Red-Hot Baseball Plays Four GSAC Games; Hosts Vanguard Wednesday

The Biola baseball team (22-9 overall, 13-7 GSAC) has been one of the hottest teams in the GSAC recently with nine win in its last 10 games. The Eagles look to continue that success this week as they play four GSAC games. The week begins with Biola hosting Vanguard on Wednesday at 3:00 p.m. The two teams then play again on Thursday in Costa Mesa at 3:00 p.m. On Saturday, Biola travels to San Diego for a key GSAC doubleheader against Point Loma Nazarene beginning at Noon.

Softball Faces Hope International; Hosts Cal State San Marcos

The Eagles' softball team (16-16 overall, 3-7 GSAC) has been playing markedly better ball over the last three weeks, going 10-5 over its last 15 games. This week, Biola wraps up the first half of the GSAC schedule at Hope International University on Tuesday. The doubleheader will begin at 4:00 p.m. and be played at George Bellis Park in Buena Park. On Saturday, the Eagles return home for a non-conference twinbill against Cal State San Marcos. First pitch is slated for noon at Freedom Field.

Tennis Returns to Action Hosting La Sierra; Travels to Concordia on Saturday

Women's Tennis (5-9 overall, 0-6 GSAC) had its three-match winning streak snapped a week ago, but has still won five of its last eight matches. This week, Biola returns to action after taking time off for spring break. The Eagles host La Sierra University on Tuesday at 2:00 p.m. on the Biola Tennis Courts, then travel to Concordia on Saturday for a GSAC match ta Noon.

The Men's Tennis team (1-10 overall, 0-5 GSAC) lost to Cal Lutheran on Saturday in its first match after spring break. The Eagles also play twice this week, hosting La Sierra Uni-

versity on Tuesday at 2:00 p.m. on the Biola Tennis Courts. They wrap up the week with a trip to Irvine to face GSAC foe Concordia University on Saturday at Noon.

Track Heads to Pomona-Pitzer for Mid-Season Tuneup

Biola's outdoor track and field season is underway and the Eagles are off to a solid start. This week, Biola heads to Pomona for the Pomona-Pitzer Invitational on Saturday. The annual meet has been going on since 1998 and features some of the best small college teams in Southern California. Biola had a great indoor season which culminated in a number of indoor All-Americans and the largest indoor contingent in the school's history. Now, the Eagles are prepping to send another group to the outdoor championships in May.

BIOLA BASEBALL

Baseball Faces Vanguard in Home and Home Series; Travels to PLNU

THIS WEEK: The Biola baseball team plays four games this week with three coming on the road. First up is a home-and-home series against Vanguard University. The first game is at Biola on Wednesday at 3:00 p.m., the second is in Costa Mesa on Thursday, also at 3:00 p.m. On Saturday, the Eagles head to San Diego for a twinbill against Point Loma at Noon.

BIOLA SWEEPS GSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS: The Eagles' **Josh Baas** and **Chris Foreman** were named the GSAC Pitcher and Player of the Week respectively as Biola swept the weekly honors for the second time this season. Baas picked up two wins and struck out 16 over 13 innings last week to improve to 6-1 on the season. Foreman batted .500 (11-for-22) with a home run, two triples, three doubles, nine RBIs and 11 runs scored.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (22-9 overall, 13-7 GSAC) continue to play great baseball, having won eight of their last nine games and going 13-3 in the month of March. Last week, Biola went 5-1 in six games, including a doubleheader sweep over GSAC foe San Diego Christian College on Saturday...Biola didn't even need its bullpen in the sweep over SDCC as Jimmy Johnson pitched a complete game, allowing just three runs while Baas allowed just one in seven innings in the nightcap...In their last four games, Biola's offense has scored 56 runs and pounded out 69 hits over the last 32 innings...The pitching staff has been great in March. Biola pitchers went 13-3 with a 3.60 ERA during the month. If you take out the 13-0 loss at Fresno Pacific, the team ERA drops to 2.80 for the month...Hitting honors for the month go to **Hawkins Gebbers**, who hit .481 (26-for-54) four home runs, six doubles, a triple, 18 runs scored and 18 RBIs in March.

VANGUARD NOTES: The Lions (15-17 overall, 6-14 GSAC) have won nine of their last 13 games after a 2-12 stretch which included a nine-game losing streak. Vanguard has had to rely on its pitching staff this year as the offense just hasn't been clicking.



Through the first half of the season, the Lions are batting .234—just one one-thousandth point better than Westmont for lowest in the GSAC...The Vanguard pitchers have the fourth-best ERA (3.82) in the conference, though, and are led by Christopher Carls, who is 5-0 with a 2.01 ERA...The teams split two games earlier this season with Vanguard winning 4-0 in Costa Mesa and Biola winning 8-5 at home.

POINT LOMA NAZARENE NOTES: The Sea Lions (16-16, 9-11 GSAC) are having a bit of a down year this season by Point Loma standards. They have won just five of their last 16 games and have dropped to .500 on the season. Pitching has



been the strength for Point Loma in the past, but this year the Sea Lions have a team ERA over 4.00 and don't seem to have that dominating starter they have featured for the last few years. Meanwhile, the offense has picked up the slack, specifically senior infielder Andy Reilly. Reilly is among the GSAC leaders with a .409 batting average on the season and has 14 doubles, four home runs, 28 RBIs and 23 runs scored...Biola and Point Loma split a pair of games in La Mirada earlier this year. In the first game, the Eagles jumped all over the Sea Lions and held on for a 10-4 win. In the nightcap, Biola fought back to tie the game at 3-3 in the third, but PLNU scored a run in each of the final three innings to win 6-3.

BIOLA SOFTBALL

Eagles Travel to Hope; Host Cal State San Marcos on Saturday

THIS WEEK: The Biola University softball team closes out the first half of the GSAC schedule this week with a conference doubleheader at Hope International on Tuesday. The games will be played at Bellis Park in Buena Park beginning at 4:00 p.m. Biola then returns home for a non-conference twinbill against Cal State San Marcos on Saturday with first pitch scheduled to be thrown at Noon.

HUDSON NAMED GSAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Biola third baseman **Jacqie Hudson** was named GSAC Player of the Week after going .478 in six games last week. Hudson went 11-for-23 with two home runs, two doubles, seven runs scored and 11 RBIs. For the season, Hudson is batting a team-best .398 with 39 hits and 22 RBIs.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (16-16 overall, 3-7 GSAC) have been playing much better as they have passed the midway point of the season. Biola is 10-5 in its last 15 games after a seven-game losing streak earlier this season. Last week, Biola went 4-2 in six games, scoring a total of 45 runs in those games. On Saturday, the Eagles split a doubleheader against #3 Point Loma Nazarene, winning game one 9-4, but falling 9-1 in the second game. The nine runs scored by Biola in game one was the most the Sea Lions had allowed in a game all season...Hudson is currently riding an eight-game hitting streak, the longest of the season for Biola.

HOPE INTERNATIONAL NOTES: The Royals (16-16 overall, 2-8 GSAC) have won eight of their last 12 games to move back to .500 on the season. It has been a bit of tumultuous season for Hope as coach

Mike Fitzgerald abruptly was let go a few weeks ago.



Two of his assistant coaches are acting as interim coaches for the remainder of the season...Hope has been playing spoiler this year as the Royals have already split doubleheaders with Vanguard and Concordia this year...Senior utility player Lisa Teberg leads the Royals with a .428 batting average and has four home runs and 23 runs scored.

CAL STATE SAN MARCOS NOTES: The Cougars (22-10 overall) are in just their second season as a varsity program, but are quickly proving to be one of the teams to beat on the west coast. Cal State San Marcos had a six-game winning streak snapped on Saturday in a split with Hope International. Overall, though, they have been just mediocre against



the GSAC, posting a 6-6 record against conference schools so far this year. The Cougars strength has been their pitching which boasts a 1.45 ERA thus far. Melissa Lerno is their No. 1 starter and is 8-4 with a 0.93 ERA while their No. 2 starter, Breanna Sandberg has an identical record with a 1.62 ERA... Lerno is also the team's leading hitter with a .352 batting average, a home run, 13 RBIs and 18 runs scored on the year.
