The Biola men's basketball team snapped a four-game losing skid with an impressive win at Vanguard University on Saturday. Sophomore Danny Campbell hit eight three-pointers and finished with 31 points to lead the Eagles, who are 11-8 overall and 3-6 in GSAC play.

The women's team suffered a heart-breaking loss to Fresno Pacific on Tuesday as a last-second three pointer gave the Sunbirds a 71-70 win. Biola is 5-13 on the season and 2-7 in conference action.

The swim teams had little trouble defeating NCAA Division III Chapman University as the women won 135-60 and the men cruised to a 93-68 win.

Track and field opened the indoor season on Friday by earning three qualifying marks at the Concordia indoor meet. The distance medley relay team qualified as did Kristin Schmidt in the 5,000 and Natasha Miller in the triple jump.

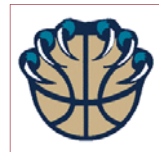
Eagles End First Half of GSAC Schedule at Arch-Rival Azusa Pacific

THIS WEEK: The Biola men's basketball team sets its sights on arch-rival Azusa Pacific University this week as it wraps up the first half of the GSAC schedule. The Eagles travel up to the Felix Event Center on Tuesday (Jan. 29) for the big showdown against APU. On Saturday (Feb. 2), the Eagles return home for a game against San Diego Christian College at Chase Gymnasium. Both games tipoff at 7:30 p.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (10-8 overall, 2-6 GSAC) snapped a four-game losing streak and may have saved the entire season with a 73-66 win at Vanguard on Saturday. Sophomore **Danny Campbell** was unstoppable, tying a school record with eight three-pointers and finishing the night with 31 points...On Tuesday, Biola struggled from the field in a 73-63 home loss to Fresno Pacific. The Sunbirds hit 11 three-pointers in the game and outscored the Eagles in the paint...Biola still ranks in the top five in the NAIA in scoring defense despite its latest struggles. The Eagles are holding teams to 60.5 ppg and 39.2% shooting on the season. While also leading the GSAC in both categories, Biola ranks 10th in scoring offense (66.8 ppg), ninth in 3-pt FG percentage (34.8%) and eighth in free throw percentage (64.6%)...Sophomore guard **Marlon King** was held under 10 points for the first time in the last six games, scoring eight points in Biola's win at Vanguard on Saturday. He's reached double-digits in scoring in 11 of the 19 games this year and is averaging 11.5 ppg... Senior forward **Danny Jones** continues to lead the team with 14.7 points and 8.9 rebounds per game. Jones has posted eight double-doubles this season including a 10-point, 10-rebound performance in the Eagles' loss to Fresno Pacific on Tuesday. He missed the school's first triple-double by two assists against The Master's on Jan. 8, finishing with 16 points, 15 boards and eight assists.

the last 11 games. The Cougars have won the last five games in the series including a pair of nail-biters last season as the Cougars swept the series winning 71-70 at Biola and 71-69 at APU.

SAN DIEGO CHRISTIAN NOTES: It seems like a long time ago now, but the Hawks (4-13 Overall, 1-8 GSAC) were the 2006-07 GSAC regular-season champions and made an appearance in the NAIA tournament last year. However, nearly everyone from that team left at the end of the season making for a tough, uphill climb for new coach Jason Smith... Senior forward Bayo Arigbon is one of the few back from last season's team and currently leads the GSAC with 20.1 ppg and 12.1 rpg...Guard Chris Neal has been playing well lately and is averaging 17.3 ppg on the season...Biola opened the GSAC schedule against the Hawks, winning 79-42 in El Cajon. The Eagles limited Arigbon to 13 and Neal to six points as SDCC shot just 27 percent from the field...Biola holds a commanding 31-13 lead in the all-time series, though the Eagles have won just three of the last eight games. SDCC won two of three last year including a 64-53 win in the GSAC playoffs.

AZUSA PACIFIC NOTES: The Cougars (12-7 overall, 5-4 GSAC) and the Eagles are quite used to being this close in the conference standings, though it is typically near the top instead of in the middle. APU has been struggling through conference play and were 4-4 after eight GSAC games for the first time since the 1991-92 season...Senior forward Davon Roberts leads the team with 14.8 ppg and adds 6.0 rpg. He has nearly single-handedly helped the Cougars win their last two games, preserving a win at The Master's with a steal with 8.8 seconds left, then hitting the game-winning shot to knock off Cal Baptist on Saturday...Senior forward Todd Martin (11.6 ppg) and sophomore guard Mike Danielian (11.1 ppg) are the other two scorers in double-figures for the Cougars...Azusa Pacific leads the all-time series 47-43 (since 1965-66) and have won nine of

BIOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Biola Travels to APU; Hosts San Diego Christian This Week

THIS WEEK: The Biola women's basketball team wraps up the first half of the GSAC schedule with its big rivalry game against Azusa Pacific University on Tuesday (Jan. 29). The Eagles then return home to kick off the second half of the conference season, hosting San Diego Christian College on Saturday (Feb. 2) at Chase Gymnasium. Both games are scheduled to begin at 5:30 p.m.

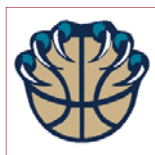
BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles (5-13 overall, 2-7 GSAC) dropped a pair of games last week, though not for a lack of effort. Biola suffered a heart-breaking 71-70 loss at the hands of Fresno Pacific University on Tuesday as Samantha Cardeno drained a deep three-pointer at the buzzer for the win. Biola followed that up with a strong effort at No. 3 Vanguard, only to see a 22-0 second-half run break open a close game and give the Lions a 86-57 win...Junior forward **Megann Alberts** continues to pace the Eagle offense. She ranks fourth in the conference in scoring at 16.2 ppg and seventh in rebounding with 7.7 rpg. She's reached double-digits in points in 16 of the team's 18 games including the last eight and has five double-doubles on the season...Not to be outdone, junior forward **Summer Matthews** has been a rebounding machine, ranking fourth in the GSAC with 8.6 boards per game. Matthews has been scoring a lot more lately and is now averaging 9.6 points per game...The team's may freshman have been getting into the act as well, led by forward **Jenna French**, who played at nearby La Serna High School. French is only averaging 4.9 points per game, but has been in double-figures in the last two games with 11 against Fresno Pacific and 12 at Vanguard...While the Eagles rank in the middle of the pack in most conference stats, they are first in rebounds (43 per game) and rebounds allowed (35.1 per game). Biola is out rebounding teams by 7.9 boards per contest, which ranks first in the GSAC as well.

AZUSA PACIFIC NOTES: The Cougars (16-3 overall, 8-1 GSAC) have been one of the GSAC's top teams this season and sit in a three-way tie atop the conference with Vanguard and Point Loma Nazarene. Azusa Pacific is ranked No. 7 in the latest NAIA National Ratings and has been in the top 10 all season...The Cougars have lost just one game to NAIA competition and have defeated eight teams ranked in the top 25 this season...Azusa Pacific has three players averaging double-figures in scoring led by senior forward Abby Johnson, who is averaging a team-best 15.5 points and 8.9 rebounds per game and adds 14 blocks and 27 steals...Senior guard Sarah Leathers (11.4 ppg, 50 steals) and sophomore center Kristie Hala'ufia (11.2 ppg, 6.2 rpg) round out the scoring leaders for the Cougars...Azusa Pacific holds a slight edge in the all-time series, leading 34-32. The



Cougars have won 19 of the last 22 games, though. On the plus side, Biola has gone 2-2 in the last four games at APU. The Cougars swept the season series last year, winning 74-59 at Biola and 88-76 at Azusa.

SAN DIEGO CHRISTIAN NOTES: The Hawks (7-11 overall, 2-7 GSAC) are playing much better ball as the season has progressed, winning six of their



last 10 games after starting the season with a 1-7 record...San Diego Christian gave the Eagles all they could handle as the teams opened GSAC play against each other.

Biola was able to stave off a second-half rally and picked up a 69-62 win back in November...junior guard Dorchella James has been a key factor in the team's improved play and leads SDCC with 15.7 ppg and has recorded 72 assists on the year...Freshman guard Vernessa Roberts is adding 10.9 ppg with senior guard Courtney Ash pouring in 10.4 points per contest...Biola has a 14-3 all-time series lead over San Diego Christian and has won six straight games. The Hawks last series win came at Biola where they have one just once in nine games.

Eagles Open Season Against Simpson University on Tuesday

THIS WEEK: Biola kicks off the season with three games this week, starting with its home and season opener on Tuesday (Jan. 29) against Simpson University at 1:30 p.m. On Friday (Feb. 1), Biola begins a home-and-home series against the University of La Verne, hosting the Leopards at 2:00 p.m. The teams then travel to La Verne to close out the series on Saturday (Feb. 2) at 1:00 p.m.

BIOLA NOTES: The Eagles return 11 starters from last season's team which finished with a 30-24 overall record and reached the NAIA Region II Semifinals... On the mound, Biola returns six pitchers including senior lefty **Jimmy Johnson** and sophomore right-hander **Derek Dietzen**. Johnson posted a 5-4 record after injuries forced him into the No. 1 spot in the pitching rotation. He finished with a 3.38 ERA and recorded 58 strikeouts. Dietzen had a strong season as well going 6-2 with a 5.93 ERA, making 11 starts after beginning the season in the bullpen...Hitting should not be an issue for the Eagles again in 2008 as they return three of their top five hitters this year. Leading the pack was junior outfielder **Chris Foreman**, who posted a .375 batting average with 63 hits, 37 runs scored and 19 driven in. Also returning is junior outfielder **David West** who hit a quiet .354, scoring 28 runs and 27 RBIs...Biola welcomed a number of new faces to the pack including nine freshman and six transfers. Head Coach John Verhoeven is high on four transfers in particular. They are infielders **Nick Rotkowitz** (Orange Coast College) and **Brent Chavez** (Rio Honda College), outfielder

Chad Pace (Bluefield College) and right-handed pitcher **Brian Albert** (Rio Honda College).

SIMPSON NOTES: The Redhawks had a tough go of things in 2007, finishing 3-39 overall. Simpson is coached by a pair of former Major Leaguers in Rick Bosetti and Greg Cadaret. The Redhawks also will be taking on Concordia, Point Loma Nazarene and San Diego Christian on this long trip.



LA VERNE NOTES: The Leopards will open the season at Biola on Friday after finishing the 2007 season with a 21-18 record. La Verne was 15-6 in the SCIAC, missing out on their third-consecutive conference title by just one game to Pomona-Pitzer. The Leopards are coached by Scott Winterburn, an Azusa Pacific grad who has turned the team into a perennial contender on the NCAA Division III level.

Biola Travels to Cal State San Marcos to Open 2008 Season

THIS WEEK: The Biola University softball teams kicks off the 2008 campaign on Saturday (Feb. 2) with a trip to San Marcos to face NAIA Independent Cal State San Marcos at Noon.

BIOLA NOTES: While the Eagles lost just three starters and five players from last year's squad, the quality of players that were lost will make things tough for this season. However, Head Coach Carissa Millsap has brought in a talented class of recruits which should help ease the loss...The lone returning pitcher is junior **Emily Gray**, who was 12-6 with a 2.04 ERA and 79 strikeouts in 110 innings pitched last season. She will likely move into the No. 1 spot in the rotation for the Eagles. Biola also added a number of freshman pitchers including right-hander **Erica Moyer** (Hemet High School) and left-handed pitcher **Lyndsie Roberts** (Bakersfield/Stockdale High School)...Leading the offensive returners are a trio of infielders. Third baseman **Jacqie Hudson** hit .316 despite being hampered by injury last season. At short, Keena Levert returns for her junior season after a sophomore season which saw her belt six home runs and drive in 41 RBIs. Senior **Sarah Jensen** hit .315 on the season last year, scoring 37 runs and driving in 21 RBIs. Among the newcomers, outfielder **Lauren Gandy** (Pleasanton/Foothill High School) should add some speed at the top

of the lineup for the Eagles while **Sara Smith** (Northridge/LA Baptist High School) will provide defensive options at catcher and in the infield...Biola finished last season with a 32-17 record and reached the NAIA Region II Semifinals...Coach Millsap is just two wins away from 100 in her career at Biola and has a 98-47 (.676 winning percentage) in three seasons with the Eagles...Biola has a chance to get out of the blocks strong thanks to 16 of its first 26 games being at home.

CAL STATE SAN MARCOS NOTES: The



Cougars put together an impressive inaugural season last year, going 10-31 but giving some of the best teams in the GSAC a tough time. Cal State San Marcos will go into the 2008 season under the direction of a new coach. Kelly Warren will lead the team this season and have last year's top pitcher back in Melissa Lerno. Lerno posted a 5-15 record with a 3.13 ERA. She added 126 strikeouts in 143 inning pitched.
