Swimming Heads to NAIA Championships This Week in Texas

The Biola Swimming and Diving Team travels to San Antonio, Texas this week for the NAIA National Championships at the Palo Alto Natatorium. The meet runs from Wednesday through Saturday. Biola is sending a contingent of 20 swimmers to the championships with a number seeded in the top eight. Last year, the Eagles placed seventh in both the men's and women's competitions.

Basketball Plays Final Road Game; Hosts Vanguard

The 2007-08 basketball season is coming to a close with just three games remaining including the big showdown against Azusa Pacific in the regular-season finale. However, before that happens the men's (16-11 overall, 8-9 GSAC) team and the women's (8-19 overall, 5-12 GSAC) play their final road contests at Fresno Pacific on Tuesday before hosting Vanguard on Saturday. The women's games tip-off at 5:30 p.m. and the men's start at 7:30 p.m.

Baseball Heads to Cal Baptist; Hosts Concordia in Doubleheader Saturday

Biola's baseball team (9-5 overall, 4-4 GSAC) has won four of its last five games and travels to Riverside for a big GSAC showdown against #13 Cal Baptist on Wednesday at 2:00 p.m. The Eagles then host Concordia in a doubleheader at Eagles Diamond on Saturday beginning at 11:00 a.m.

Biola's women's basketball team picked up a huge win at Concordia, defeating CUI 70-56. The Eagles opened the week with a 75-56 loss to Westmont.

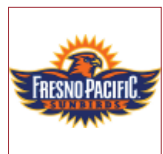
BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Hits Final Stretch; Travels to Fresno Pacific, Hosts Vanguard

THIS WEEK: Biola has just three games remaining in its schedule and is fighting to secure one of the final playoff berths in the GSAC standings. The week begins with a trip north to face Fresno Pacific on Tuesday, a team which holds a half-game lead over the Eagles. Saturday, Biola hosts Vanguard in its next-to-last game of the year. Both games start at 7:30 p.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (16-11 overall, 8-9 GSAC) currently occupy the eighth and final spot in the GSAC standings. They are just one-half game behind Fresno Pacific, one behind The Master's and two back of Point Loma Nazarene. Biola also has a one-game lead on Westmont heading into the final three games. Biola is in this position after going 5-2 to start the second half of the GSAC schedule after going 2-7 during the first half...The Eagles picked up a huge win on Tuesday, defeating Westmont 72-66 at Chase Gymnasium to move past the Warriors into the final spot. Biola lost 73-56 to No. 7 Concordia, snapping its two-game winning streak against teams in the NIAA's Top 10...Head Coach **Dave Holmquist** won his 700th game at Biola as the Eagles downed Westmont 72-66 on Tuesday. Holmquist is 700-232 in his 28 years at Biola and has a 736-275 overall in his coaching career...sophomore **Marlon King** has had the hot hand as of late, averaging 14 points in two games this week. King scored a game-high 17 points against Westmont and added 11 against Concordia. He is now averaging 11.4 points per game this year and shooting an impressive 48 percent from the field.

FRESNO PACIFIC NOTES: The Sunbirds (18-10 overall, 9-9 GSAC) have just two games remaining in their schedule as they have the final bye of the regular season. Fresno Pacific has dropped five of its last seven games and has just a 1-1/2 game lead on



Westmont for the final spot in the GSAC playoffs... Leading scorer Adrian Sanchez, who is averaging 13.5 ppg, has reached double-figures just twice in the last seven games. The senior forward is one of four players averaging in double-figures. He is joined by sophomore forward Todd Brown (12.6 ppg, 5.6 rpg), senior forward Jordan Farley (11.6 ppg, 6.9 rpg) and senior guard Andrew David (10.3 ppg, 2.9 apg)... The Sunbirds were among the GSAC's hottest teams when they beat Biola 73-63 in La Mirada earlier this season. Farley led the way with 25 points and 11 rebounds while Sanchez added 22 points...The win by Fresno Pacific at Biola was just the first by the Sunbirds since 1996-97 and snapped a 14-game home winning-streak by Biola in the series. The Eagles still hold a commanding 57-21 overall lead and have won 22 of the last 24 games between the two schools dating back to the 1996-97 season.

VANGUARD NOTES: The Lions (18-8 Overall, 11-6 GSAC) have put together a surprisingly strong season and are battling to finish in the top half of the GSAC standings heading into the final week. A loss to Azusa Pacific on Saturday put an end to



Vanguard's five-game winning streak, though the Lions have still won seven of their last nine games... Vanguard has a balanced season-scoring list with six players averaging eight points per game or better. Sophomore guards Dennis Heehan and Greg Scott lead the way with Heehan contributing 11.7 ppg and 5.3 rpg with Scott adding 10.7 ppg and 6.0 apg... Biola downed the Lions 73-66 in Costa Mesa earlier this season and now holds a 50-31 lead in the series and have won 10 of the last 15 against Vanguard. Last season, both games were thrillers with the Lions winning 64-63 at La Mirada and Biola recording a 58-51 victory in overtime in Costa Mesa.

BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Eagles Look to Clinch Playoff Spot This Week at Fresno

THIS WEEK: The Biola women's basketball team is coming off a clutch victory over Concordia last week and sets its sights on earning a GSAC playoff spot this week. First up is the Eagles final road game of the season, traveling to Fresno Pacific on Tuesday. Biola then returns home to face Vanguard on Saturday. Both games are scheduled to start at 5:30 p.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (7-18 overall, 4-11 GSAC) picked up a huge victory on Saturday, downing Concordia University 70-56, sweeping the season series and essentially giving Biola a two-game lead on CUI for the final GSAC playoff spot. Concordia is one game back but Biola holds the tiebreaker by virtue of sweeping the season-series. San Diego Christian currently sits in 10th place and is two games back of the Eagles with three to play. Biola needs just one win or losses by SDCC and CUI to wrap up its first GSAC playoff berth in four years...Biola opened the week with a tough 75-56 loss to Westmont College... Junior **Megann Alberts** continues to lead Biola's offense, averaging 16.4 point and 7.9 rebounds per game this year. Last week, Alberts scored 40 points in the Eagles' two games including recording her eighth double-double of the season with 24 points and 11 rebounds in the win over Concordia...Forward **Summer Matthews** has regained her shooting touch after struggling through a rough patch midway through the season. Matthews is averaging 11.3 ppg over the last seven games and had her fifth double-double of the season with 17 points and 11 rebounds against Concordia...Sophomore **Elise Paty** scored 27 points last week thanks to nine three-pointers in the two games. Paty has been on-fire from beyond the arc and ranks fourth in the GSAC in 3-pt field goals made (2.33/game) and sixth in 3-pt field goal percentage (.401). She now has 100 through her first two seasons at Biola and is on pace to finish as one of the two best three-point shooters in school history.

FRESNO PACIFIC NOTES: The Sunbirds (9-19 overall, 2-16 GSAC) snapped an eight-game losing streak with a 65-48 win over San Diego Christian on Saturday.

However, Fresno Pacific has had a frustrating season with just two GSAC wins. Of course the first one came at the expense of Biola as Fresno Pacific drained 13 three-pointers including a buzzer-beater by Samantha Cardeno as the Sunbirds beat the Eagles 71-70 in La Mirada earlier this season...Fresno Pacific's bright spot on offense has been from senior forward Keri Cox who is averaging 14.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per game in her final season with the Sunbirds...Biola has dropped its last four games to Fresno Pacific, and trails the all-time series 43-14. The Eagles are 5-8 in the last 13 games and split the series five of the last six seasons.

VANGUARD NOTES: The #4-ranked Lions (20-3 overall, 16-1 GSAC) are in good position to claim their sixth straight GSAC title, needing just a win over Point Loma Nazarene on Thursday all but clinch the title. Of course they will still have two



games after that and Biola could play spoiler with a win over Vanguard on Saturday...Should both teams win on Tuesday, the two teams would likely meet in the first round of the GSAC playoffs...Defending NAIA Player of the Year Jessica Richter leads Vanguard with her 20.5 ppg and 8.0 rpg averages. Richter has scored in double-figures in all but two games this season, though one of those games was against Biola as the Eagles held her to just nine points though the Lions won the game 86-57...Vanguard leads the all-time series 30-25 and has won 12 of the last 13 games between the two.

Biola Swims Well at Conference Championships; Readies for NAIA

The Biola University swimming and diving team wraps up the 2008 season this week at the NAIA National Championships at the Palo Alto Natatorium in San Antonio, Texas.

The meet runs Thursday through Saturday with prelims in the morning and finals at night.

On Thursday, the meet kicks off with the 200 medley and 800 free relays along with the 50 free, 500 free and the 200 IM.

Friday features the 100 of each stroke, the 200 free, the 400 IM and the 200 free relay and the 400 medley relay.

The meet wraps up Saturday with the 200 of each stroke, the 100 free, the 1650 free and the 400 free relay.

Biola has qualified 20 swimmers for the NAIA Championships—eight from the men's team and 12 from the women's team. The Eagles are a young team with a number of freshman leading the way. The top two this year have been **April Smith** on the women's side and **Paul Mendoza** for the men.

Smith has qualified in six different events this season while Mendoza has earned cuts in four events. Both swimmers have also shattered numerous school records this season.

Sophomore **Ben Oviedo** has put together a well-rounded season, qualifying in six events for Biola including an impressive 2:02.68 in the 200 backstroke at the PCSC conference meet on Saturday.

The NAIA Championships will be the final meet for five Biola swimmers on the women's side. They are **Elena Fernandez, Ali Patt, Christina Piakak, Meghan Samsvick** and **Brittany Sharpe**. All five swimmers have been instrumental in bringing the women's team to prominence over the last four seasons.

Eagles Travel to Cal Baptist; Host Concordia in Twinbill on Saturday

THIS WEEK: The Biola baseball team plays a trio of GSAC games this week. First up, the Eagles travel to Riverside to face Cal Baptist in a single game on Wednesday at 2:00 p.m. On Saturday, Biola returns home to take on Concordia University in a doubleheader at Eagles Diamond. First pitch is scheduled for 11:00 a.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (9-5 overall, 4-4 GSAC) went 4-1 last week, opening the week with a sweep over Bethany in a two-game series. Biola took the first game 11-9 in 10 innings on Monday and won 8-0 on Tuesday. The Eagles then returned to GSAC play with an 8-5 win over Vanguard on Thursday and split a twinbill at The Master's, winning the opener 2-1 and falling 9-3 in the nightcap...Senior lefty **Jimmy Johnson** struck out 11 and allowed just one run on five hits to earn the complete-game victory on Saturday. Johnson improves his record to 4-0 on the season and drops his ERA to 2.10...**Chris Foreman** scored the winning run in that game with a straight steal of home in the top of the eighth inning...**Hawkins Gebbers** and **Nick Rotkowitz** had the best offensive numbers this week. Gebbers went 7-for-17 with three doubles in five games while Rotkowitz was 8-for-20 with four runs scored and three RBIs.

CALIFORNIA BAPTIST NOTES: The Lancers (14-5 overall, 4-4 GSAC) got off to a hot start to the season, but have struggled in GSAC play. Cal Baptist lost twice at Fresno Pacific to start the GSAC sched-

ule and split at Westmont the next weekend. Since then, though, the Lancers have won three-straight GSAC games including a doubleheader sweep of Vanguard on Saturday...Part of the problem has been their play on the road as the Lancers are just 2-5



on the road, but 12-0 at their new baseball facility... Cal Baptist is led by All-American Steve Goins, who is batting a team-high .360 on the season and also has a 4-1 record with a miniscule 1.54 ERA...Biola was 3-3 against the Lancers in 2007, ending CBU's season with a 12-8 win in the NAIA Region II tournament.

CONCORDIA NOTES: The Eagles (3-5 overall, 2-4 GSAC) have struggled through the first eight games of their season with most of the blame resting squarely on the pitching staff. Biola Returns Home (Finally) to Host Bethany University on Wednesday

THIS WEEK: The Biola University softball team returns home for its first home games since Feb. 7, hosting Bethany University in a non-conference doubleheader at Freedom Field on Wednesday. First pitch is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. The Eagles then head to San Diego to play a non-conference games against Lee University (TN) and the University of Mobile (AL). Biola faces Mobile at 11:00 a.m. and Lee at 3:00 p.m. Both games are being played at Point Loma Nazarene.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (4-4 overall, 0-0 GSAC) had a frustrating road trip last week, going 1-3 in a trip up to the Bay area where they faced a pair of NCAA Division II schools. Biola was swept 9-0 and 10-1 by San Francisco State on Monday, but followed that up with a split at Notre Dame de Namur on Tuesday. The Eagles won 2-1 in the first game, but blew a late lead and lost 4-3 in the second...Biola's success has come thanks to its offense as the Eagles are 3-1 when scoring two or more runs. They are batting .328 as a team so far with four players batting .375 or better. **Krista Johnson** leads the way with a .435 batting average and has a team-best seven RBIs. Erin DaSilva is just behind her with a .429 average... Biola's pitching has struggled a bit this year, though three of the four pitchers on the team are just freshman. **Emily Gray**, the lone upperclassmen, is 2-1 with a 3.68 ERA while freshman Lyndsie Roberts is 2-1 with a 2.62 ERA.

HOLY NAMES NOTES: The Hawks (4-7 overall) are playing well in their first season as a varsity program. Just ask No. 14-ranked College of Idaho, which Holy Names defeated 4-3 for just the second

win in the program's history...The Hawks have lost four straight games while playing at the Cal Baptist tournament this weekend and faces a rough schedule this week. Holy Names plays three doubleheaders in three days against three ranked teams this week starting at No. 3 Point Loma, then at No. 10 Vanguard and wrapping up at No. 19 Biola on Wednesday... Team stats were not available for the Hawks through their first 11 games.

UNIVERSITY OF MOBILE NOTES: The No. 13-ranked Rams (4-0 overall) are off to a great start winning their first four games of the 2008 season—all against NAIA Top-25 competition... The Rams have posted a combined .339 batting average through the first four game and have a team ERA of just 0.81 as they have outscored their opponents 29-5 on the season...Mobile was 36-17 last year and earned a trip to the NAIA National Championships by winning the NAIA Region XIII tournament.

LEE UNIVERSITY NOTES: The No. 11-ranked Flames (6-0 overall) also have not lost yet in 2008, going 6-0, though their games have come against unranked competition...Lee's offense has been strong as the team is batting .393 on the season led by Tiffany Walker's .688 average...Lee earned an at-large berth to the NAIA Championships last year and finished with a 43-16 record.
