The Biola men's basketball team suffered a frustrating loss at Azusa Pacific on Tuesday, but rebounded with a come-from-behind home victory against San Diego Christian on Saturday. The victory was the second in three games for the Eagles.

The women's basketball team dropped a pair of games, as a major comeback effort fell just short against Azusa Pacific on Tuesday. In Saturday's contest, Biola was unable to keep up with a hot-shooting San Diego Christian squad which edged the Eagles at La Mirada.

The baseball team opened the season with a 13-0 win over Simpson University on Tuesday. The Eagles followed that with a split in a home-and-home series against La Verne, falling 2-1 at home and winning 7-4 in La Verne.

The track and field squads saw three more individuals and events qualify for the NAIA Indoor Championships while participating in the Concordia Indoor Qualifying meet on Friday. Sunday, Danielle Simpson punched her ticket in the Marathon, running a strong race at the Surf City Marathon.

The men's tennis team opened the year with a 6-3 loss to Whittier College on Friday while the women's tennis team began the 2008 season with a good showing at the Cal State Los Angeles Invitational as a number of players won matches.

BIOLA MEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Looks to Build on Win; Hosts Hope Before Traveling to Point Loma

THIS WEEK: The Biola men's basketball team closes out its brief two-game home stand this week, hosting Hope International University on Tuesday (Feb. 5) at Chase Gymnasium. The Eagles then hit the road on Thursday (Feb. 7) for a big GSAC contest at #13 Point Loma Nazarene. Both games are scheduled to tip-off at 7:30 p.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (11-9 overall, 3-7 GSAC) have won two of their last three games after snapping a season-high four-game losing streak. Biola came back from a nine-point second-half deficit to score a 64-55 win over San Diego Christian on Saturday after suffering at tough loss to arch-rival Azusa Pacific on Tuesday...Sophomore guard **Marlon King** continued his hot play, scoring a game-high 23 points and adding three steals and three assists in the Eagles' win over San Diego Christian. It was the third time in the last eight games that King scored 20-plus points and ups his season average to 11.9 points per game...Sophomore forward **Rocky Hampton** finished the week averaging 13 points and 10 rebounds in the two games including 16 points at Azusa. Saturday's 10-point, 11-rebound performance marked the third-straight game Hampton scored in double-figures after failing to reach that mark in the previous three. He is averaging 12.4 points and 8.5 rebounds per game for the Eagles this season...Senior **Danny Jones**—the other member of the Biola "Twin Towers"—had just nine points at Azusa, but scored 16 against SDCC and continues to lead the team with 14.5 ppg and 8.9 rpg. The nine points is his lowest point total this season...Biola continues to lead the GSAC and rank among the top five schools in the NAIA in scoring defense, allowing just 60.3 ppg. Opponents are also hitting just under 40 percent from the field against the Eagles, which also leads the GSAC. However, Biola still ranks next-to-last in the conference in scoring, averaging just 65.9 points per game and ranks last in assists per contest at 11.3.

HOPE INTERNATIONAL NOTES: The Royals (1-17 overall, 1-10 GSAC) have continued to struggle through the 2007-08 season, picking up just one victory to 17 defeats. Of course the one win came at the expense of Biola as Hope pulled off a stunning 59-55 win over the Eagles in Fullerton earlier this season. In that game, Biola allowed Hope to shoot 47 percent from the field including over 50 percent from beyond the arc. The Eagles managed just one three-pointer on 12 attempts and shot just 37 percent from the field...Junior forward Arron Boone scored 23 points to lead Hope in that game and has been the team's leading scorer ever since. He is averaging 10.7 points and 5.5 rebounds for the Royals... Hope's victory over the Eagles earlier this season was

just the second win for the Royals in the 35 games between the two schools.

POINT LOMA NAZARENE NOTES: The Sea Lions (17-4 Overall, 8-3 GSAC) enter Thursday's game ranked No. 13 in the latest NAIA Poll and tied for second in the GSAC with Cal Baptist. Point Loma started out the season red-hot, but is just 4-3 in its last seven contests...Senior guard Josh Sander-son has been a dominant force for the Sea Lions this season and is widely considered one of the best in the conference. He is averaging 15 points per game this season and has 92 steals and 32 steals...The Sea Lions stunned a huge Biola crowd earlier this season when they overcame an 11-point deficit with 4:34 remaining and beat the Eagles 63-59. Biola shot just 20 percent in the second half of that game even with the home crowd on its side. Now things will be decidedly harder as the Eagles must contend with one of the toughest crowds in the GSAC...Biola has lost the last three games in San Diego dating back to 2004-05 including a 63-60 loss last season. Overall, the Eagles hold a 52-27 advantage in the all-time series, though they have dropped the last five straight and are just 5-8 in the last 13 series games.

BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Begins Stetch of Four Games in Eight Days by Hosting Hope

THIS WEEK: The Biola women's basketball team has a busy week coming up, playing four games over the next eight days, beginning with Tuesday's (Feb. 5) home game against an upstart Hope International squad. On Thursday (Feb. 7), Biola travels to Point Loma Nazarene for a GSAC contest against the Sea Lions. The Eagles wrap up the week with a non-conference road game on Saturday (Feb. 9) against Chapman University. Tuesday and Thursday's games tip off at 5:30 p.m. while Saturday's game at Chapman will begin at 5:00 p.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (5-15 overall, 2-9 GSAC) had another frustrating week of close calls that ended in a pair of disappointing losses. On Tuesday at Azusa Pacific, Biola used an 11-2 run in the final two minutes to cut a 14-point deficit to just five with over 30 seconds to go, but eventually time just ran out on the Eagles in a 77-70 loss. On Saturday, Biola ran into a hot-shooting San Diego Christian squad which drained 10 three-pointers en route to a 74-63 win over the Eagles...Junior forward **Meggann Alberts** had another strong week, averaging 21.5 points and 11.5 rebounds to pace Biola. She scored 25 points for the Eagles at Azusa Pacific and recorded her sixth double-double of the season with an 18-point, 14-rebound performance against San Diego Christian on Saturday...Senior guard **Mandi England** made the most of her final trip to APU, scoring 14 points and adding four assists and three assists on Tuesday. The game was the first time she reached double-figures this season as she drained four three-pointers on the night...Sophomore guard Elise Paty had a great game against San Diego Christian, hitting five three-pointers and finishing with 15 points overall. Paty, who is hitting over 38 percent from three-point range, leads the Eagles with 44 three's on the season.

HOPE INTERNATIONAL NOTES: The Royals (14-9 overall, 5-6 GSAC) have been the talk of the GSAC this season as they have posted an impressive 14-9 overall record and sit right in the middle of the conference standings with a 5-6 GSAC record. The Royals nearly pulled off their biggest win in a number of seasons last week, falling 73-72 at Vanguard...Hope's impressive season has been thanks in large part to the play of senior guard Jasmine Nault, who leads the NAIA in scoring with 24.9 ppg. Nault has been virtually unstoppable this season, scoring 20 or more points in all but one game and reaching the 30-point plateau four times including a 36-point outburst against Concordia...Freshman guard Britanni Philbrook and junior guard Sarah Nylander each are scoring 11.2 ppg...Biola has had the better of the all-time series, leading 21-4. However, the Royals have won four of the last six games in the series after

losing 19 straight games to Biola. Earlier this season, Hope downed the Eagles 62-57 in Fullerton thanks to 24 points by Nault.

POINT LOMA NAZARENE NOTES: The Sea Lions (16-2 overall, 10-1 GSAC, Ranked No. 3 in NAIA) have been in a three-way battle for supremacy in the conference with Vanguard and Azusa Pacific throughout the 2007-08 season. Last week, PLNU won its 10th-straight game by beating APU 61-56. Just a few weeks back, the Sea Lions snapped Vanguard's 53-game GSAC winning streak with an 86-65 shellacking of the Lions in San Diego...Biola nearly pulled off the upset against Point Loma when the two met in La Mirada earlier this season. Despite trailing by as many as 14 in the first half, the Eagles tied the score at 60-60 with just over five minutes to play. However, the Sea Lions quickly snapped out of their funk and held on for a 76-69 win...Senior guard Kerra Sutton-Wodarski leads the Sea Lions in scoring at 11.9 ppg, with sophomore forward Colleen Planeta adding 10.2 ppg and 5.2 rpg...Biola holds a slight 30-27 lead in the all-time series, but has lost 11 of the last 12 against Point Loma.
