Baseball, Softball Host Big GSAC Doubleheaders This Week

Baseball Travels to Westmont; Hosts Doubleheader Against APU on Saturday

The Biola baseball team (13-7 overall, 8-6 GSAC) has won eight of its last 11 games to move into a virtual tie for third in the conference. The Eagles put hope to move up even higher this week as they travel to Westmont for a single GSAC game on Wednesday at 3:00 p.m. Biola then returns home for a huge doubleheader on Saturday against arch-rival Azusa Pacific with first pitch slated for Noon.

Softball Hosts GSAC Twinbill Against Vanguard; Travels to Concordia on Saturday

Softball (6-10 overall, 0-2 GSAC) looks to snap its six-game losing streak and get its first GSAC win of the season with four games in conference this week. The Eagles host Vanguard University in a doubleheader on Tuesday at Freedom Field at 2:00 p.m. On Saturday Biola hits the road for two games at Concordia University beginning at Noon.

Tennis Teams Host Dallas Baptist; Women Travel to La Verne

Women's Tennis (4-7 overall, 0-5 GSAC) is in the midst of a three-game winning streak and has won four of its last five matches overall. The Eagles put that streak on the line with a pair of matches this week. First up, Biola hosts NCAA Division II Dallas Baptist University on Tuesday at 1:00 p.m. On Friday, the Eagles head to La Verne for a non-conference match against the University of La Verne at 2:30 p.m.

Men's Tennis (1-8 overall, 0-4 GSAC) picked up its first victory of the season last week and has just one match this week. The Eagles also host NCAA DII Dallas Baptist on Tuesday at 1:00 p.m.

Track Wraps Up Indoor Regular Season

Biola's indoor track and field teams had a successful end to the season as two Eagles earned NAIA All-American honors at the NAIA Indoor Championships last week in Johnson City, Tenn. Biola now turns its attention to the outdoor schedule which opens with a trip to Los Angeles on Friday for the Occidental College Distance Meet at 6:00 p.m.

Three All-Americans and Three All-GSAC Players Highlight Winter Season

Biola had three student-athletes earn All-America honors during the winter championships. They were freshman **Paul Mendoza** from the men's swimming team and sophomore **Kristin Schmidt** and freshman **Natasha Miller** from the women's track and field team.

Mendoza finished second in the mile swim at the NAIA Swim Championships, breaking the school record by nearly half a minute.

Miller took fourth place overall in the pentathlon including wins in the 800m run and the long jump in her first-ever NAIA Indoor Championship meet.

Schmidt finished fourth in the 5,000m run as she earned All-America honors for the fourth time in her career. It was a PR for Schmidt in the 5k and over a minute faster than her eighth-place time at last year's meet.

Biola also had three basketball players earn All-GSAC honors. On the women's side, it was junior **Megann Alberts** earning all-conference for the second-straight year.

For the men, senior **Danny Jones** also repeated as an All-GSAC selection while sophomore **Rocky Hampton** was received all-conference accolades for the first time in his career. NAIA All-Americans for basketball will be announced next week.

BIOLA BASEBALL

Baseball Heads to Westmont Tuesday; Hosts APU in Doubleheader Saturday

THIS WEEK: The Biola baseball team plays just three games this week, starting things out with a trip to Santa Barbara to face Westmont College on Wednesday at 3:00 p.m. Saturday, Biola returns home for a key GSAC doubleheader against Azusa Pacific University beginning at Noon.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (13-7 overall, 8-6 GSAC) have been playing well over the last three weeks, winning eight of their last 11 games. Included in that stretch has been a pair of splits in road doubleheaders against top GSAC teams, moving Biola back into contention in what should prove to be a tight conference race this year...The Eagles picked up a split at Fresno on Saturday, falling 13-0 in the opener, but rebounding with a 9-6 extra-inning win in the nightcap. Biola saw a 6-4 lead disappear heading into the bottom of the seventh, but forced extra innings by turning an impressive 6-8-3 doubleplay. In the top of the eighth, **Kris Cook** drove home the first run with a sac fly, then **David West** drove home two more to seal the deal...Junior transfer **Brent Chavez** has led the offense this year, posting a .382 average and a team-high .485 on-base percentage. Chavez was 2-for-4 with two runs scored and an RBI on Saturday at Fresno Pacific...Junior **Hawkins Gebbers** continues his hot hitting, collecting three hits in seven at bats on Saturday to raise his average to .377 on the year. Gebbers has hit safely in five-straight games and recorded seven multi-hit games this season...Biola still remains a perfect 12-0 when scoring four runs or more on the season but are just 1-7 when scoring three or fewer.

WESTMONT NOTES: The Warriors (3-12 overall,

2-11 GSAC) are mired in a five-game losing streak and have lost seven of their last eight games. Despite its record, Westmont is playing much better ball this year and has conference wins over Cal Baptist and The Master's to show for it. On Saturday, Westmont was swept by Azusa Pacific at home, though went 10 innings in the second game of the doubleheader before falling 4-3...Leading the Warriors is junior Mark Boujikian, who is batting .283 on the season...Biola is 40-4 against the Westmont since the 1997 season.



AZUSA PACIFIC NOTES: The No. 2-ranked Cougars (19-3 overall, 11-2 GSAC) matched their pro-



gram-best start to a season last week by going 17-1. However, a split at Fresno Pacific and a home loss to Dixie State has APU going 2-2 in its last four games...The Cougars earned a trip to the NAIA Tournament in 2007, winning the Region II crown and finishing the season with a 51-10 overall record...Azusa Pacific is leading the conference with a .352 batting average and has three hitters swinging at over .400 on the year. Leading the way is sophomore first baseman Bryce Cutspec with his .431 average. Senior shortstop Matt Venegas is right behind him with a .415 average while senior catcher Stephen Kohatsu is batting at a .404 clip...APU won all five games against Biola in 2007 including a season-ending 8-0 in the Regional semifinals. The Cougars lead the all-time series 96-49, though Biola is 16-8 against APU since the 2003 season.

BIOLA SOFTBALL

Biola Hosts Vanguard on Tuesday; Travels to Concordia on Saturday

THIS WEEK: The Biola University softball team wraps up its six-game homestand with a GSAC doubleheader against Vanguard University on Tuesday. First pitch is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. at Freedom Field. On Saturday, the Eagles travel down to Irvine to face Concordia University in another GSAC doubleheader set to begin at Noon.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (6-10 overall, 0-2 GSAC) have lost six-straight games after a promising start to the season. Biola was swept by #2 California Baptist in its GSAC opener on Saturday, falling 10-3 in the opener and 3-0 in the nightcap. Freshman pitcher **Erica Moyer** pitched well in the second game, not allowing a hit until the fifth inning. However, Biola's offense was unable to manufacture any runs of its own to support her. The Lancers finally broke through with a run in the fifth and added two in the sixth...Earlier in the week, Biola lost a non-conference doubleheader with #13 Mobile, falling by scores of 6-1 and 5-2...Senior **Jacqie Hudson** has been playing well on offense for Biola, collecting hits in her last five games. She is now batting .444 on the season with six runs scored and six RBIs...Sophomore **Krista Johnson** also is sporting a five-game hitting streak and upped her batting average to .435 on the season with nine runs scored and 10 driven in.

VANGUARD NOTES: The Lions (21-5 overall, 1-1 GSAC) opened the season ranked No. 10 in the NAIA and have lost just five games thus far. Vanguard split its GSAC openers in a home doubleheader against Concordia. The Lions won the opener 2-1 but

fell 5-0 in the nightcap...Vanguard's leading returner is senior pitcher Jennifer Olivera, who is again having a great season. She is 8-0 with a 0.60 ERA through her first nine starts...Offensively, the Lions are batting .313 as a team with freshman Angela St. Croix leading the way with a .500 batting average...Vanguard leads the all-time series 38-22, though Biola is 22-11 against the Lions since the 2000 season. The Eagles were 2-3 against Vanguard last year but did knock the Lions out of the NAIA Region II playoffs with an 8-4 win.

CONCORDIA NOTES: The No. 25-ranked Eagles (20-7 overall, 2-2 GSAC) snuck into the NAIA Pre-season rankings to give the GSAC five teams among the top-25 and have won 20 games already this year. However, Concordia has lost four of its last seven games after a 17-3 start, including a 5-4 loss at



Hope International on Saturday...Offense has not been a problem for Concordia, which ranks second in the GSAC with a team batting average of .340 and is averaging nearly six runs a game. Leading the hitters is senior shortstop Caitlyn Senkbeil, who is batting .462, slugging at .774 with four home runs and 28 runs scored...Concordia holds a 30-24 edge in the all-time series, though Biola is 7-3 against the Eagles in the last 10 games.

BIOLA TRACK AND FIELD

Biola Wraps Up Indoor Season; Begins Outdoors at Occidental on Friday

The Biola University track and field teams closed out the indoor schedule on a successful note as two Eagles earned NAIA All-American honors at the NAIA Indoor Championships last week in Johnson City, Tennessee.

Freshman Natasha Miller opened the competition with a strong performance in the pentathlon, finishing fourth overall.

Miller, who was participating in the pentathlon for just the second time this season, moved into the top six and wrapped up fourth place by winning the final event, the 800m run. She crossed the line with a time of 2:29.04. She also tied for first in the high jump—the second event of the day, clearing a personal-best height of 5-5 in her final jump of the day.

Biola sophomore Kristin Schmidt wrapped up the competition with a fourth-place finish in the 5,000m run Saturday.

Schmidt ran an indoor personal best time of 17:27.38 to earn All-America honors for the fourth time. She twice earned the honors in outdoor track in 2007 and added another during cross country this fall.

Schmidt dropped nearly a full minute off her eighth-place time during the 2007 indoor championships at the same location last year.

The Eagles, who have only had one other indoor All-American in their history, scored eight points overall to tie for 22nd place. It was the third-best point total by a GSAC team in the competition.

Biola now sets its sights on the outdoor season which opens this week with the Occidental College Distance Carnival on Friday in Los Angeles. The meet, which is made up of a variety of distance events, begins at 6:00 p.m.
