, Biola is tied for seventh with Westmont, 1-1/2 games behind Fresno Pacific and two games behind Azusa Pacific and Vanguard. The Eagles need to finish in the top eight to make the GSAC playoffs. Their NAIA chances are not looking too rosy as their best chance of making it into the NAIA tournament right now is by earning an automatic berth by winning the conference tournament...Biola's 56-point win over Hope on Tuesday was key on a number of levels. Not only did the Eagles avenge a disappointing loss to the Royals earlier this season, but it allowed them to rest their main players ahead of the rare Thursday game...Freshman **Andrew Schroeder** recorded his first career double-double with 18 points and 10 rebounds in the game while **Danny Jones** recorded 19 points and 10 boards in just 22 minutes...Sophomore guard **Marlon King**, who has averaged 14 points a game over the last 10 contests, was the only Biola player not to score in the Hope game as he allowed his teammates to shine and did not take a shot in the game. However, he followed that game up with a 17-point outburst to help lead the Eagles to a win over Point Loma on Thursday...Head Coach **Dave Holmquist** is just two wins away from his 700th victory at Biola. He enters this weeks games with an overall mark of 698-230, a remarkable .752 winning percentage.

THE MASTER'S NOTES: The Mustangs (11-12 overall, 5-8 GSAC) have dropped their last four straight games and have fallen to ninth in the GSAC standings after spending the majority of the season in the middle of the pack. Probably the most surprising thing about their recent struggles is that three of those four losses have come at home where they knocked off GSAC leaders Concordia and Point Loma earlier this season...Junior guard **Ryan Zamroz** continues to lead the Mustangs with 18.6 ppg. Right behind him is senior forward **Eric Durso**, who contributes 14.6 points and 9.5 rebounds per game... The Mustangs received a big boost after Christmas as junior forward Jeremy Haggerty joined the team.

Since that point, he has added 13.9 ppg...The Eagles have dominated the series with the Mustangs over the years, leading 60-17 in the all-time series. Since 2000, the Eagles are 16-4 against The Master's including a 77-65 home win earlier this season.

CALIFORNIA BAPTIST NOTES: The No. 16-ranked Lancers (18-3 Overall, 10-3 GSAC) jumped back into the top spot in the conference with an 85-81 win over Concordia two weeks ago and a sweep of games last week. However, Cal Baptist has won just three of its last five games after starting the season 15-1...Junior forward Mark Roussin, a transfer from Hope International, leads the Lancers with 18 points and 8.5 rebounds per game. He also has 46 assists, 40 steals and 22 blocks...Junior forward Matt Gonzalez adds 11 points and six rebounds a game while junior guard Dave Cernin contributes 10.3 ppg...The Lancers got the better of the Eagles earlier this season, handing them a 68-61 defeat in Riverside. Biola led through most of the first half and trailed by just one with 8:15 to play, but was unable to pull out the win...The Eagles hold a 52-35 lead in the all-time series, but have lost four of the last six games between the two schools. Biola is 11-2 against Cal Baptist in La Mirada in the last 13 seasons.

BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Faces Two Ranked Teams; Plays At The Master's and Hosts CBU

THIS WEEK: The Biola women's basketball team wraps up its busiest stretch of the season on Tuesday (Feb. 12), traveling to #12 The Master's for its fourth game in eight days. On Saturday (Feb. 16), the Eagles return home for a big GSAC contest against #20 Cal Baptist. Both game tip at 5:30 p.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (6-17 overall, 3-10 GSAC) snapped their four-game losing streak with a big win on Tuesday, defeating Hope International 96-85. Biola then fell 80-51 to a hot-shooting Point Loma Nazarene team which is one of the GSAC's hottest teams right now having won 12-straight games. On Saturday, the Eagles made a furious comeback after falling behind by as many as 26 in the second half. However, they were unable to come away with the W, falling to Chapman University 78-69 in a non-conference game...The Eagles still have as strong chance of making the GSAC playoffs and currently sit in a three-way tie with Concordia and San Diego Christian for eighth in the conference... Biola's 96-point outburst was the most points scored by the Eagles in nearly a decade. The last time Biola scored 96 or more points was against Hope International back in the 1998-99 season. The school record was set in 1979 when the Eagles posted 130 points against Whittier College...Freshman guard **Jenna French** had a strong week, scoring in double-figures in all three game and averaging 16.7 points. French, from nearby La Serna High School in Whittier, has moved into a starting role this week as sophomore **Chelsea De Luca** has been hampered by injuries. In addition, Head Coach **Ken Crawford** has also worked with her to improve her outside shot. As a result, she hit three 3's in each game this week and was 9-for-18 overall from beyond the arc...Junior forward **Megann Alberts** was the catalyst for the Eagles in their win over Hope with 26 points, 14 rebounds and seven assists. Overall, she leads the team with 16.4 points and 8.0 rebounds per game.

THE MASTER'S NOTES: The #12-ranked Mustangs (16-6 overall, 8-5 GSAC) had a four-game winning streak snapped on Saturday, falling 74-64 at home to GSAC-leading Vanguard. The Master's is currently tied for fourth in the conference with Westmont and trails third-place Azusa Pacific by just two games. The Mustangs are just 4-3 in home conference games this season, but have won three of their last four at Bross Gym...The Master's has four players averaging double-digits in scoring this season led by sophomore guard Annie Gillespie's 13.7 ppg. Junior guard Amanda Durocher is contributing 12.3 ppg with freshman guard Erica Inge adding 10.5 points and a team-high 4.8 apg... The Mustangs defeated Biola 77-63 when the two did battle earlier this year. The game was a lot closer than the final score would indicate as the Mustangs scored 14 of

the final 17 points—mostly on free throws—to seal the deal...The victory was the seventh straight win for the Mustangs in the series though Biola still leads 28-20 overall. The Eagles have lost 11-straight games in Santa Clarita with their last win coming in 1995.

CALIFORNIA BAPTIST NOTES: The #20-ranked Lancers (13-7 overall, 7-6 GSAC) started out the season with an impressive 10-3 mark, but have gone 3-4 since that point. They have played very well at home where they are 9-3, but are just 4-4 on the road...The Eagles will need to contend with junior guard Nicole Davis who has been a scoring machine for the Lancers, averaging 21.4 points per game this season. She has taken a quarter of the team's shots over the season and has made more field goals than field goals attempts by all but one of her teammates...Junior guard Jeanine Deno adds 13.1 points a contest off the bench and is the only other Lancer averaging in double-figures...CBU knocked off Biola 88-68 earlier this season but still trails 37-27 all-time. The Eagles have won eight of the last nine games against the Lancers in La Mirada dating back to the 1998-99 season.

Eagles Play Four Games This Week Including Three Home Contests

THIS WEEK: The Biola baseball team begins a busy week with four games. Three of those games are at home starting with a non-conference contest against Cal State San Marcos at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday (Feb. 12). On Wednesday (Feb. 13), the Eagles return to GSAC play with a road game at Vanguard at 2:00 p.m. Saturday (Feb. 16) Biola hosts Point Loma Nazarene in what should be a big doubleheader at 11:00 a.m. at Eagles Diamond.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (3-2 overall, 1-1 GSAC) opened GSAC play on Saturday, splitting a doubleheader with San Diego Christian. Biola dropped the first game 5-2, but rebounded with a 10-1 win in the nightcap...Senior left-handed pitcher **Jimmy Johnson** tossed a seven-inning complete game in the second, allowing just one run on seven hits to pick up his second win of the season...The Eagles' pitching has been key to their success this year. Biola have an impressive 1.67 ERA through the first five games, though the offense has not been able to keep up. The Eagles have batted just .267 as a team through the first five games, but have been up and down offensively...Senior **Kris Cook** is leading the team with a .438 average (7-of-16) with a home run and seven RBIs...Junior **Nick Rotkowitz** is right behind him at .368 (7-of-19) and has four RBIs.

CAL STATE SAN MARCOS NOTES: The Cougars (3-5 overall) have struggled offensively batting .218 though their first eight games. However, the have been able to score a couple of big wins over Point

Loma Nazarene, winning by scores of 9-2 and 8-5. Cal State San Marcos is a member of the NAIA Region II and could be battling for a final spot in the Regional at the end of the season.

VANGUARD NOTES: The Lions (4-3 overall, 0-2 GSAC) were swept on Saturday by The Master's in their GSAC opener, snapping a three-game winning streak. Vanguard opened the season with a doubleheader split against Cal State San Marcos and has wins over Patten and two over Bethany. Just like the Eagles, the Lions have struggled offensively while their pitching has done well. Vanguard is batting just .212 on the season while its pitching has posted a 2.83 ERA. The Lions have already been shutout twice this season and should face a strong foe in Biola's pitching staff on Wednesday.

POINT LOMA NAZARENE NOTES: The Sea Lions (6-3 overall, 1-1 GSAC) opened the year receiving votes in the national poll and opened the GSAC schedule with a doubleheader split at No. 2 Azusa Pacific. PLNU won the opener 8-2, but fell 6-4 in the nightcap. The Sea Lions have also dropped two games to Cal State San Marcos and have played all of their games at home. PLNU's offense has been the strongest of any GSAC team thus far, batting .334 and scoring 67 runs in nine games. Chris Honer has been the Sea Lions best starter, going 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in three starts this season. Andy Reilly has led the offense, batting .471 with two homers and 12 RBIs thus far.
