## Softball Begins Second Half at No. 1 Cal Baptist and No. 10 Vanguard

The Biola softball team (18-18 overall, 4-8 GSAC) begins the second half of the conference schedule this week with a pair of road games against top-ranked teams. The Eagles travel to Riverside on Tuesday to face off against No. 1 California Baptist University in a GSAC twinbill at 2:00 p.m. Then, on Saturday, Biola heads to Costa Mesa to take on No. 10 Vanguard University in a doubleheader beginning at Noon. The Eagles are just one game behind the Lions in the GSAC standings heading into this week's games.

### Baseball Plays Five Games Including Cross-Town Whittier College on Tuesday

The baseball team (24-11 overall, 15-9 GSAC) begins a busy week of games on Tuesday, hosting cross-town foe Whittier College at 3:00 p.m. on Eagles Diamond. The Eagles then return to GSAC play with a home-and-home series against California Baptist. Biola hosts the Lancers on Wednesday then the teams face off again on Thursday, this time in Riverside. Both games are set to begin at 3:00 p.m. The Eagles wrap up the week with a doubleheader on Saturday against The Master's College. First pitch is schedule for Noon at Eagles Diamond.

### Women's Tennis Plays Three Home Matches

Women's Tennis (6-10 overall, 0-7 GSAC) split a pair of matches last week, beating La Sierra University on Tuesday, but falling to Concordia on Saturday. This week, Biola plays three home matches—two against GSAC foes. The Eagles host Hope International University on Tuesday at 1:30 p.m. On Friday, Biola welcomes Cal State Los Angeles to the Biola Tennis Center for a 1:30 p.m. match. Saturday, the Eagles round out the week with a GSAC match

against California Baptist University with introductions beginning at 1:00 p.m.

### Men's Tennis Plays Final Three Matches

The Men's Tennis team (2-11 overall, 0-5 GSAC) wraps up the 2008 dual-match season with three home matches this week. The Eagles start out the week against Hope International University in a GSAC match at 1:30 p.m. On Friday, Biola takes on California Lutheran University at 3:30 p.m. The Eagles then play their final regular-season match against California Baptist University on Saturday at 1:00 p.m.

### Track Travels to Fresno for Tri-Meet

Biola's outdoor track and field team continues its 2008 campaign with a trip north for a tri-meet at Fresno Pacific University on Saturday. The Eagles and Sunbirds will be joined by Westmont College at the meet. Biola had a great week last week at the Pomona-Pitzer Invitational as freshman Natasha Miller and sophomore Kristin Schmidt combined for six NAIA automatic qualifying times. The Eagles now have qualified seven individuals in 12 different events for the NAIA Championships in Edwardsville, Ill., May 22-24.

# BIOLA BASEBALL

## Baseball Plays Five Games This Week Including Cross-Town Foe Whittier

**THIS WEEK:** The Biola baseball team returns to action this week with five games in as many days. The Eagles open things up with a non-conference game against cross-town Whittier College, which plays in the NCAA Division III. That game will be on Tuesday on Eagles Diamond at 3:00 p.m. On Wednesday, the Eagles take on California Baptist University in the first of a home-and-home series. Biola hosts the first game at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday with the Lancers hosting the second game at the same time on Thursday. The Eagles close out the week with a home doubleheader against The Master's College on Saturday beginning at Noon.

**BIOLA NOTES:** The Eagles (24-11 overall, 15-9 GSAC) moved up to No. 13 in the NAIA National Rankings released on Wednesday. However, their six-game winning streak was snapped as they were swept in a doubleheader on Saturday at Point Loma despite hitting six home runs in the two games. In the first game, Biola came back from a 10-4 deficit but lost 11-10. The Eagles held a 3-0 lead in the second only to see the Sea Lions score six runs in the final two innings to win 6-4. Biola won two games against Vanguard this week, defeating the Lions 12-8 at Biola and 7-1 in Costa Mesa...Junior **Hawkins Gebbers** extended his hitting-streak to 20 games with seven hits this week. He waited until his final at-bat to collect a hit at Vanguard, hitting a double down the left-field line. Gebbers leads the team with a .410 batting average on the season...Junior **Chad Pace** became the first Biola player to record home runs in three consecutive at-bats with his three-homer day at Point Loma on Saturday. He hit home runs in his final two at-bats of game one, then drilled a solo shot in his first at-bat of the second game.

**WHITTIER NOTES:** The Poets (12-14-1 overall) are just 3-6 in their last nine games after going 8-2 in their previous 10 games. Whittier, which is a member of the NCAA Division III, currently sits in the middle of the pack in the Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SCIAC) with a 5-4 conference record...The Poets have not had much trouble scoring runs as they average nine runs scored per game. However, their pitching has struggled to keep up as they have a 6.58 team ERA...Junior Anthony Cappellitti leads the Poets with a .456 average and has seven home runs, 31 RBIs and 29 runs scored on the season...Biola leads the all-time series 36-17, but despite being just five miles apart, the two teams have not played each other since the 2001 season.

**CALIFORNIA BAPTIST NOTES:** The Lancers (25-13 overall, 14-10 GSAC) remain in the mix for a playoff spot and are just one game back of the Eagles heading into this week's pair of games...



Cal Baptist has been a force to be reckoned with at its new ballpark, going 20-3 at home. However, the Lancers are just 5-10 on the road where they play eight of their final 12 games...Senior second baseman Steve Goins leads CBU with a .382 average. The three-time All-GSAC selection is also one of the team's top pitchers with a 6-3 record and a 2.75 ERA...Biola is 4-4 against Cal Baptist over the last eight games including splitting the first two games earlier this season. The Eagles are 36-14 against the Lancers since the start of the 1998 season.

**THE MASTER'S NOTES:** The Mustangs (24-12-1 overall, 12-12 GSAC) have not been able to get above the .500 mark in conference play over the course of the season as they have split the vast majority of the series they have played. At one point this season, The Master's was ranked in the Top-10 in the NAIA after going 11-1-1 to start the season. However, they have gone just 13-10 since that point...The Mustangs' success has come from its stellar pitching staff which ranks second in the conference with a 2.89 ERA. Offensively, they aren't too shabby either as they rank fourth with a .298 batting average...Junior catcher Tyler Diamond is having a monster year offensively for The Master's, batting .388 with seven homers and 37 RBIs...The pitching tandem of Tim Woodward (8-2, 2.11 ERA) and Joe Zeller (8-3, 2.79 ERA) has carried the Mustangs...Biola leads the all-time series 63-43-1 as the two teams split a pair of games earlier this season. The Eagles are 19-6 against the Mustangs since the start of the 2003 season.

# BIOLA SOFTBALL

## Biola Begins Second Half of GSAC Schedule on the Road

**THIS WEEK:** The Biola University softball team begins the second half of the conference schedule with a pair of tough road doubleheaders. First up is a trip to Riverside where the Eagles will face No. 1 California Baptist University on Tuesday at 2:00 p.m. Then, on Saturday, Biola heads south to Costa Mesa to face off with No. 10 Vanguard University in a twinbill at Noon.

**BIOLA NOTES:** The Eagles (18-18 overall, 4-8 GSAC) are coming off a bit of a frustrating week where they were forced to split a pair of doubleheaders. On Tuesday, Biola dropped the first game at Hope International by a 8-0 count in five innings, before responding with a 5-1 win in the nightcap. On Saturday, the Eagles dropped a 4-2 decision to Cal State San Marcos at home but again, came back to earn a split with a 4-0 win in the second game... **Krista Johnson** continued her hot hitting, going 7-for-12 last week with three doubles and a run scored. She is now batting .409 on the season to lead the Eagles.

**CALIFORNIA BAPTIST NOTES:** The Lancers (40-4 overall, 13-1 GSAC) moved back into the No. 1 spot in the NAIA rankings last week. Cal Baptist lost its first GSAC game of the season on Saturday, falling to Point Loma as the top two teams in the nation split a doubleheader...The Lancers are once again clicking on all cylinders, batting .347 as a team while their pitchers have a 1.26 ERA on the season. Their two main starters are senior Amy Thomas (22-2, 0.85 ERA) and sophomore Melanie Ahu-

mada (18-2, 1.75 ERA). Only one other pitcher has pitched for Cal Baptist, and she's thrown just 3-1/3 innings...The Lancers lead the all-time series 47-18 and took both games of a doubleheader in La Mirada earlier this season. Despite Cal Baptist's success over the last five years, Biola has been able to take at least one game from the Lancers each season.

**VANGUARD NOTES:** The Lions (30-14 overall, 5-9 GSAC) enter the week ranked No. 10 in the NAIA, but are fourth in the conference and four games back of third-place Azusa Pacific. Vanguard has really struggled as of late and stopped a six-game losing streak with a 4-2 win over Concordia Saturday in a doubleheader split...The Lions have not been hitting well in GSAC games, batting a conference-worst .209 with just 17 runs scored in 14 games... Vanguard has had to rely on its star pitcher Jennifer Olvera, who is 14-2 with a 0.73 ERA. Taking her out of the equation, Vanguard's team ERA goes from 1.65 to 2.24...The two teams split earlier this season with the Lions winning 4-0 in the first game behind 15 strikeouts from Olvera. ## Biola Looks to Improve NAIA Marks in Tri-Meet at Fresno Pacific

The Biola University track and field team travels north to Fresno this weekend to take part in a three-way meet at Fresno Pacific University. The meet will be held on Saturday at Fresno Pacific and will also involve the team from Westmont College.

The Eagles had two athletes combine to record six automatic qualifying marks to the NAIA Championships on Saturday at the Pomona-Pitzer Invitational.

Freshman Natasha Miller tied for second in the high jump (5-6), placed seventh in the 100 hurdles (14.89), tied for eighth in the triple jump (11.59 m) and finished third in the 400 hurdles (1:04.14). All of these marks hit or bettered the NAIA qualifying standard.

Sophomore Kristin Schmidt, a four-time NAIA All-American, finished eighth in the 1500m with a time of 4:41.12 and took fourth

in the 5000m with a 17:33.48. Both of these marks are well under the "A" standard.
