## Baseball Hosts Two Games vs. Westmont; Travels to Concordia

The Biola baseball team (28-12 overall, 18-10 GSAC) moved to within four games of first place last week by going 4-1 in five contests. The Eagles now set their sights on Westmont College, which comes to town for a two-game series on Wednesday and Thursday. Both games are set to begin at 3:00 p.m. On Saturday, Biola heads down to Irvine to take on Concordia University in a big GSAC doubleheader. The twinbill begins at Noon on the CUI campus.

### Softball Hosts Concordia; Travels to Azusa Pacific this Week

Biola's softball team (19-21 overall, 5-11 GSAC) is still in good position to earn a berth in the NAIA Region II playoffs. The Eagles can strengthen their chances on Tuesday as they host Concordia University in a GSAC doubleheader at Freedom Field. Biola and Concordia are tied for fifth in the conference right now and are just one game back of fourth-place Vanguard. The top four teams in the conference are likely to make it to the regional tournament. The Eagles round out the week at arch-rival Azusa Pacific University on Saturday for a GSAC doubleheader beginning at Noon.

### Women's Tennis Travels to Arizona to face Grand Canyon University

Women's Tennis (6-13 overall, 0-9 GSAC) travels to Arizona this week for a time of ministry and competition. The ladies will ... On Friday, the Eagles wrap up the trip with a non-conference match against NCAA Division II Grand Canyon University at 1:00 p.m.

The men's team wrapped up its season last week with three home matches. The Eagles, who are in just their second season as a varsity program, wrapped up the 2008 season with an overall record of 2-15.

### Four Biola Athletes To Take Part in 50th Mt. SAC Relays

Biola's outdoor track and field team sends four athletes to the prestigious Mt. SAC relays this week. The meet involves well over 50 teams from all over the country along with some of the premier athletes from US Track and Field. Biola will be sending four athletes, senior Brian Ball (3000m Steeplechase), sophomore Kyle McNulty (3000m Steeplechase), freshman Natasha Miller (400m Hurdles) and sophomore Kristin Schmidt (5000m). Ball, McNulty and Schmidt all run on Thursday while Miller competes on Friday.

The rest of the track and field team will compete at the California Invitational on Wednesday and Thursday at Azusa Pacific and the APU Invite on Friday.

### Former Biola President, Athlete, Coach and Athletic Director Clyde Cook Passes Away

The Biola community was stunned on Friday night at the news that President Emeritus Clyde Cook died suddenly in his home in Fullerton. Cook was a star athlete at Biola in the mid-50's and was the school's first athletic director from 1957-60. He also started and coached the baseball program and coached track, cross country and basketball at Biola.

# BIOLA BASEBALL

## Eagles Inch Closer to Top of GSAC; Host Westmont, Travel to Concordia

**THIS WEEK:** The Biola baseball team closes out a brief four-game series with a two-game GSAC series against Westmont College on Wednesday and Thursday. Both games are slated for a 3:00 p.m. first pitch at Eagles Diamond. On Saturday, Biola hits the road for a conference twinbill at Concordia University beginning at Noon.

**BIOLA NOTES:** The Eagles (28-12 overall, 18-10 GSAC) went 4-1 in five games last week including winning three of four GSAC contests. Biola defeated crosstown foe Whittier College to open last week's action, winning 6-0 at home on Tuesday. Wednesday, the Eagles came from behind to beat Cal Baptist by a 6-5 count, but fell to the Lancers in Riverside on Thursday 7-0. Biola then rebounded with a convincing sweep over The Master's College at home on Saturday, winning 13-6 and 9-4...Biola, which fell to No. 19 in the latest NAIA National Poll, moved two games closer to GSAC-leading Azusa Pacific as the Cougars went 1-3 in four conference games last week. The Eagles are also just two games back of Fresno Pacific for second place and remain a game ahead of Cal Baptist for third...Junior **Hawkins Gebbers** saw his 22-game hitting streak come to an end on Thursday as he went 0-for-4 at Cal Baptist. However, he continued to post strong numbers during the week anyway, going 9-for-19 with 10 RBIs and nine runs scored. Gebbers, who leads the team with a .418 batting average, had the big blast in Biola's 6-5 win over Cal Baptist, belting a grand slam to put the Eagles up for good...Senior **Kris Cook** and junior **David West** also had a strong week for the Eagles with Cook going 9-for-19 and West going 8-for-18. West is now batting an even .400 on the season while Cook is batting a season-best .333 overall.

**WESTMONT NOTES:** The Warriors (8-26 overall, 4-24 GSAC) have struggled lately and dropped 11 of their last 12 games on the season. Westmont has played well against some of the GSAC's best teams this year and pulled off stunning victories over Azusa Pacific, Cal Baptist and most recently downing The Master's 8-6 in 10 innings last week...The Warriors rank next to last in the GSAC in hitting with a team batting average of .237 overall and are dead last in pitching with a 6.63 ERA and in fielding with a .946 fielding percentage...Colton Christianson has the highest batting average among the regulars for Westmont. He is hitting .329 on the season with 11 RBIs in 25 games for the Warriors...Biola has had little

trouble with Westmont over the last decade, going 42-4 against the Warriors since the start of the 1998 season. Biola has won both games against Westmont this year by a combined score 34-5, taking the first game 12-0 and the second 22-5. Both games were in Santa Barbara.

**CONCORDIA NOTES:** The Eagles (17-15 overall, 15-13 GSAC) have moved back into the playoff picture thanks to winning seven of their last 11 games including a split with No. 14 Fresno Pacific at home on Saturday...Concordia also ranks near the bottom of the GSAC in pitching (5.51 ERA) and hitting (.279 batting average). However, they do have one of the GSAC's best pitchers in Enrique Luchiga, who is 7-1 with a 3.21 ERA on the season. Luchiga has recorded wins in his last five outings including holding the high-powered Fresno Pacific offense to just two runs on five hits over seven innings on Saturday...Leading the offense is Nathan Dean, who is batting .350 on the season with a team-high 15 doubles. Right behind him is Gregg Davidson, who has a .333 average with four home runs and 17 RBIs...Biola swept a doubleheader with the Eagles in La Mirada earlier this year with Jimmy Johnson tossing a near no-hitter in the first game. Biola won by scores of 9-0 and 4-2. Biola leads the all-time series 63-34 and has won 10 of the last 14 games between the two teams in Irvine. Last year the teams split the season series with each team winning twice on the other's home field.

## Eagles Host Concordia, Travel to Azusa Looking to Move Up in GSAC

**THIS WEEK:** The Biola University softball team returns home for the first time in over a week to host Concordia University in a key GSAC battle. The two teams which are currently tied for fifth in the GSAC standings, begin their doubleheader at 2:00 p.m. at Freedom Field in La Mirada. On Saturday, the Eagles return to the road to take on arch-rival Azusa Pacific University in Azusa at Noon.

**MOYER NAMED GSAC PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Freshman pitcher Erica Moyer was named the GSAC Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 7-13 as announced Monday by the conference office. Moyer was 1-1 in two starts last week, but allowed just one run on six hits against a pair of nationally-ranked teams. She limited No. 1-ranked California Baptist to just one run on two hits over five innings and struck out two on Tuesday. At No. 13 Vanguard on Saturday, she continued her solid pitching, scattering four hits over seven shutout innings. She added five strikeouts and picked up the win in that game to improve to 4-7 on the season.

**BIOLA NOTES:** The Eagles (19-21 overall, 5-11 GSAC) are coming off a tough week of games against two NAIA Top-15 teams. Biola dropped two games at No. 1 Cal Baptist, but rebounded with a split in a twinbill at No. 13 Vanguard on Saturday...Sophomore **Krista Johnson** and senior **Jacqie Hudson** continue to pace Biola's offense. Johnson leads the Eagles with a .377 batting average while Hudson is close behind batting .366 on the season...Freshman **Lauren Gandy** returned to the leadoff spot in the second game on Saturday and went 3-for-4, reaching base on an error the lone time she didn't get a hit.

**CONCORDIA NOTES:** The Eagles (32-17 overall, 5-11 GSAC) enter the week tied with Biola for fifth in the GSAC standings. Concordia had a ton of success in non-conference games, but has won just five times in the GSAC. In fact, the Eagles are 3-7 in their last 10 games and just 2-6 in their last eight GSAC contests...Ashley Alvarez has the hot bat on the team, leading the way with a .394 batting average...Earlier this season, the teams split a twinbill at Concordia, with Biola winning 7-3 in the opener and Concordia surviving a late Biola rally to win 8-6 in the nightcap.



**AZUSA PACIFIC NOTES:** The Cougars (19-22 overall, 9-9 GSAC) are one of the most improved teams in the GSAC this season and are poised to return to the postseason for the first time in four years...Azusa Pacific had been ranked in the Top-25 two weeks ago, but slipped out last week as the Cougars have dropped six of their last eight games...The last four games have come against No. 1 Cal Baptist and No. 2 Point Loma, but all four games resulted in losses...Azusa Pacific has been led by pitcher Camille Hundley who has pitched in 23 of the team's 41 games this year. She has a 10-11 record with a 1.86 ERA.
